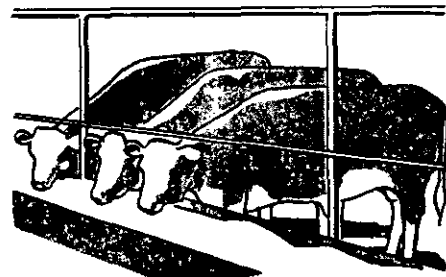

CATTLE ON FEED UP 11 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on July 1, 1966 in 32 major feeding States totaled 8,347,000 head, 11 percent more than a year earlier according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Increases from a year earlier were shown in the number on feed in all weight groups. The number placed on feed during the past quarter was 6 percent above the same quarter a year earlier. Marketings during this period were up 11 percent.

The July 1 number on feed was 13 percent below the number on feed April 1 this year compared with an 11 percent decrease for this same period last year.

NORTH CENTRAL REGION UP 9 PERCENT

On July 1 there were 5,041,000 cattle and calves on feed in the North Central States, 9 percent more than last year. Iowa and Nebraska, the leading States in this region, were up 2 percent and 16 percent, respectively. All States except Michigan showed increases, ranging from 1 percent in North Dakota to 38 percent in Kansas. Michigan was down 2 percent.

WESTERN STATES INCREASE 9 PERCENT

There were 2,449,000 cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 11 Western States on July 1--up 9 percent from a year earlier. Increases were shown in all States except Arizona. California, the leading Western State, was up 10 percent. Other increases ranged from 4 percent in Utah to 40 percent in New Mexico. Arizona had 3 percent fewer cattle on feed than on July 1 last year.

OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES

The nine other cattle feeding States had 857,000 cattle and calves on feed July 1 -- up 33 percent from last year. Texas, the major feeding State in the group, showed an increase of 45 percent. Pennsylvania, Georgia, Tennessee, Alabama, and Oklahoma also had more cattle on feed, while Florida, Kentucky, and Mississippi had fewer.

PLACEMENTS AND MARKETINGS UP

Cattle and calves placed on feed in the 32 States during April-June totaled 3,632,000 head, an increase of 6 percent from the same period in 1965. Placements were up 11 percent in the North Central States, but down 3 percent in the Western States. Shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into 8 Corn Belt States during April and May were up 28 percent from the same period in 1965.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the second quarter totaled 4,830,000 head -- 11 percent above the same period in 1965. Fed cattle marketings were up 14 percent in the North Central States and 2 percent in the Western States.

Total slaughter of steers and heifers under Federal Inspection during the April-June quarter was up 9 percent from a year earlier.

Beef steers and heifers (prime, choice and good) sold out of first hands for slaughter at 15 livestock markets during April-June were down 2 percent from the same period in 1965. These data do not include direct sales to packing plants, mixed lots, and some deliveries bought on prior contract.

WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

The July 1 number of cattle and calves on feed in the 32 States by weight groups showed a larger number than a year earlier in all groups. The number in each weight group and percentage change from July 1 last year are as follows: under 500 pounds, 327,000 head, up 17 percent; 500-699 pounds, 1,971,000 head, up 15 percent; 700-899 pounds, 3,685,000 head, up 7 percent; 900-1099 pounds, 2,018,000 head, up 15 percent; 1,100 or more pounds, 346,000 head, up 9 percent.

KINDS ON FEED

Cattle feeders had 5,769,000 steers and steer calves on feed July 1, 1966 -- up 10 percent from a year earlier. Heifers and heifer calves, at 2,548,000 head, were up 15 percent. Cows on feed totaled 30,000 head on July 1 compared with 26,000 a year earlier.

TIME ON FEED

Cattle and calves on feed less than 3 months totaled 3,475,000 -- 6 percent above a year earlier. The total on feed 3-6 months, at 2,963,000 head, was up 23

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percent. Cattle on feed 6 months or longer totaled 1,909,000 head, up 4 percent.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Of the July 1 number on feed, cattle feeders intend to market 4,664,000 head during July, August, and September. This would be 11 percent above July-September marketings last year from July 1 numbers. Intentions are to market 29 percent of the 3 - month total during July, 35 percent during August, and 36 percent during September. Expected marketings are based on the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

JUNE MARKETINGS FOR 15 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 15 livestock markets during June 1966 totaled 517,090 head, 13 percent less than during June 1965. Steers accounted for 357,678 head, 17 percent less than a year earlier. Heifers totaled 159,412 head, down 2 percent.

Steers and heifers marketed in the prime, choice and good grades totaled 489,121 head, down 12 percent from June 1965.
