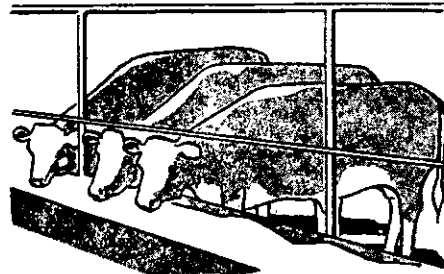

## CATTLE ON FEED UP 7 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in 39 feeding States totaled 11,279,000 head as of January 1, 1967, an increase of 7 percent from a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The 32 major feeding States had 11,136,000 head on feed for slaughter market compared with 10,436,000 head on January 1, 1966. There were 143,000 head on feed in 5 Atlantic and 2 South Central States, down 2 percent from January 1, 1966.

## NORTH CENTRAL STATES 7 PERCENT HIGHER

On January 1, 1967, there were 7,142,000 cattle and calves on feed in the North Central States, 7 percent more than a year earlier. Iowa, the leading State, was up 14 percent, and Nebraska, the second ranking State, was up 7 percent. Indiana, Illinois, Missouri and North Dakota showed decreases, but all other States in this region were above a year earlier.

## WESTERN STATES UP 4 PERCENT

In the 11 Western States, cattle on feed for slaughter market totaled 2,774,000 head on January 1 this year, 4 percent more than a year earlier. California, the leading Western State, and Colorado, the second ranking State, were each up 3 percent. The number on feed in Montana, Wyoming, Utah and Oregon for slaughter market was down from a year earlier, but all other Western States reported increases.

## OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES SHOW LARGE GAIN

The number of cattle on feed for slaughter market in feeding States outside the North Central and Western States showed a gain of 12 percent from

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January 1 a year ago. Texas and Oklahoma, the leading States in this group, were up 25 and 32 percent, respectively.

#### FOURTH QUARTER PLACEMENTS AND MARKETINGS UP

In the 32 major feeding States the number of cattle and calves placed on feed during the fourth quarter of 1966 was 7,720,000 head, a 5 percent increase over the same period in 1965. Placements were 6 percent larger in the North Central States but 1 percent lower in the Western region. Recorded shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into the 8 Corn Belt States during October and November were up 3 percent from the same period of 1965.

Marketings of grain fed cattle for slaughter from the 32 States during the October-December quarter totaled 5,008,000 head, 8 percent more than a year earlier. North Central region marketings were up 10 percent from last year, but marketings in the Western region were down 1 percent. The number of slaughter steers and heifers, grading good or better, sold out of first hand at 15 principal markets during October-December was down 6 percent. These data do not include direct sales to packing plants, mixed lots, and some deliveries bought on prior contract.

#### WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

A breakdown of the cattle on feed in the 32 States January 1, 1967, by weight groups indicates a 4 percent increase for those weighing less than 900 pounds, and the number weighing more than 900 pounds is up 14 percent from a year earlier. The number in each weight group and percentage comparisons with a year earlier are as follows: under 500 pounds, 1,872,000, up 2 percent; 500-699 pounds, 2,730,000, down 2 percent; 700-899, pounds, 3,699,000, up 11 percent; 900-1,099 pounds, 2,381,000, up 14 percent; 1,100 pounds and over, 454,000, up 16 percent.

#### KINDS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed in the 32 States totaled 7,853,000 head, an 8 percent increase from January 1, 1966. There were 3,222,000 heifers and heifer calves on feed, 5 percent more than a year earlier. There were 61,000 cows and others on feed, down 2 percent.

#### TIME ON FEED

The number on feed less than 3 months in the 32 States totaled 7,521,000 head, 6 percent above January 1, 1966. Those on feed 3-6 months numbered 2,912,000 head, up 7 percent from January last year. The over 6-months group, at 703,000 head, was up 17 percent.

## MARKETING INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders in the 32 major States intend to market 5,245,000 head during the January-March period. This would be 8 percent more than actual marketings for the same period a year earlier. Intentions in the Western States point to a 4 percent increase in January-March marketings. Feeders in the North Central States plan 9 percent more marketings. A breakdown of anticipated marketings during the January-March quarter shows 32 percent to be marketed during January, 33 percent in February, and 35 percent in March. Expected marketings, as published, are based on the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

## DECEMBER MARKETINGS FOR 15 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 15 markets during December 1966, numbered 461,803 head, down 7 percent from the 496,028 a year earlier. Steers accounted for 68 percent of the total marketed during the month, 1 percentage point lower than December 1965. The average weight for steers was 1,140 pounds, 23 pounds above December 1965. Heifers averaged 963 pounds, up 29 pounds.

Steers and heifers grading prime, choice, and good totaled 1,320,247 head for the October-December quarter, 6 percent below the comparable period in 1965.

The cattle and calves on feed estimates for 1959 through 1965 have been revised in conjunction with the 5-year revision program for all cattle and calves. Information on sales of cattle and calves fattened on grains and concentrates from the 1964 Census, marketing data, and other information which became available after the original estimates were made necessitated revising cattle and calves on feed estimates for some States for all or part of the 1959-65 period.

Revised estimates by States for the years 1959-65 are shown in Statistical Bulletin 387 "Cattle on Feed and Sheep on Feed," U.S. Department of Agriculture, Statistical Reporting Service. This bulletin is available on request.
