August Farm Prices Received Index Decreased 2 Points From Last Month

The preliminary All Farm Products Index of Prices Received by Farmers in August, at 139 percent, based on 1990-92=100, decreased 2 points (1.4 percent) from July. The Crop Index is down 2 points (1.4 percent) and the Livestock Index decreased 1 point (0.7 percent). Producers received lower prices for onions, corn, broilers, and eggs. Higher commodity prices were received for wheat, cattle, strawberries, and broccoli. The overall index is also affected by the seasonal change based on a 3-year average mix of commodities producers sell. Increased average marketings of cattle, grapes, calves, and sweet corn offset decreased marketings of wheat, hay, milk, and broilers.

The preliminary All Farm Products Index is up 20 points (17 percent) from August 2006. The Food Commodities Index, at 142, decreased 1 point (0.7 percent) from last month but increased 19 points (15 percent) from August 2006.

Prices Paid Index Unchanged

The August Index of Prices Paid for Commodities and Services, Interest, Taxes, and Farm Wage Rates (PPITW) is 158 percent of the 1990-92 average. The index is unchanged from July but 9 points (6.0 percent) above August 2006. Higher prices for complete feeds, feed concentrates, feeder cattle, and feeder pigs offset lower prices in August for gasoline, feed grains, feed supplements, and mixed fertilizers.

Program Change: Canola added to the monthly price program beginning July 2007.

Prices Received by Farmers

The August All Farm Products Index is 139 percent of its 1990-92 base, down 1.4 percent from the July index but 17 percent above the August 2006 index.

ALL CROPS: The August index is 139, down 1.4 percent from July but 11 percent above August 2006. Index decreases for potatoes & dry beans, cotton, feed grains & hay, and oil crops more than offset the index increases for food grains and fruit & nuts.

Food Grains: The August index, at 191, is 11 percent above the previous month and 46 percent above a year ago. The August all wheat price, at \$5.85 per bushel, is up 68 cents from July and \$1.94 above August 2006.

Feed Grains & Hay: The August index is 150, down 2.6 percent from last month but 40 percent above a year ago. The corn price, at \$3.17 per bushel, is down 15 cents from last month but \$1.08 above August 2006. The all hay price, at \$132 per ton, is up \$1.00 from July and up \$26.00 from last August. Sorghum grain, at \$5.89 per cwt, is 37 cents above July and \$1.54 above August last year.

Oil-Bearing Crops: The August index, at 134, is down 1.5 percent from July but 43 percent higher than August 2006. The soybean price, at \$7.49 per bushel, decreased 7 cents from July but is \$2.26 above August 2006.

Cotton: The August index, at 74, is down 3.9 percent from July and 2.6 percent below last year. The August price, at 44.9 cents per pound, is down 1.6 cents from the previous month and 0.9 cent below last August.

Potatoes & Dry Beans: The August index, at 137, is down 6.2 percent from last month but unchanged from August 2006. The all potato price, at \$7.98 per cwt, is down 50 cents from July and 25 cents from last August. The all dry bean price, at \$26.40 per cwt, is down \$2.10 from the previous month but \$6.90 above August 2006.

Fruits & Nuts: The August index, at 153, is up 2.0 percent from July but 5.0 percent lower than a year ago. Price increases for strawberries, apples, and grapes more than offset price decreases for peaches, pears, and grapefruit.

Commercial Vegetables: The August index, at 129, is unchanged from last month but 15 percent below August 2006. Price increases during August for broccoli, lettuce, and snap beans offset price declines for onions, sweet corn, and tomatoes.

LIVESTOCK & PRODUCTS: The August index, at 139, is 0.7 percent below last month but up 22 percent from August 2006. Compared with a year ago, prices are higher for milk, broilers, eggs, cattle, turkeys, and hogs. The price for calves is down from last year.

Meat Animals: The August index, at 122, is up 1.7 percent from last month and 2.5 percent higher than last year. The August hog price, at \$53.20 per cwt, is up \$1.00 from July and \$1.60 higher than a year ago. The August beef cattle price of \$90.50 per cwt is up \$1.30 from last month and \$3.30 higher than August 2006.

Dairy Products: The August index, at 166, is unchanged from a month ago but 80 percent higher than August last year. The August all milk price of \$21.70 per cwt is unchanged from last month but up \$9.70 from August 2006. The fluid grade milk price is unchanged but the manufacturing grade milk price is down 40 cents from the previous month. The July all milk price of \$21.70 is a new record high, up \$1.50 from the previous record high of \$20.20 set in June 2007.

Poultry & Eggs: The August index, at 153, is down 2.5 percent from July but 24 percent above a year ago. The August market egg price, at 71.6 cents per dozen, decreased 9.6 cents from July but is 34.4 cents above August 2006. The August broiler price, at 50.0 cents per pound, is down 1.0 cent from July but 8.0 cents above a year ago. The August turkey price, at 57.7 cents per pound, is up 2.2 cents from the previous month and 9.1 cents from a year earlier.

