CATTLE ON FEED UP 2 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed July 1 for the slaughter market totaled 10,881,000 head in the 23 major feeding States, according to the Crop Reporting Board, 2 percent over a year earlier.

Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during April-June were up 5 percent from the same 1970 quarter. Marketings of fed cattle April-June were 6,311,000 head, 1 percent above a year earlier.

Marketings during July-September 1971 (from cattle on feed July 1) in the 23 States are expected to be 2 percent more than during the same 3-month period in 1970.

NORTH CENTRAL REGION DOWN 6 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1971, in the North Central Region totaled 5,879,000 head, 6 percent below a year earlier. Iowa, the largest feeding State in this region, had 13 percent fewer cattle on feed than a year earlier. Also showing decreases were: Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Missouri, and North Dakota. The largest percentage decrease was 21 percent in Illinois. Kansas--with an 18 percent increase--had the greatest gain.

10 WESTERN STATES UP 14 PERCENT

There were 5,002,000 cattle and calves on feed July 1 in the 10 Western States, 14 percent more than a year earlier. Texas, the leading feeding State in this region, had 1,700,000 head, 26 percent more than a year earlier. Increases were reported in all other States in this region except Idaho and New Mexico.

PLACEMENTS UP 5 PERCENT, MARKETINGS UP 1 PERCENT

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 23 major States during April-June totaled 5,478,000 head, 5 percent more than a year earlier. In the North Central States placements were 2,588,000 head, 2 percent above a year earlier; Western State placements of 2,890,000 head were up 7 percent.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter in the 23 major States April through June totaled 6,311,000 head, 1 percent more than a year earlier. Fed cattle marketings in the North Central States were 3,675,000 head, down 3 percent; marketings in the Western States at 2,636,000 head were up 9 percent.

TIME ON FEED

Cattle and calves on feed less than 3 months in the 23 major feeding States on July 1, are estimated at 5,226,000 head, up 5 percent from a year earlier. There were 4,002,000 head on feed 3-6 months, 8 percent more than a year earlier. The number on feed 6 months and over, at 1,653,000 head, was 16 percent below July 1, 1970.

KINDS ON FEED

There were 7,623,000 steers and steer calves on feed, a 4-percent increase from a year earlier, while heifers and heifer calves numbered 3,226,000 head, down 1 percent. Cows and other cattle on feed totaled 32,000 head, up 1,000 from a year earlier.

WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves in each weight group in the 23 States and the changes from July 1, 1970 are as follows: Under 500 pounds--523,000 head, up 222,000; 500-699 pounds--1,410,000 head, up 85,000; 700-899 pounds--3,172,000 head, up 199,000; 900-1,099 pounds--2,155,000 head, down 158,000; 1,100 pounds and over--363,000 head, down 58,000 head.

Heifers and heifer calves by weight groups and changes from a year earlier are as follows: Under 500 pounds--288,000 head, up 41,000; 500-699 pounds--1,064,000 head, down 74,000; 700-899 pounds--1,584,000 head, up 17,000; 900-1,099 pounds--290,000 head, down 32,000 head.

MARKET INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders in the 23 major States intend to market 6,165,000 head during July-September 1971. If feeders realize these intentions, marketings from those on feed July 1, 1971, would be 2 percent more than during the same period last year. Feeders intend to market 32 percent of the quarterly total during July, 33 percent during August, and 35 percent during September.

JUNE MARKETINGS FOR SEVEN LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter at 7 markets during June totaled 228,592 head. This total included 146,538 steers and 82,054 heifers. The average liveweight of steers marketed was 1,127 pounds, 12 pounds lighter than a year earlier. Heifers averaged 935 pounds, 9 pounds less than June 1970. Average price per 100 pounds liveweight in 7 markets during June was \$31.53 for steers and \$30.92 for heifers, up \$1.83 and \$1.87, respectively, from averages in June 1970.
