JANUARY 1 ALL CATTLE AND CALVES INVENTORY DOWN 3 PERCENT:

All cattle and calves on hand in the United States on January 1, 1976 are estimated at 128.0 million head, 3 percent below a year earlier and down 9 percent from July 1, 1975, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the first decline in cattle inventory since January 1, 1967. Contributing to this decline was the record high commercial cattle and calf slaughter during 1975 of 46.1 million head, 16 percent above 1974.

-- All cows and heifers that have calved, at 54.8 million head, are down 3 percent from a year ago and 5 percent below July 1, 1975.

-- Beef cows at 43.7 million, are down 4 percent from a year earlier but 2 percent above January 1, 1974.

-- Milk cows at 11.1 million, are down 1 percent from a year earlier and 2 percent below January 1, 1974.

This report includes the number of Cattle and Calves on Feed as of January 1 by States and for the United States on page 9.

Other classes on January 1 and the change from last year and two years ago, respectively, are as follows:


- All heifers weighing 500 pounds and over - 18.6 million head, down 5 percent and 2 percent.
- Beef replacement heifers - 7.2 million, down 19 percent and 13 percent.
- Milk replacement heifers - 4.0 million, down 3 percent and up 1 percent.
- Other heifers - 7.4 million, up 14 percent and 8 percent. (Includes 4.0 million head in feedlots in the 23 major feeding States.)
- Steers weighing 500 pounds and over - 17.2 million, up 5 percent and down 4 percent. (Includes 8.3 million in feedlots in the 23 major feeding States.)
- Bulls weighing 500 pounds and over - 2.8 million, down 5 percent and up 8 percent.
- Heifers, steers and bulls under 500 pounds - 34.6 million, down 5 percent and up 2 percent.

Indicated death losses were above the 1974 level at 7.0 million head. This increase was due to adverse weather during the calving season last spring. Cattle and calves slaughtered on farms was indicated at 750,000 head in 1975 compared with 700,000 head in 1974. More complete disposition estimates will be published in "Meat Animals Production, Disposition and Income" to be released April 2, 1976.

CALF CROP DOWN 1 PERCENT:

The 1975 calf crop is estimated at 50.4 million, down 1 percent from the record high of 50.7 million in 1974 but 3 percent more than in 1973.