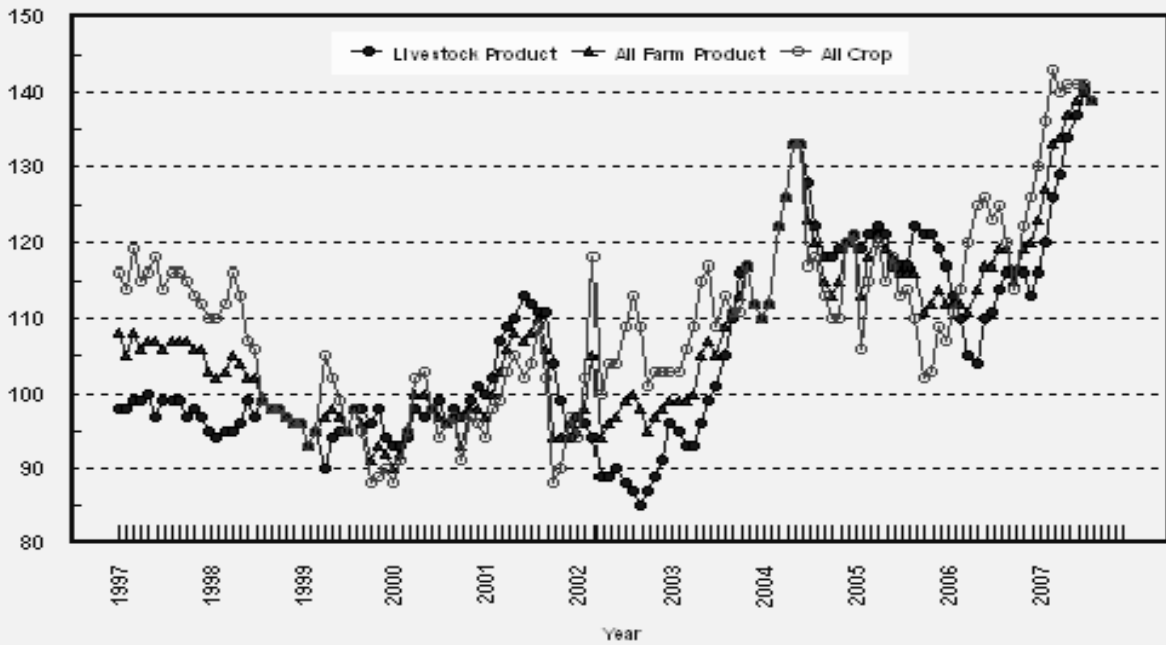

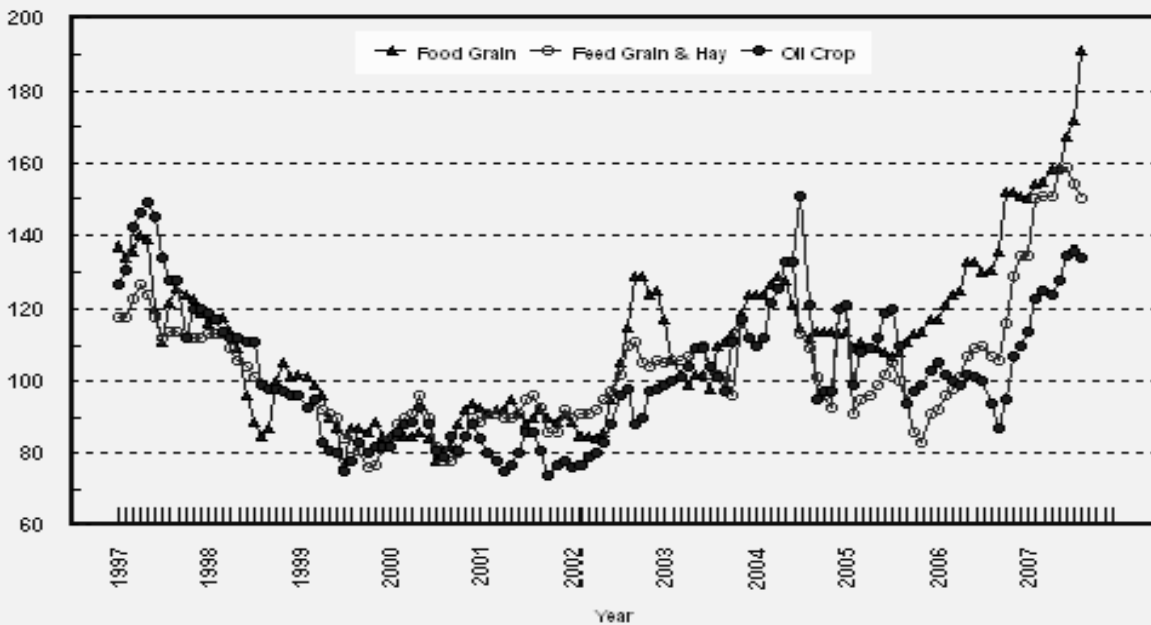
Prices Received, Major Indexes, US

Percent (1990-92=100)



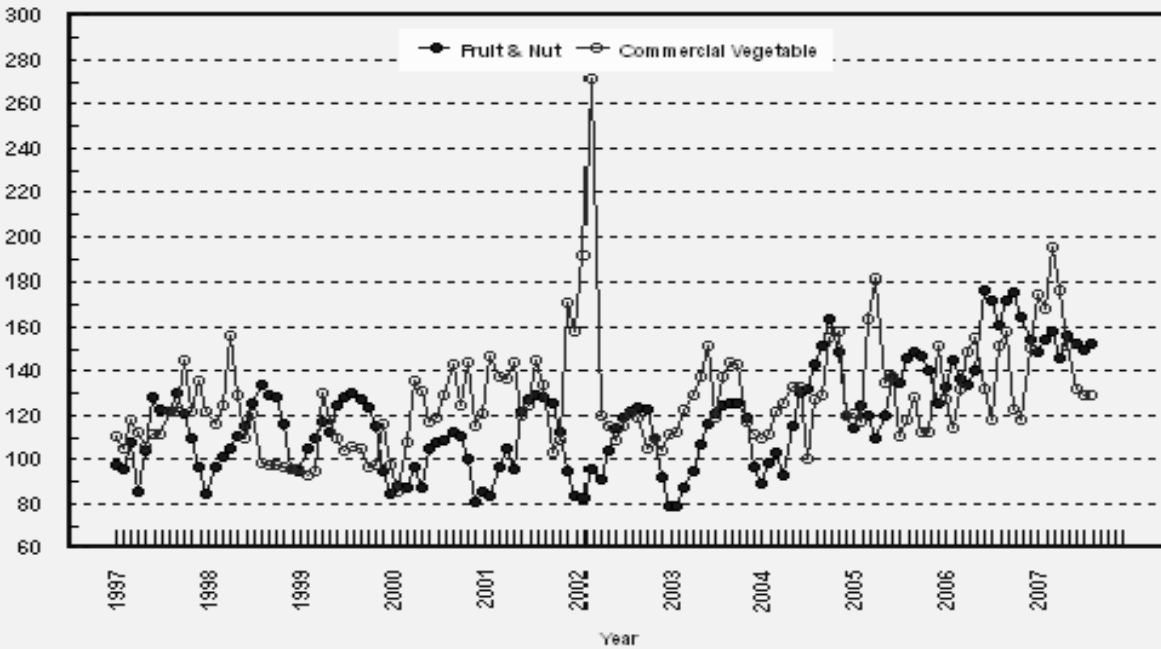

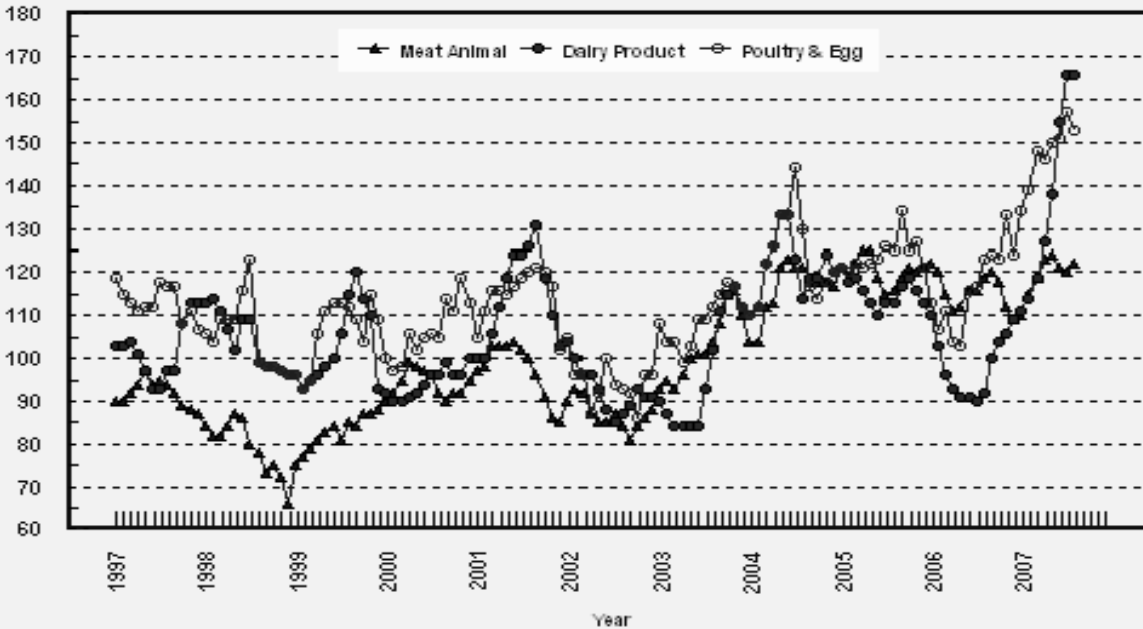
Prices Received, Fruit and Vegetable Indexes, US

