

# Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

## March 2015 Report

The March WASDE report shows fiscal year (FY) 2015 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 99,208 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. The country details are shown on Table 3.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2015 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 22,050 metric tons raw value (MTRV) on April 10, 2015. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.

FY 2015 raw sugar imports under the Re-Export Program to date totaled 250,930 MTRV, about 69 percent of projected imports for FY 2015.
