

Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

June 2015 Report

The June WASDE report shows fiscal year (FY) 2015 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 41,105 short tons raw value (STRV), down 58,103 STRV from last month. Projected shortfall for FY 2016 is unchanged.

On June 8, USTR reallocated 157,937 metric tons raw value (MTRV) of the original WTO raw sugar TRQ quantity from those countries that have stated they do not plan to fill their FY 2015 allocated raw sugar quantities (see Table 3B).