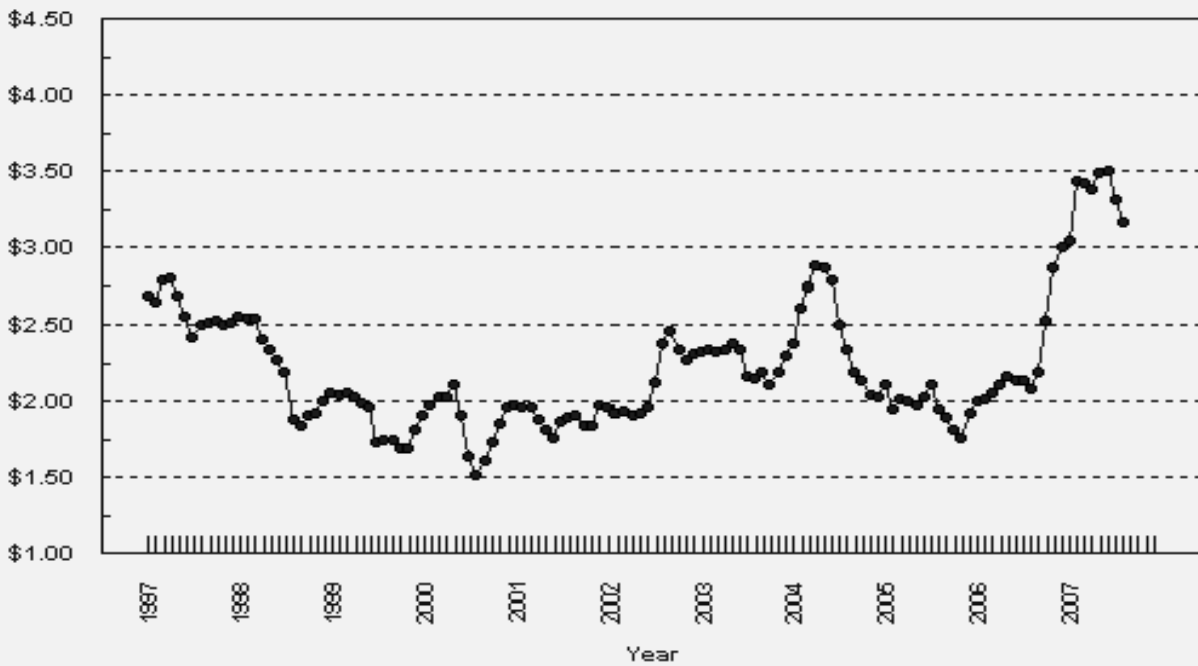

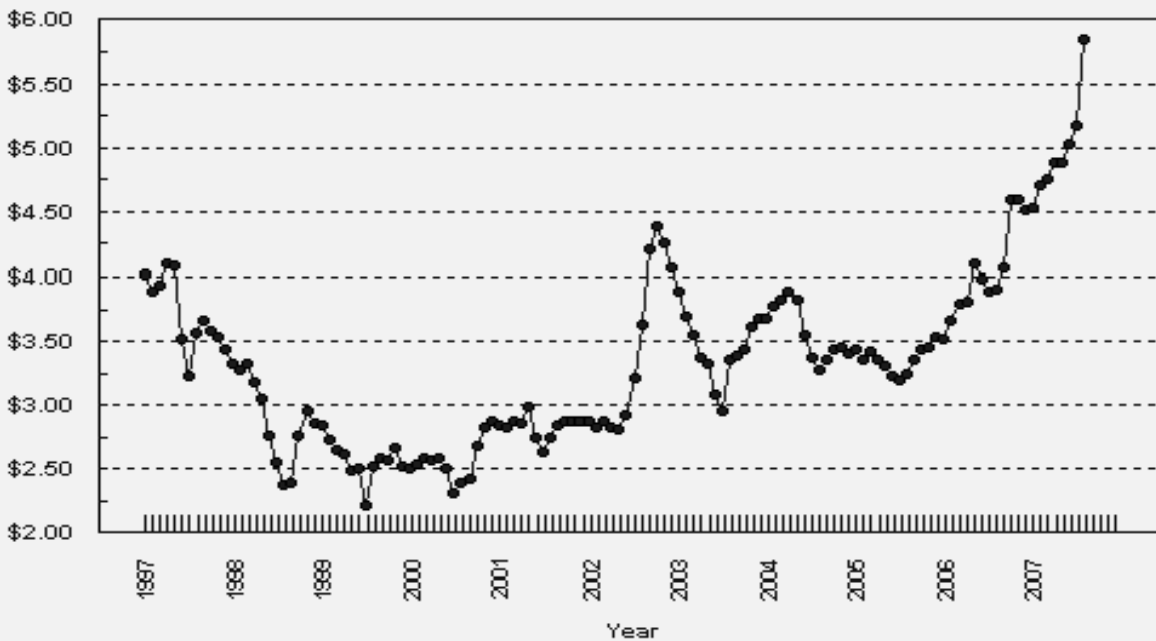
Prices Received, Corn, US

Dollars per Bu



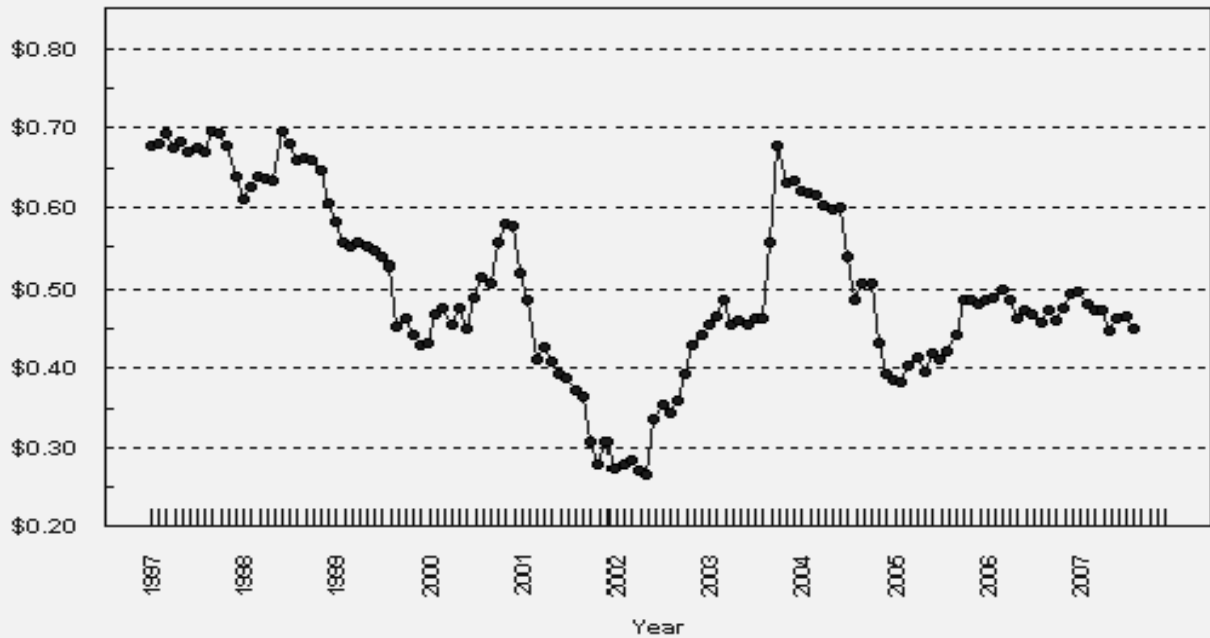
Prices Received, Wheat, US

Dollars per Bu



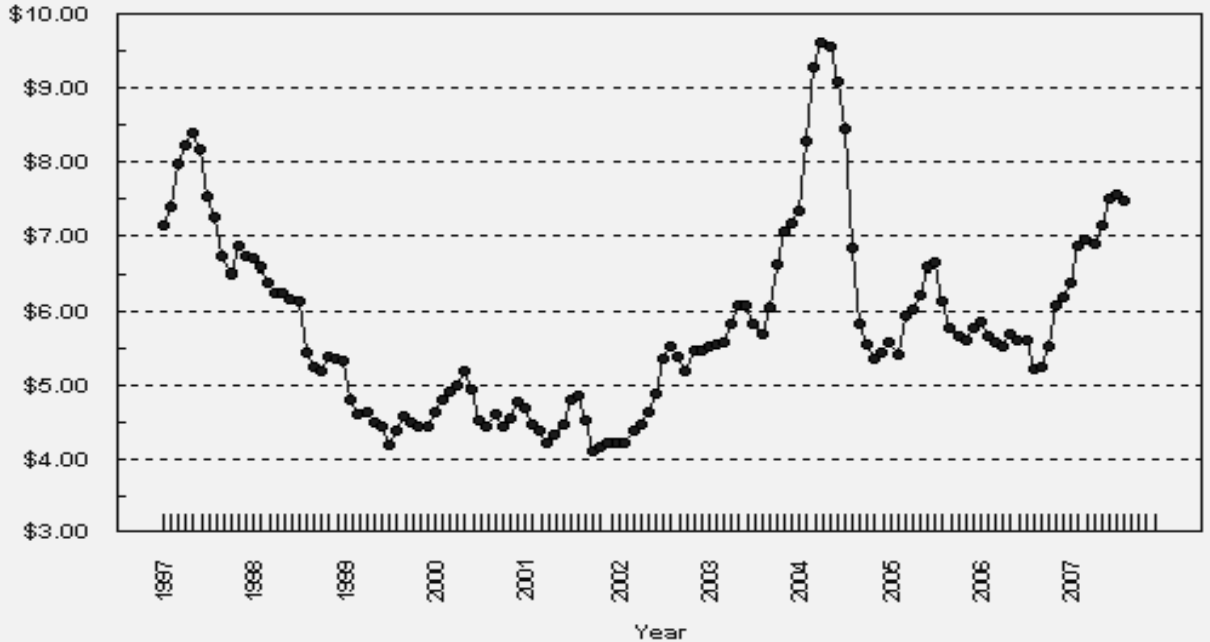
Prices Received, Cotton, US

Dollars per Lb



