

# **Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports**

## **Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Report**

### **August 2016**

The August WASDE report shows FY 2016 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 89,988 short tons raw value (STRV), up 14,988 from last month. No information available about specific countries.

The FY 2017 WTO raw sugar TRQ shortfall projected at 99,208 STRV, unchanged from last month. No information available about specific countries.
