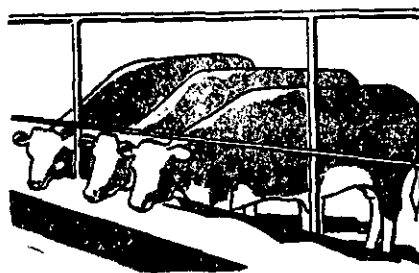

## CATTLE ON FEED UP 2 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on October 1, 1967 in 32 major feeding States is estimated at 8,566,000 head, 2 percent more than a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The increase in the number of cattle and calves on feed was in those that weighed less than 700 pounds -- up 13 percent. The number on feed weighing over 700 pounds declined 3 percent. Fed cattle marketings during the past quarter were 2 percent above a year earlier. The number of cattle and calves placed on feed during the quarter was up 8 percent.

The number on feed October 1 was 2 percent less than the number on feed July 1 compared with a 5 percent decrease during the same period in 1966, and a 2 percent decrease in 1965.

## NORTH CENTRAL STATES INCREASE 2 PERCENT

On October 1, 1967 there were 5,163,000 cattle and calves on feed in the North Central States, 2 percent more than a year earlier, and 7 percent less than on July 1 this year. The number on feed was unchanged from a year earlier in Iowa, the leading cattle feeding State, and numbers were 4 percent larger in Nebraska, the second ranking State. Numbers were up from last year in Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, and Missouri, but were down in Wisconsin, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and Kansas.

## WESTERN STATES DOWN 2 PERCENT

On October 1, 1967 there were 2,397,000 cattle and calves on feed in the 11 Western States, 2 percent less than a year earlier and 4 percent more than on July 1 this year. Numbers were down 13 percent from a year earlier in California, the leading State in this region, but were up 5 percent in Colorado, the second ranking State in the region. Increases were also recorded in Idaho, New Mexico, Arizona, Washington and Oregon. Decreases were recorded in Montana, Utah and Nevada. Wyoming remained unchanged.

## OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES

The number of cattle and calves on feed on October 1, 1967 in Pennsylvania and all of the South Eastern States was down from a year earlier, with decreases ranging from 5 percent in Kentucky to 30 percent in Florida. Sharp increases were recorded in both Oklahoma and Texas, 15 percent and 27 percent, respectively.

## PLACEMENTS AND MARKETINGS UP

Cattle and calves placed on feed in the 32 States during July-September totaled 5,120,000, an increase of 8 percent from the same period in 1966. Placements were 8 percent larger in the North Central States and 3 percent in the Western States. Shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into 8 Corn Belt States during July and August were down 1 percent from the same period in 1966.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the third quarter totaled 5,278,000 head--2 percent above the corresponding period in 1966. Fed cattle marketings were up 3 percent in the North Central States but down 2 percent in the Western States.

Total slaughter of steers and heifers under Federal inspection during the July-September quarter was 1 percent above a year earlier.

Beef steers and heifers (prime, choice and good) sold out of first hands for slaughter at 15 livestock markets during July-September were down 6 percent from the same period in 1966. These data do not include sales to packing plants, mixed lots, and some deliveries bought on prior contract.

## WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

The October 1 number of cattle and calves on feed in the 32 States by weight groups showed increases for the under-500 pounds group and the 500-699 pounds group. Decreases were registered for the 700-899 pounds group and the 1,100 pounds and over group. The 900-1,099 pounds remained relatively unchanged from a year earlier. The number of head in each weight group and the percentage change from October 1 last year are as follows: under 500 pounds, 706,000 head, up 29 percent; 500-699 pounds, 1,870,000, up 8 percent; 700-899 pounds, 3,064,000 head, down 3 percent; 900-1,099 pounds, 2,563,000 head, no change; 1,100 and more pounds, 363,000 head, down 14 percent. There were 43 percent more heifers on feed in the 500 pounds and under weight group than a year ago. Steers in the 500 pounds and less weight group showed an increase of 19 percent from a year ago.

## KINDS ON FEED

Steers and steer calves on feed in the 32 States totaled 6,011,000 head, an increase of 1 percent from October 1 a year ago. There were 2,539,000 heifers and heifer calves on feed, an increase of 4 percent. Cows and others on feed October 1 totaled 16,000 head, a decrease of 33 percent from a year earlier.

TIME ON FEED

Cattle and calves on feed less than 3 months are estimated at 4,878,000 head, an increase of 7 percent from October 1, 1966. The total on feed 3-6 months, at 2,419,000 head, was up 5 percent. Cattle on feed 6 months or longer totaled 1,269,000 head--down 20 percent from a year earlier.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Of the October 1 number on feed, cattle feeders intend to market 4,894,000 head during October, November and December. If these intentions materialize, marketings will be 2 percent above October-December marketings last year from those on feed October 1. Intentions are to market 35 percent of the three-month total during October, 31 percent during November, and 34 percent during December. Expected marketings are based on the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

SEPTEMBER MARKETINGS FOR 15 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 15 livestock markets during September 1967 totaled 407,661 head, 5 percent less than during September 1966. Steers accounted for 258,589 head, 5 percent less than a year earlier. Heifers totaled 149,072 head, down 3 percent from a year ago.