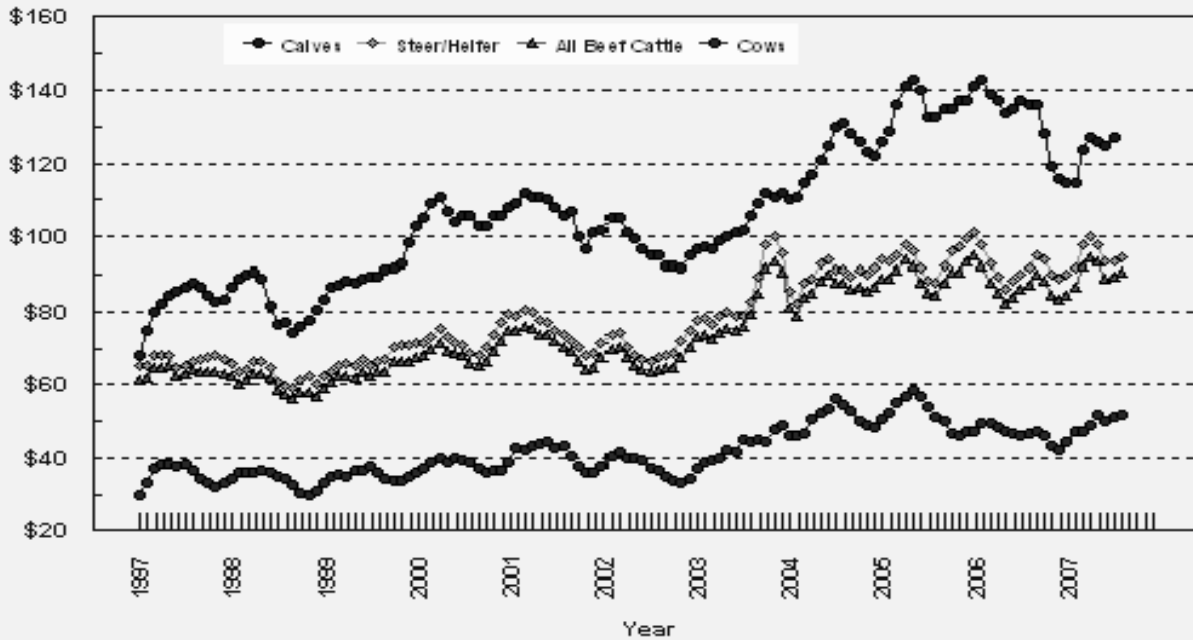
Prices Received, Soybeans, US

Dollars per Bu



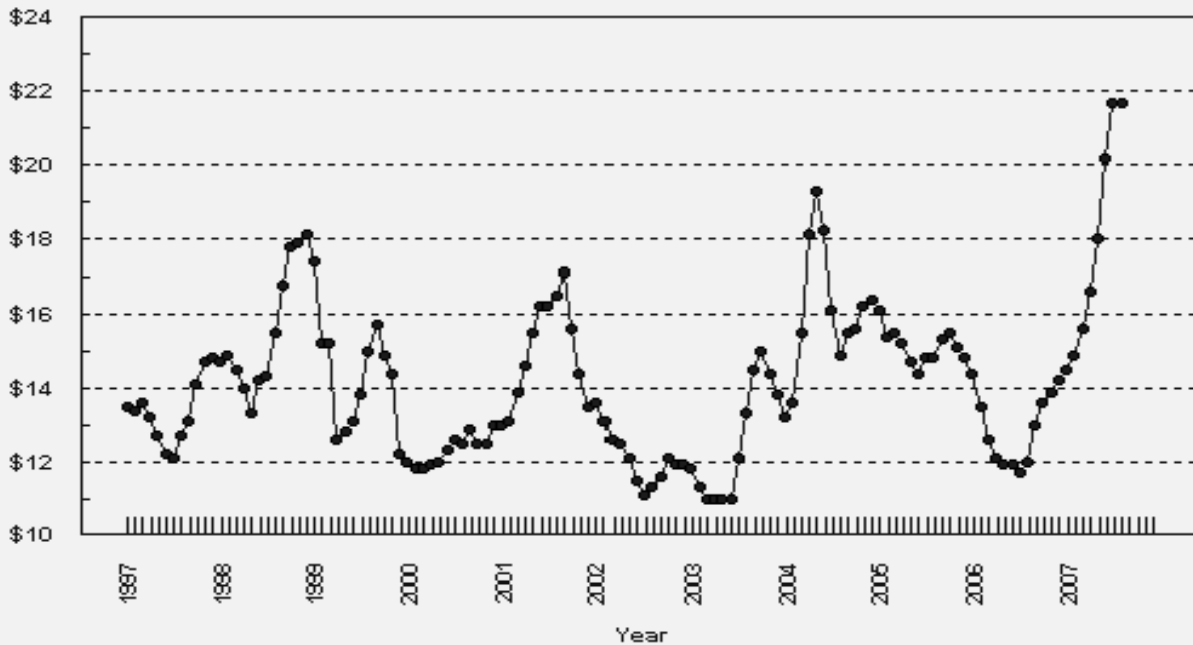
Prices Received, Cattle, US

Dollars per Cwt



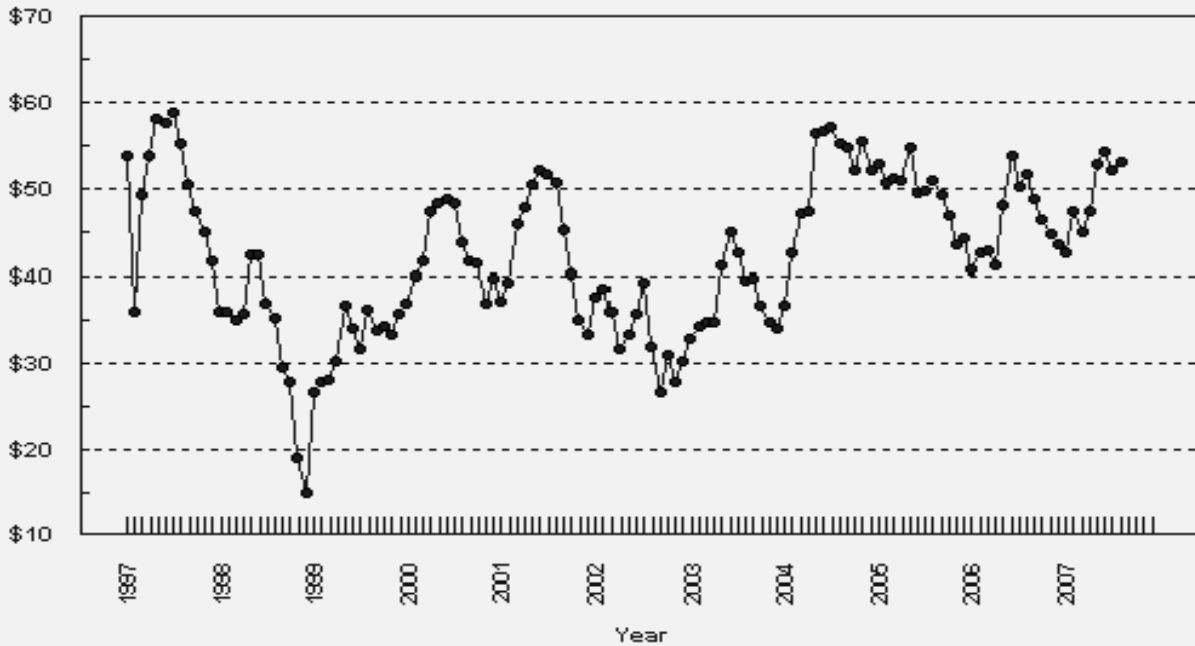
Prices Received, Milk, US

Dollars per Cwt



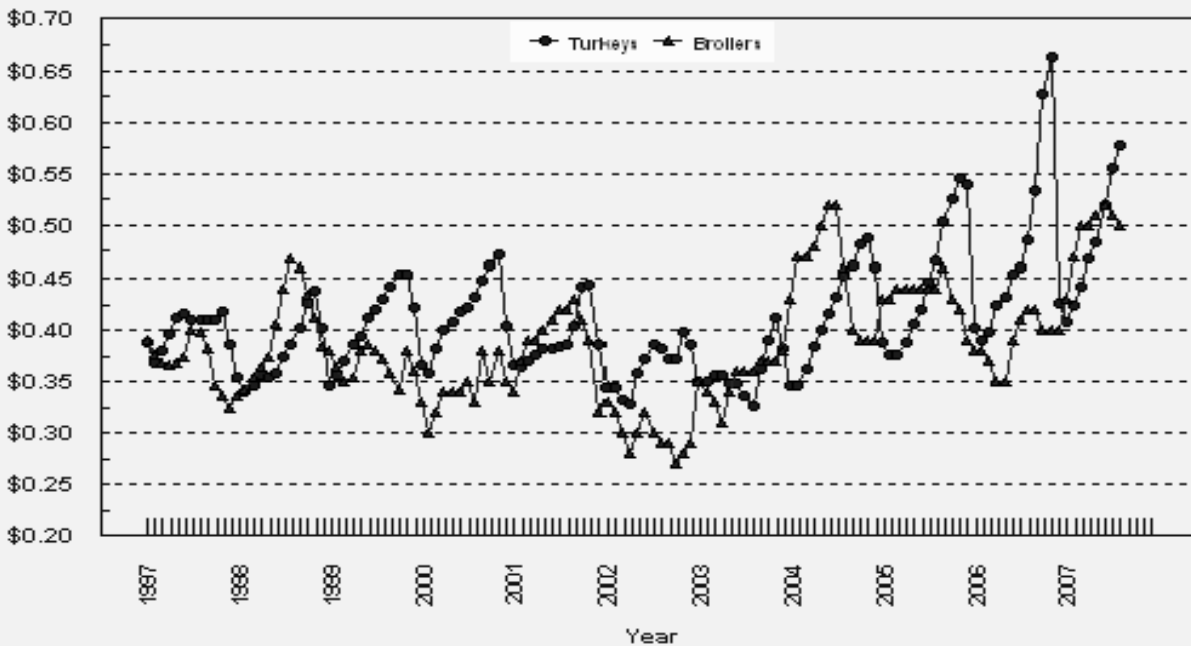
Prices Received, Hogs, US

Reliability of Prices Received Estimates

Definition: Prices received represent sales from producers to first buyers. They include all grades and qualities. The average commodity price from the survey multiplied by the total quantity marketed theoretically should give the total cash receipts for the commodity.

