## CATTLE ON FEED UP 10 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed October 1 for slaughter market totaled 11,764,000 head in the 23 major feeding States, an increase of 10 percent from a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the July-September quarter amounted to 6,226,000 head, a decline of 2 percent from placements during the comparable period of 1971. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the July-September period, at 6,919,000 head, were 5 percent above the comparable period last year.

Marketings of fed cattle for the coming October-December quarter are projected at 6,621,000 head--7 percent more than the number marketed during the same 3-month period of 1971.

## NORTH CENTRAL REGION UP 4 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed October 1, 1972 in the North Central Region totaled 5,982,000 head, 4 percent above a year earlier and 1 percent more than on October 1, 1970. Iowa, the largest feeding State in this region, had 2 percent less cattle on feed than a year earlier. However, the other large feeding States in the region, Kansas and Nebraska, were up 24 and 9 percent, respectively. Also showing increases were Minnesota, Ohio, Michigan and North Dakota. States with fewer cattle on feed than a year earlier include Illinois, Indiana, Missouri, Wisconsin and Pennsylvania, while South Dakota was unchanged from a year ago.

## 10 WESTERN STATES UP 18 PERCENT

There were 5,782,000 cattle and calves on feed October 1 in the 10 Western States, 18 percent above a year ago. Texas, the leading feeding State in the Nation, had 2,091,000 head, a gain of 30 percent from October 1, 1971. California with 1,206,000 head was up 19 percent while Colorado with 978,000 head was up 9 percent. Idaho and Oregon were the only States in this region with fewer cattle on feed while Washington was unchanged.

PLACEMENTS DOWN 2 PERCENT, MARKETINGS UP 5 PERCENT

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 23 major States during July-September totaled 6,226,000 head, 2 percent less than a year ago. In the North Central States, placements were 3,261,000 head, 9 percent below a year earlier; placements in Western States at 2,965,000 were up 7 percent.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter in the 23 major States from July through September totaled 6,919,000 head, 5 percent more than a year earlier. Fed cattle marketings in the North Central States at 3,849,000 head were up 4 percent and the Western States at 3,070,000 head were up 6 percent.

KINDS ON FEED

The 23 major Cattle on Feed States had 8,445,000 steers and steer calves on feed on October 1, a 10 percent increase from a year earlier.

Heifer and heifer calves numbered 3,279,000 head, 11 percent above a year earlier. Cows and other cattle on feed totaled 40,000 head, up 7,000 head from October 1 last year.

WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves in each weight group in the 23 major States and the changes from October 1, 1971 are as follows: Under 500 pounds--617,000 head, up 150,000; 500-699 pounds--1,798,000 head, up 265,000; 700-899 pounds--2,778,000 head, down 42,000; 900-1,099 pounds--2,705,000 head, up 324,000 or 14 percent but only 5 percent above 2 years ago; 1,100 pounds and over, up 15 percent from last year and 6 percent from 2 years ago.

Heifers and heifer calves by weight groups and the respective changes from a year earlier are as follows: Under 500 pounds--375,000 head, down 7,000; 500-699 pounds--1,031,000 head, down 18,000; 700-899 pounds--1,291,000 head, up 146,000 or 13 percent and 5 percent above 2 years ago; 900-1,099 pounds--up 53 percent from last year and 33 percent above 2 years ago.

### MARKET INTENTIONS

During October-December 1972, cattle feeders in the 23 major States intend to market 6,621,000 head. If these intentions materialize, marketings will be 7 percent above the same time period a year earlier. Of the total intentions, 37 percent are expected to go to market in October, 32 percent in November and 31 percent in December.

### SEPTEMBER MARKETINGS FOR SEVEN LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter at 7 livestock markets during September totaled 131,644 head. This total included 65,861 steers and 65,783 heifers. Of those marketed during September the average liveweight for steers was 1,110 pounds compared to 1,094 pounds a year earlier. For heifers, the average liveweight was 946 pounds, up from 933 pounds a year earlier. Average price per 100 pounds liveweight in these 7 markets was \$34.40 for steers and \$33.09 for heifers, up \$2.55 and \$2.30, respectively, from September a year ago.
