CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 3 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1971 for slaughter market in 39 feeding States are estimated at 12,762,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 3 percent less than the 13,190,000 head on feed a year earlier.

The 22 major feeding States had 12,167,000 head on feed, a 3 percent drop from the 12,581,000 head on feed January 1, 1970.

NORTH CENTRAL STATES OFF 6 PERCENT

There were 7,323,000 cattle and calves on feed for slaughter in the North Central States on January 1, a decline of 6 percent from a year earlier. Iowa, the largest feeding State had 1,992,000 head on feed, 10 percent below a year ago and Nebraska had 1,422,000 head on feed, a drop of 4 percent. Kansas, Michigan, Wisconsin, and Pennsylvania were the only States in the North Central region showing increases.

10 WESTERN STATES UP 1 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in the 10 Western States on January 1 totaled 4,844,000 head, an increase of 1 percent from a year earlier. Texas, the largest feeding State in the Western region increased 4 percent while California, the 2nd leading State in the region was down 3 percent. Other than Texas, numbers on feed were up in Colorado, Arizona, Oklahoma, and Montana.

PLACEMENTS OFF 6 PERCENT - MARKETINGS UP 3 PERCENT

Cattle and calves placed on feed in the 22 major feeding States during October-December 1970 totaled 7,919,000 head, 6 percent less than during the same quarter last year.

Placements in the North Central States totaled 5,131,000 head, down 10 percent, while the Western States at 2,788,000 head increased 2 percent.

Fed cattle marketed for slaughter from the 22 States during the October-December quarter totaled 6,145,000 head, up 3 percent from the same quarter a year ago.

Marketings were up 4 percent in the North Central States and 2 percent in the Western States.

TIME ON FEED

Cattle and calves on feed less than 3 months in 22 major States are estimated at 7,664,000, down 6 percent from January 1, 1970. There were 3,837,000 head on feed 3-6 months, up 3 percent, and 666,000 head on feed 6 months and over, down 8 percent.

KINDS ON FEED

There were 8,736,000 steers and steer calves on hand January 1, 1971 in the 22 major feeding States, 1 percent above a year earlier. Heifers and heifer calves on feed totaled 3,376,000 head, down 12 percent, while cows and other cattle on feed were 55,000, up 12 percent.

WEIGHT OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed in the 22 major States in each weight group and change from January 1, 1970 are as follows: Under 500 pounds -- 1,075,000 head, up 20,000; 500-699 pounds -- 1,993,000 head, down 70,000; 700-899 pounds -- 2,844,000 head, up 113,000; 900-1,099 pounds -- 2,282,000 head, same; 1,100 pounds and over -- 542,000 head, down 18,000.

The number of heifer and heifer calves by weight groups with changes from a year ago are as follows: Under 500 pounds -- 804,000 head, down 125,000; 500-699 pounds -- 1,194,000 head, down 119,000; 700-899 pounds -- 1,029,000 head, down 132,000; 900-1,099 pounds -- 349,000 head, down 89,000.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

During the January-March period, cattle feeders in the 22 States intend to market 5,843,000 head from their January 1, 1971 inventory. If these intentions are carried out, first quarter marketings this year would be 1 percent below the January-March period a year earlier. Monthly marketing intentions are for 31 percent of the 3 month total during January, 33 percent in February, and 36 percent in March.

DECEMBER MARKETINGS FOR 8 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter at 8 major markets in December totaled 305,311 head, and included 197,607 steers and 107,704 heifers. Average live weight of December marketings included steers at 1,142 pounds, compared with 1,145 pounds last year, and heifers at 969 pounds versus 968 pounds last year.

CATTLE FEEDLOTS AND FED MARKETINGS BY SIZE GROUPS

The trend toward fewer but larger cattle feedlots continued in 1970 in the 22 major feeding States. Feedlots with a capacity of 1,000 head and over increased 7 percent to 2,221 lots, while feedlots maintaining a capacity below 1,000 head declined 4 percent to 180,329 lots. Feedlots with a capacity of 32,000 head or more showed the largest percentage gain in 1970 in number of lots and fed marketings.

During 1970, fed cattle marketings in the 22 major feeding States totaled 24,790,000 head, up 4 percent from the 23,751,000 head marketed in 1969. Lots under 1,000 head capacity marketed 45 percent of the 1970 total versus 48 percent in 1969, while lots over 1,000 head accounted for 55 percent of the 1970 fed marketings compared with 52 percent during 1969.