Survey Procedures: Primary sales data used to determine grain prices were obtained from probability samples of about 2000 mills and elevators. These procedures ensure that virtually all grain moving into commercial channels has a chance of being included in the survey. Generally, States surveyed account for 90 percent or more of total U.S. production. Livestock prices are obtained from packers, stockyards, auctions, dealers, and market check data from AMS-USDA, private marketing organizations, and state commodity groups and agencies. Inter-farm sales of grain and livestock are not included since they represent very small percentages of the total marketings. Grain marketed for seed is also excluded. Fruit and vegetable prices are obtained from sample surveys and market check data from AMS-USDA, private marketing organizations, state agencies, and universities.

Summary and Estimation Procedures: Survey quantities sold are expanded by strata to state levels and used to weight average strata prices to a state average. State prices are then weighted to a U.S. price based on expanded marketings. Recommendations are prepared by the State Field Offices and reviewed by the Agricultural Statistics Board in Washington, D.C. State recommendations are reviewed for reasonableness with survey data, other States, and recent historic estimates.

Revisions: For most items, the current month's preliminary price represents a 3-5 day period around the 15th of the month. Previous month's prices represent actual dollars received for quantities sold during the entire month. Revisions are published in monthly issues of *Agricultural Prices*.

Reliability: U.S. price estimates based on probability surveys generally have a sampling error of less than one percent for the major commodities such as corn, wheat, soybeans, cotton, and rice. Current methods of summarization for non-probability commodities are not designed directly to calculate sampling errors. However, analytical measures approximate the U.S. relative sampling errors at around five percent. Any nonsampling errors are attributed to such things as the inability to obtain correct information, differences in interpreting questions or definitions, mistakes in coding or processing the data, etc. Efforts are made at each step in the survey process to minimize these nonsampling errors.

Prices Paid by Farmers

The August Index of Prices Paid for Commodities and Services, Interest, Taxes, and Farm Wage Rates (PPITW) at 158 (1990-92=100), is unchanged from July 2007 but up 6.0 percent from August 2006.

PRODUCTION INDEX: The August index, at 158, increased 0.6 percent from last month and 7.5 percent from last year. Higher prices for complete feeds, feed concentrates, feeder cattle, and feeder pigs more than offset lower prices in August for gasoline, feed grains, feed supplements, and mixed fertilizers.

Feed: The August index, at 151, increased 1.3 percent from July and 26 percent from last August. Since July, higher prices for complete feeds, feed concentrates, and hay & forages offset lower prices for feed grains and feed supplements.

Livestock & Poultry: The August index, at 135, increased 1.5 percent from last month but decreased 0.7 percent from last year. The August feeder cattle price, at \$113.20 per cwt, is up \$1.20 per cwt from the July price. August feeder pigs averaged \$110.00 per cwt, up \$8.00 per cwt from July.

Fertilizer: The August index, at 211, is up 0.5 percent from July and 25 percent above August a year ago. Since July, higher prices for nitrogen and potash & phosphate more than offset lower prices for mixed fertilizers.

Chemicals: The August index, at 130, is unchanged from July but increased 0.8 percent from last August.

Fuels: The August index, at 262, is down 1.1 percent from a month earlier and 3.0 percent below August 2006. Compared with last month, prices are lower for gasoline and LP gas but higher for diesel fuel.

Machinery: The August index, at 189, is unchanged from July but 3.8 percent above last August.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX: The July 2007 Consumer Price Index, as issued by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, for all urban consumers (CPI-U) decreased slightly before seasonal adjustment to a level of 208.299 (1982-84=100). This compares with the June index of 208.352. For the 12-month period ending in July, the overall index increased 2.4 percent.

