## CATTLE ON FEED UP 14 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed July 1 for slaughter market totaled 12,455,000 head in the 23 major feeding States, an increase of 14 percent from a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the April-June quarter amounted to 6,377,000 head, a 17 percent gain over placements during the comparable period of 1971. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the April-June period, at 6,742,000 head, was above the comparable period of last year.

Total marketings of fed cattle as projected for the coming July-September quarter are expected to reach a new record high of 7,184,000 head--9 percent more than the number moving to the slaughter market during the same 3-month period of 1971.

## NORTH CENTRAL REGION UP 12 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1972 in the North Central Region totaled 6,568,000 head, 12 percent above a year earlier. Iowa, the largest feeding State in this region, had 4 percent more cattle on feed than a year earlier. Also showing increases were Nebraska, Kansas, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Missouri, and North Dakota. The largest percentage increase was 32 percent in Kansas. Pennsylvania, South Dakota and Minnesota show slightly fewer animals on feed than a year earlier.

## 10 WESTERN STATES UP 18 PERCENT

Cattle feeders in the 10 Western States had a total of 5,887,000 head of cattle on feed as of July 1, an increase of 18 percent over a year earlier. Texas, the leading feeding State in the Nation for this date,

had 2,119,000 head in feedlots, a gain of 25 percent from July 1, 1971. California and Colorado, with 1,165,000 and 1,020,000 head, respectively, held second and third positions for the region. Both of these States show increases of 16 percent over a year earlier. Montana with a 30 percent gain showed the greatest rate of increase in feeding operations. Washington, Oregon and Idaho were the only States in this region with fewer cattle on feed.

#### PLACEMENTS UP 17 PERCENT, MARKETINGS UP 7 PERCENT

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 23 major States during April-June totaled 6,377,000 head, 17 percent more than a year earlier. In the North Central States, placements were 3,021,000 head, 18 percent above a year earlier; placements in Western States at 3,356,000 head were up 16 percent.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter in the 23 major States from April through June totaled 6,742,000 head, 7 percent more than a year earlier. Fed cattle marketings in the North Central States at 3,843,000 head were up 6 percent, and the Western States at 2,899,000 head were up 10 percent.

#### KINDS ON FEED

There were 8,702,000 steers and steer calves on feed on July 1, a 14 percent increase from a year earlier, and heifers and heifer calves numbered 3,710,000 head, up 15 percent. Cows and other cattle on feed totaled 43,000 head, up 11,000 head from a year earlier.

#### WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves in each weight group in the 23 States and the changes from July 1, 1971 are as follows: Under 500 pounds--496,000 head, down 27,000 head; 500-699 pounds--1,672,000 head, up 262,000; 700-899 pounds--3,395,000 head, up 218,000; 900-1,099 pounds--2,667,000 head, up 508,000; 1,100 pounds and over--472,000 head, up 110,000 head.

Heifers and heifer calves by weight groups and changes from a year earlier are as follows: Under 500 pounds--417,000 head, up 130,000 head; 500-699 pounds--1,237,000 head, up 175,000; 700-899 pounds--1,676,000 head, up 90,000; 900-1,099 pounds--380,000 head, up 89,000 head.

### MARKET INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders in the 23 major States intend to market 7,184,000 head during July-September 1972. If feeders realize these intentions, marketings from those on feed July 1, 1972, would be 9 percent more than during the same period last year. Feeders intend to market 31 percent of the quarterly total during July, 34 percent during August, and 35 percent during September.

### JUNE MARKETINGS FOR SEVEN LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter at 7 markets during June totaled 192,494 head. This total included 121,054 steers and 71,440 heifers. The average liveweight of steers marketed was 1,125 pounds, 2 pounds lighter than a year earlier. Heifers averaged 937 pounds, 2 pounds more than June 1971. Average price per 100 pounds liveweight in 7 markets during June was \$36.94 for steers and \$35.87 for heifers, up \$5.41 and \$4.95, respectively, from averages in June 1971.
