


U.S. Agricultural Trade Update

Summary--The monthly U.S. agricultural trade surplus, which had fallen to \$1 billion or less each month between March and September 1998, mostly because of high imports, has revived in October and November to \$1.7 billion as the value of imports declined sharply. November 1998 imports fell 7 percent from October 1998, while exports dropped 4 percent. But, for the first 11 months of calendar year 1998, cumulative imports are still 3 percent above January-November 1997, at \$33.9 billion. Also, the \$47 billion in cumulative exports remains 10 percent below 1997. The 1998 trade surplus through November is \$13.1 billion, down 31 percent from January-November 1997.

Exports--At \$16.8 billion, bulk product exports in January-November 1998 are 18 percent below the first 11 months of 1997. However, the \$1.8 billion of bulk exports shipped in November is the same as in October and up sharply from September's \$1 billion. The stabilization reflects gains in exports of soybeans, cotton, and corn as marketing of the 1998 harvest intensified.

Soybean exports increased 29 percent from October 1998 to November. However, at 23.3 million tons and \$6.1 billion, soybean exports for the first 11 months of 1998 are still off 3 percent in volume and 12 percent in value compared with the same period in 1997.

Cotton exports also increased in November to 173,000 tons and \$259 million from 58,000 tons and \$90 million in October. In addition to marketing of the new harvest, the spread between the U.S. Memphis price and the international A Index price widened, making Step 2 payments increasingly attractive to U.S. companies. But exporters had to hurry to take advantage of the remaining Step 2 funds as program funding ran out in mid-December. Cotton exports for the year are virtually unchanged in volume from 1997, but down 8 percent in value to \$2.2 billion.

Exports of corn also rose 10 percent in November compared with October. But, through November, corn exports declined 18 percent to \$3.9 billion. Cumulative wheat exports in the year-to-date are \$3.3

billion, 11 percent below 1997. November exports fell from October.



Exports of *high-value products (HVP)* are down 4 percent from January-November 1997 to \$30.3 billion, the first year-over-year decline since fiscal 1985. Hides and skins account for much of the decline, falling 24 percent from \$1.6 billion in 1997. Meat and poultry, animal feeds, and fruits and nuts also dropped. Vegetable oils remain the bright spot, rising 36 percent to \$2 billion.

Imports--At \$2.4 billion, up 27 percent, vegetable imports are responsible for much of the year-to-date gain in imports. But, malt beverages, cocoa, and wine imports also are up sharply for the year. Gains are partly offset by losses in imports of tobacco, rubber, coffee, and grain. (Carol Whitton, 694-5287).

Brazil is important, but not crucial, to U.S. agricultural trade--In 1998 Brazil is the 21st largest market for U.S. agricultural exports, but it is fifth largest among Latin American markets. In recent years, Brazil has ranked higher, second in Latin America to Mexico. But in 1998 U.S. agricultural exports to Brazil have already declined somewhat even prior to the recent currency devaluation. The largest U.S. agricultural export to Brazil is live baby chicks, but the 1.5 million baby chicks exported account for only 3 percent of total U.S. baby chick sales. Rice exports also are large; the 634,000 tons of rice exports to Brazil in 1998 are 18 percent of total U.S. rice export volume.

Brazil is slightly more important as a source of U.S. agricultural imports. It ranks as the eighth largest U.S. import supplier in January-November 1998 and third largest Latin American supplier. It accounts for 52 percent of the value of U.S. orange juice imports and 61 percent of volume. The U.S. also imports from Brazil prepared and preserved beef or veal, lemon juice, sugar, coffee, and tobacco.