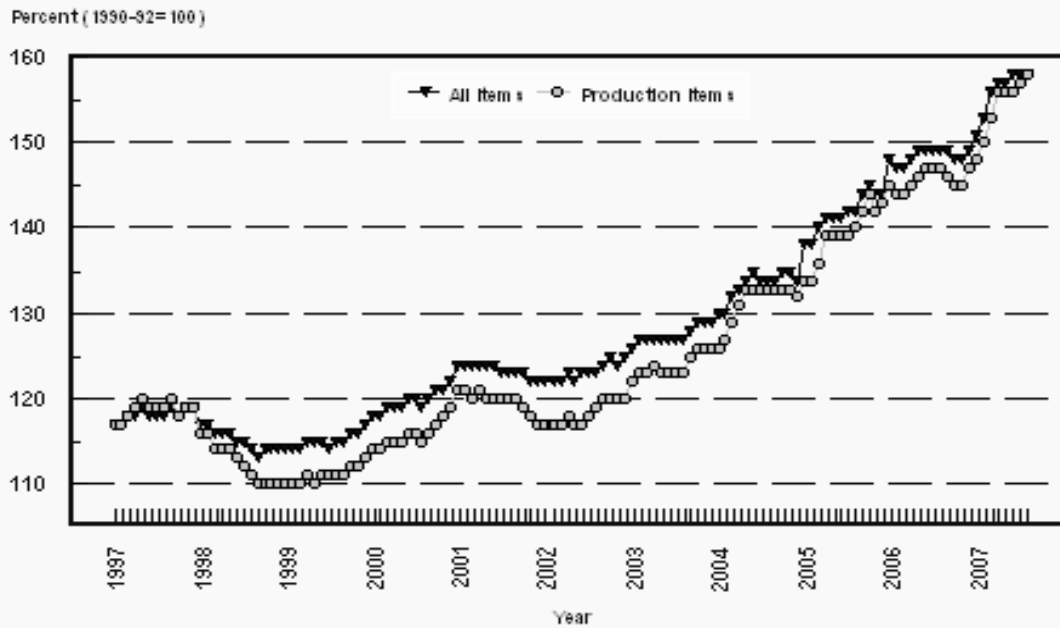

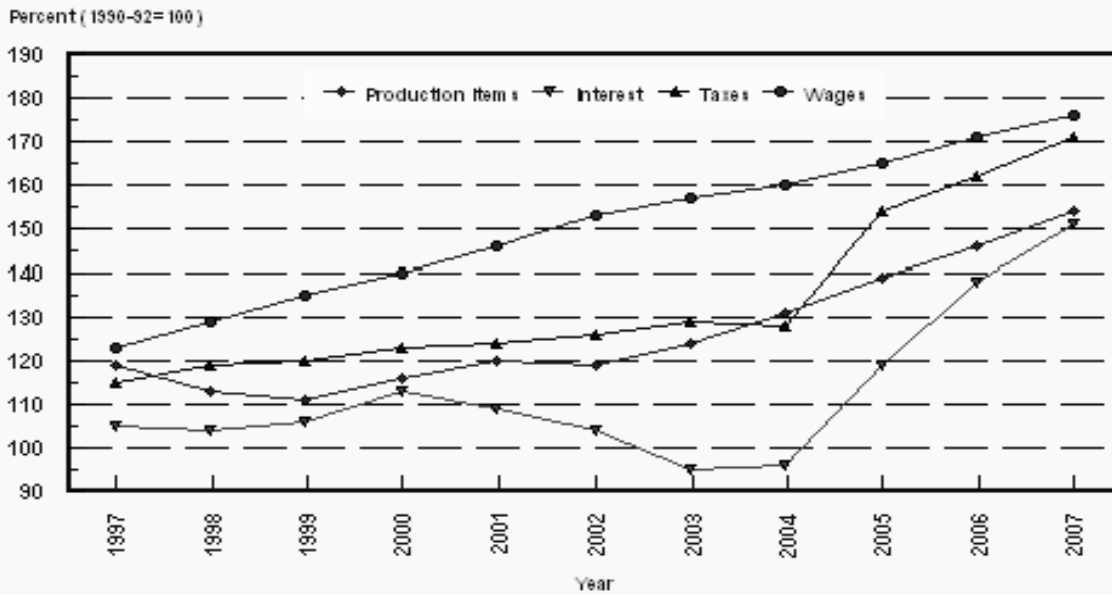

Prices Paid by Farmers, Major Indexes US, by Month

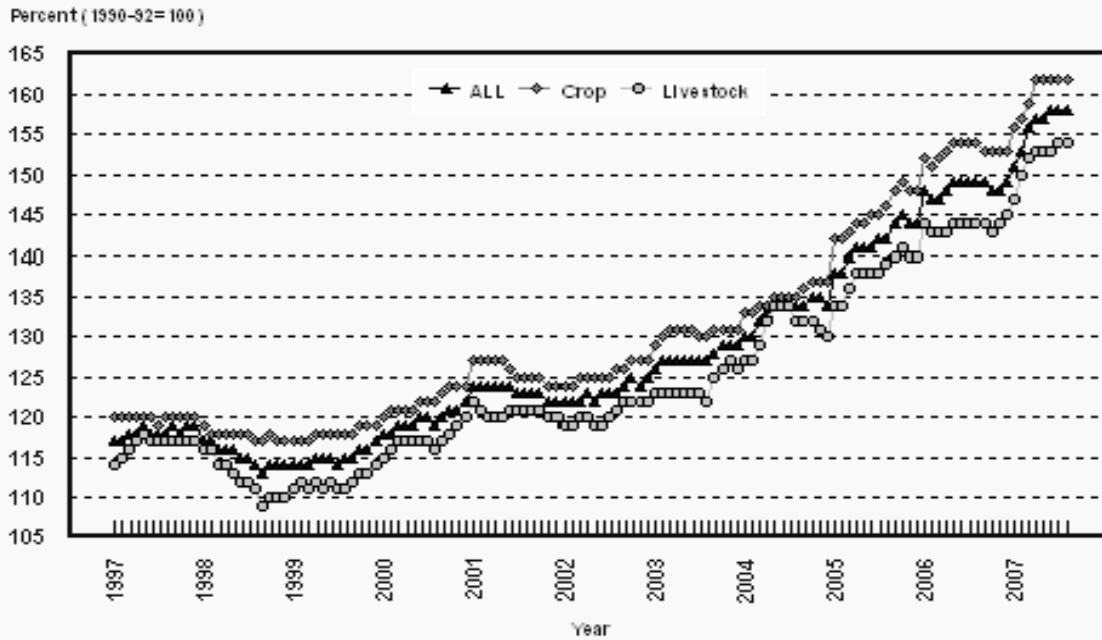


Prices Paid by Farmers, Major Indexes US, Annual Averages 1/

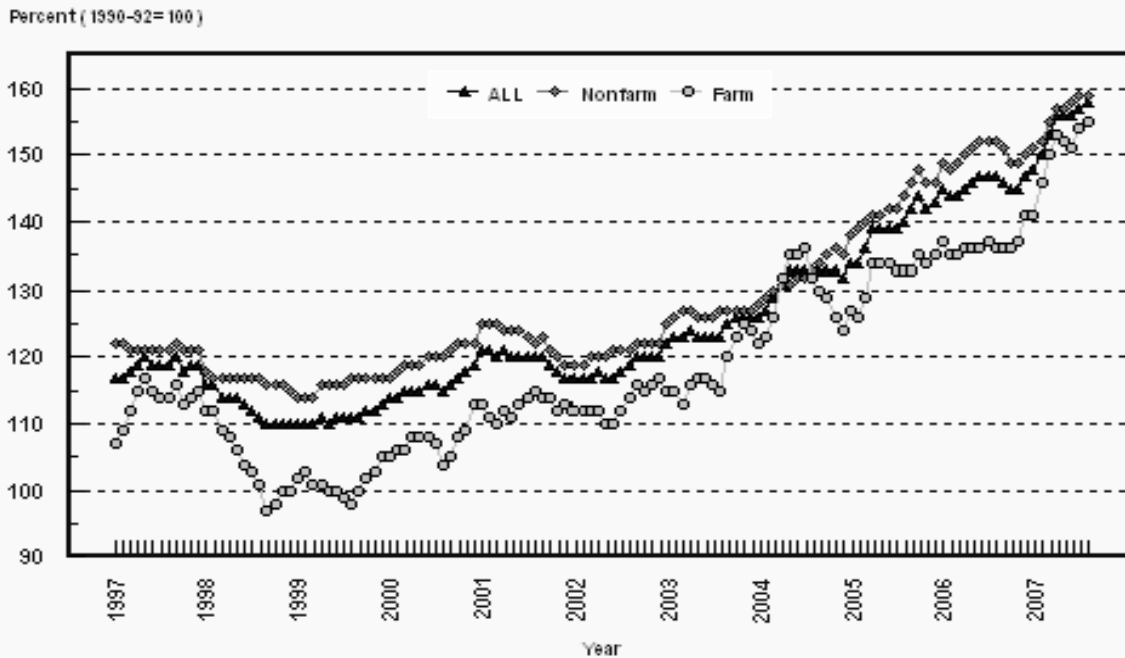

Prices Paid by Farmers, Indexes, All Items US, By Farm Type

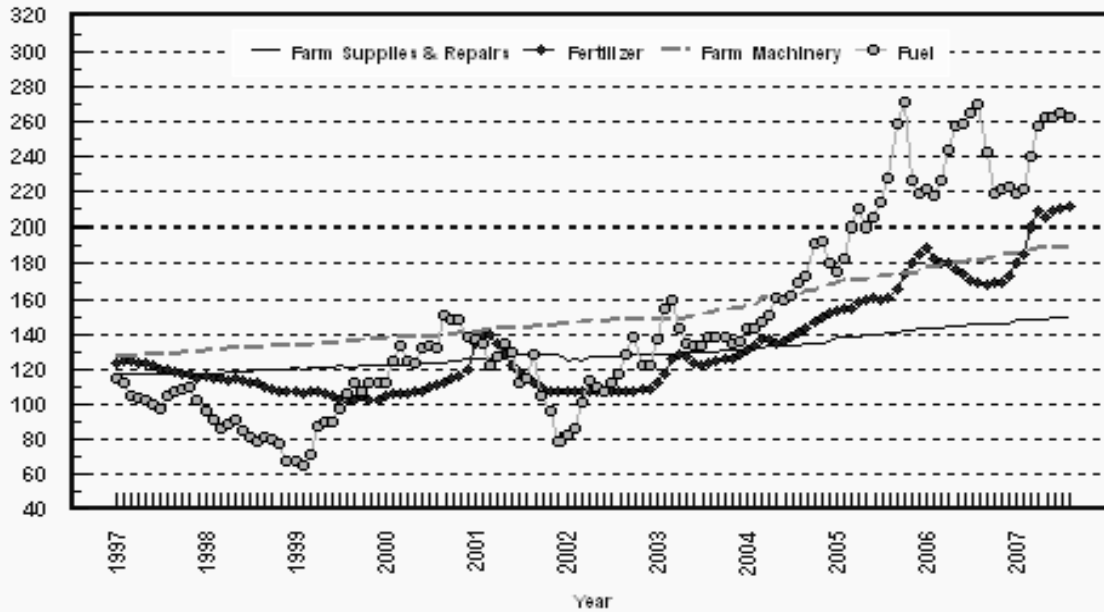


Prices Paid by Farmers, Indexes, All Production Items US, By Sector Origin



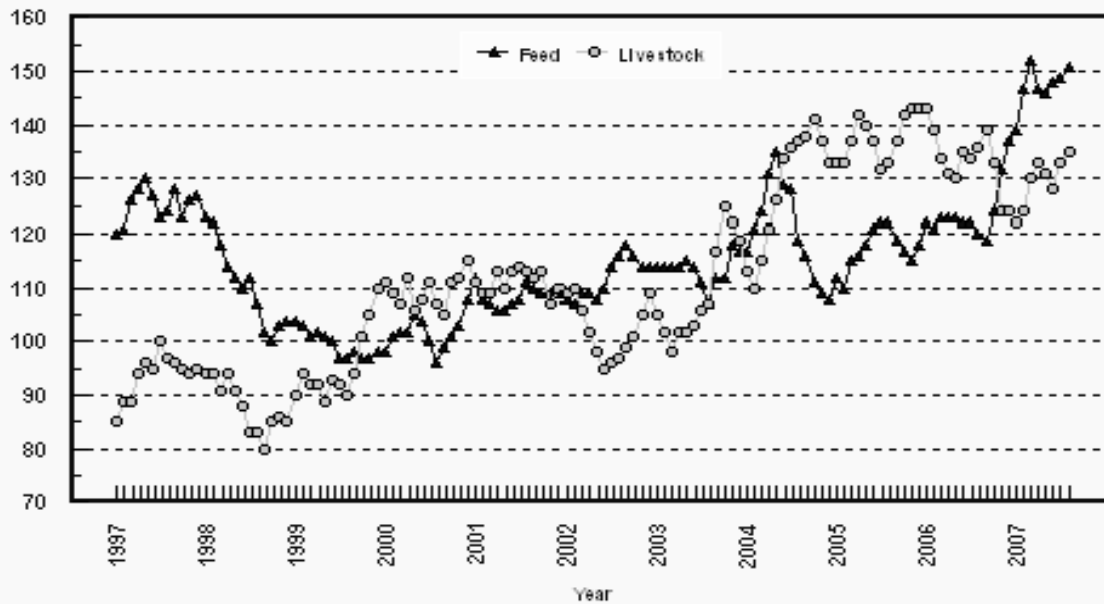
Prices Paid by Farmers, Selected Production Indexes US, By Non-Farm Sector

Prices Paid by Farmers

Definition: Prices paid by farmers represent the average costs of inputs purchased by farmers and ranchers to produce agricultural commodities. Conceptually, the average price when multiplied by quantity purchased should equal total producer expenditures for the item.

Survey Procedures: The prices paid data are obtained from establishments that sell goods and services to farmers and ranchers. Annually, about 8,500 firms are randomly selected from lists by type of item sold with an average response rate in the range of 75-80 percent. Firms are asked to report the price for the specified item "most commonly bought by farmers" or that was the "volume seller". Approximately 135 items are surveyed each April to represent all production input items purchased. The survey reference period for most items is the 5 business days centered around the 15th of the month. Separate prices paid surveys are conducted for agricultural chemicals, fuels, feed, fertilizer, machinery, and seed.

Summary and Estimation Procedures: The annual April Prices Paid Survey is summarized as a nonprobability survey. Average prices reported are aggregated to the region and U.S. level using weights available from expenditure data and other administrative sources. Price recommendations are prepared by the State Field Offices and Headquarters for review by the Agricultural Statistics Board in Washington, D.C. Also, the change in price level for individual items surveyed