


CATTLE ON FEED



CATTLE SOLD FOR SLAUGHTER--Selected Markets

April 1, 1964

April 16, 1964

On April 1, there were 8,265,000 cattle and calves on feed in 28 major feeding States for slaughter market, 1 percent more than a year earlier according to the Crop Reporting Board. In 32 States for which estimates are available this April, a total of 8,395,000 cattle and calves was on feed compared with a total of 9,085,000 head January 1, 1964, for these same States.

The number on feed in the 28 States declined 7 percent from January 1 to April 1 this year compared with a 9 percent decline for the same period in 1963.

NORTH CENTRAL STATES INCREASE 1 PERCENT

In the North Central region there were 5,463,000 cattle and calves on feed April 1 for slaughter market--1 percent more than the 5,392,000 on feed a year earlier. Ohio, Illinois, Wisconsin, and Nebraska had 2 to 9 percent fewer cattle on feed than for a year earlier while the numbers on feed in the other States were up from 1 to 14 percent from April 1, 1963. Iowa, the leading State, was up 4 percent; Missouri, South Dakota, and Kansas up 5 percent; Minnesota up 6 percent; and Indiana was up 14 percent.

WESTERN STATES UP 1 PERCENT

On April 1 there were 2,201,000 cattle and calves on feed in the 11 Western States for slaughter market--an increase of 1 percent from the 2,179,000 head on feed April 1 last year. California, the leading Western

State, had a decrease of 1 percent and Arizona, a decrease of 5 percent while Colorado had an increase of 3 percent from a year earlier. In the other Western States the numbers on feed compared with a year earlier ranged from 23 percent fewer in Wyoming to 30 percent more in Montana.

OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES

States in other regions showed the following changes in cattle feeding from April 1, 1963: Pennsylvania, up 5 percent; Georgia, up 46 percent; Alabama, down 8 percent; Oklahoma, up 11 percent; and Texas, down 3 percent.

PLACEMENTS UP 20 PERCENT--MARKETINGS UP 10 PERCENT

There were 3,427,000 cattle and calves placed on feed January through March in the 28 States compared with 2,846,000 head the same period in 1963--an increase of 20 percent. Shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into 8 Corn Belt States during January and February this year were up 48 percent from the same period in 1963. However, inshipments into these States during October, November, and December of 1963, some of which moved into feedlots after January 1, were down 9 percent from a year earlier.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during January through March were 4,059,000 head in the 28 States, 10 percent more than for the same period in 1963. The North Central States had an increase of 14 percent in marketings from a year earlier and the Western States were up 2 percent.

Beef steers and heifers (prime, choice, and good) sold out of first hands for slaughter at 14 livestock markets during January-March were up 12 percent from the same period in 1963. These data do not include direct sales to packing plants, mixed lots, and some deliveries bought on prior contract. Direct sales to packing plants comprise a higher proportion of the fed cattle marketings than in the past in a number of States.

WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

In the 28 States, there were fewer cattle and calves on feed April 1 weighing under 700 pounds, but more on feed weighing over 700 pounds than April 1 last year. Most of the increase in total numbers on feed from a year earlier was in steers and steer calves. The number of cattle and calves weighing less than 500 pounds was 595,000 head, down 12 percent; the 500-699 pound group was 2,728,000 head, down 7 percent; the 700-899 pound group totaled 2,473,000 head, up 9 percent; the 900-1,099 pound group totaled 1,923,000 head, an increase of 6 percent; and the over 1,100 pound group, at 546,000 head, showed an increase of 16 percent.

KINDS ON FEED

Steers and steer calves on feed April 1 in the 28 States totaled 6,017,000 head, 3 percent more than last year. Heifers and heifer calves, totaling 2,216,000 head, were down 2 percent from a year earlier, and cows and others, at 32,000 head, were 38 percent less than last year.

TIME ON FEED

In the 28 States, the number on feed under 3 months, at 3,346,000 head, was up 21 percent from April 1 last year. The 3-6 month group, with 4,278,000 head, was down 9 percent from a year ago, and those on feed more than 6 months, 641,000 head, were down 7 percent.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders in the 28 States plan to market 4,098,000 head during April, May, and June. If these intentions are carried out, marketings will be 6 percent greater than for this period last year. A breakdown of anticipated marketings of April 1 numbers on feed show 37 percent to be marketed in April, 31 percent in May, and 32 percent in June. Expected marketings, as published, are based upon the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

MARCH MARKETINGS FOR 14 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers, marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 14 markets during March 1964, totaled 602,000 head compared with 500,962 head a year earlier--an increase of 20 percent. Steers accounted for 75 percent of the total marketed in March compared with 73 percent in March 1963. The average weight for steers was 1,165 pounds, 32 pounds above March 1963 and heifers averaged 963 pounds, up 22 pounds from a year earlier.

Steers and heifers grading prime, choice and good totaled 557,696 head, 22 percent above March 1963.
