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CATTLE ON FEED UP 4 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in 50 States are estimated at 14,485,000 head on January 1, 1973, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 4 percent more than a year earlier.

The 23 major feeding States had 13,920,000 on feed this January 1, up 4 percent from a year earlier. These 23 States accounted for 96 percent of the 50-State total.

NORTH CENTRAL STATES DOWN 2 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter in the North Central States totaled 7,677,000 head on January 1, 2 percent below a year earlier. With 1,981,000 on feed, Iowa ranked number two nationally, though down 6 percent from a year earlier. Nebraska was feeding 1,581,000 cattle, up 2 percent and Kansas with 1,250,000 was up 14 percent. Michigan and South Dakota were the only other States with larger inventories than on January 1, 1972.

10 WESTERN STATES UP 14 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in the 10 Western States totaled 6,243,000 head, up 14 percent from a year ago. Texas with an increase of 26 percent from a year earlier had the largest number on feed of any State. California and Colorado were second and third, respectively, in the region. Montana, Idaho and Oregon were the only States in the region showing reduced inventories from a year earlier.

Revision in Estimates: The 1966-70 cattle and calves on feed estimates were reviewed and revised, if necessary, based on data obtained from 1969 Census of Agriculture and other data which have become available since the original estimates were made. Revised estimates by States for the years 1966-70 are shown in Statistical Bulletin 503. This bulletin is available on request.

PLACEMENTS UP 1 PERCENT - MARKETINGS UP 9 PERCENT

Cattle and calves placed on feed in the 23 major States during October-December 1972 totaled 8,904,000 head, 1 percent more than during the same 1971 quarter. Placements in the North Central States, at 5,437,000 were down 3 percent, while placements in the Western States, at 3,467,000 head, were up 7 percent.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the last quarter of 1972 totaled 6,758,000 head, 9 percent more than marketed during the last quarter of 1971. The North Central States sold 3,752,000 head, 7 percent more than a year earlier, and the Western States marketed 3,006,000, up 12 percent.

KINDS ON FEED

There were 9,919,000 steers and steer calves on feed January 1, 1973 in the 23 major feeding States, 6 percent above a year earlier. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3,935,000, virtually unchanged from January 1, 1972. Cows and other cattle on feed, at 66,000, were 8 percent above a year earlier.

WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed in the 23 major States in each weight group and the change from January 1, 1972 are as follows: under 500 pounds--1,071,000 head, down 144,000; 500-699 pounds--2,499,000 head, up 231,000; 700-899 pounds--3,156,000 head, up 348,000; 900-1,099 pounds-- 2,558,000 head, up 17,000; 1,100 pounds and over--635,000 head, up 145,000.

The number of heifers and heifer calves by weight groups with changes from a year ago are as follows: under 500 pounds--885,000 head, down 45,000; 500-699 pounds--1,360,000 head, up 33,000; 700-899 pounds-- 1,190,000 head, down 80,000; 900-1,099 pounds--500,000 head, up 80,000.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS

During January-March, cattle feeders in the 23 major States intend to market 6,917,000 head. If these expectations are realized first quarter marketings this year would be 7 percent above a year earlier. Monthly marketing intentions are for 32 percent of the 3-month total to be marketed in January, 34 percent in February and 34 percent in March.

DECEMBER MARKETINGS FOR SEVEN LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter in December totaled 194,748 head and included 113,676 steers and 81,072 heifers. Average liveweight of December marketings of steers was 1,155 pounds compared with 1,124 pounds a year earlier. Heifers averaged 982 pounds compared with 957 pounds a year ago. Average price per 100 pounds live weight during December was \$36.26 for steers, up \$2.75 from December 1971 and \$35.12 for heifers, up \$2.43.

CATTLE FEEDLOTS AND FED MARKETINGS BY SIZE GROUPS

The trend toward fewer but larger feedlots continued in 1972 in the 23 major feeding States. Feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head and over decreased 4 percent to 2,107. Feedlots with a capacity below 1,000 head decreased 7 percent to 152,429. Feedlots with a capacity of over 32,000 head showed the largest percentage gain during 1972 in number of lots and fed cattle marketings.

During 1972 fed cattle marketings in the 23 major feeding States totaled 26,835,000 head, up 6 percent from 1971. Lots under 1,000 head capacity marketed 38 percent of the total compared with 42 percent in 1971. Lots over 1,000 head accounted for 62 percent of the 1972 fed marketings compared with 58 percent during 1971.

Cold temperatures accompanied by ice and snow storms have persisted since late November over much of the Plains States. These storms have caused higher than normal death losses of cattle during this period. Heaviest losses occurred in light weight feeders not yet in feedlots. This has resulted in a reduction and delay in placements.