are combined to the regional and U.S. levels, and are published as prices paid indexes referenced to a specific base period. Prices paid indexes for new autos and trucks, building materials, farm supplies, motor supplies, and marketing containers are updated based on price changes measured in selected Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) indexes.

Revisions: Any revisions are published in the monthly and in annual issues of *Agricultural Prices*. The basis for revision must be supported by additional data that directly affect the level of the estimate. More revisions are likely in April when separate prices paid surveys are conducted, in lieu of BLS indexes, by the USDA to measure price change.

Reliability: Current methods of summarization in April are not designed directly to calculate sampling errors. However, analytical measures approximate the U.S. relative sampling errors for major items around 10 percent. Any nonsampling errors are attributed to such things as the inability to obtain correct information, differences in interpreting questions or definitions, mistakes in coding or processing the data, etc. Efforts are made at each step in the survey process to minimize these nonsampling errors.

Program Change: Effective January 1, 1995, the National Agricultural Statistics Service updated the weights and changed the construction of its prices paid and received by farmers indexes. A Federal Register Notice dated October 28, 1994 discussed these program modifications.

A 1990-92 reference and base period replaced the 1977 reference and 1971-73 base weight period. Five-year moving average weights replaced the current fixed 1971-73 base period weights. The 1910-14=100 price indexes, required by statute for computing parity prices, were linked forward based on the changes in the new 1990-92=100 indexes. The new indexes were constructed by multiplying the ratios of the current prices to the base period prices by the moving average weights (adjusted for seasonal marketing patterns for the prices received indexes).
