CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES 2 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in 23 States totaled 12,732,000 head on July 1, 2 percent more than the number on feed a year ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number on feed in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23-State total) is estimated at 9,491,000 head, 4 percent above a year ago.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 23 States during the April-June 1973 quarter amounted to 5,661,000 head, down 11 percent from the same quarter in 1972. Marketing of fed cattle during the same period totaled 6,302,000 head, down 6 percent from a year earlier.

Marketings during the July-September quarter are expected to total 6,989,000 head, 1 percent more than the same quarter in 1972.

NORTH CENTRAL STATES UP 1 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed July 1 in the North Central States are estimated at 6,665,000 head, 1 percent above a year earlier. Iowa, the leading feeding State in the region, had 1,750,000 head on feed, an increase of 3 percent from a year ago. Numbers in Nebraska were up 2 percent and Kansas showed a 9 percent gain over 1972.

WESTERN STATES UP 3 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in the 10 Western States amounted to 6,067,000 head, 3 percent above July 1, 1972. Texas, the leading feeding State in the Nation, had 2,335,000 head on feed July 1, 10 percent more than the number on feed at this time last year. California, with 1,179,000 head on feed, was up 1 percent.

PLACEMENTS DOWN 11 PERCENT--MARKETINGS DOWN 6 PERCENT

Cattle and calves placed on feed in the 23 major States during the April-June quarter were 5,661,000 head, down 11 percent from the same quarter in 1972. Placements of 2,651,000 head in the North Central States were 12 percent below the same period a year ago. In the Western States, 3,010,000 head were placed on feed, 10 percent less than during the same quarter a year earlier.

Marketings of fed cattle for the slaughter market from the 23 States during the quarter totaled 6,302,000 head, down 6 percent from the same quarter in 1972. Feeders in the North Central States sold 3,418,000 head for slaughter during the quarter, 11 percent less than the same quarter last year. Marketings in the 10 Western States totaled 2,884,000 head, slightly below the same period a year earlier.

KINDS ON FEED

Cattle feeders in the 23 major feeding States had 8,989,000 steers and steer calves on feed July 1, 1973 compared to 8,702,000 a year earlier. There were 3,695,000 heifers and heifer calves on feed, about the same as a year ago. Cows and other cattle on feed were 48,000, which was 5,000 greater than 1972.

WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The current numbers and changes from July 1, 1972 for steers and steer calves on feed in the 23 major States are: Under 500 pounds--537,000 head, up 41,000; 500-699 pounds--1,788,000 head, up 116,000; 700-899 pounds--3,470,000 head, up 75,000; 900-1,099 pounds--2,649,000 head, down 17,000; 1,100 pounds and over--545,000 head, up 72,000.

The number of heifers and heifer calves on feed by weight groups with changes from a year earlier are as follows: Under 500 pounds--362,000 head, down 57,000; 500-699 pounds--1,341,000 head, up 104,000; 700-899 pounds--1,567,000 head, down 110,000; 900-1,099 pounds--426,000 head, up 46,000.

INTENTIONS TO MARKET

Cattle feeders in the 23 major States intend to market 6,989,000 head during the July-September quarter. These third quarter marketings, if realized, will be 82,000 (1 percent) above a year ago. Percentages of the three month total intended to be marketed each month are as follows: July--33 percent, August--33 percent, and September--34 percent.

JUNE MARKETINGS AT SEVEN LIVESTOCK MARKETS

There were 88,953 steers and 61,577 heifers for a total of 150,535 head marketed during June through seven livestock markets. Average liveweight of the steers was 1,139 pounds compared to 1,125 a year ago. The liveweight of heifers averaged 957 pounds, 20 pounds heavier than June 1972. Price per hundred pounds for June averaged \$46.09 for steers and \$44.83 for heifers, up \$9.15 and \$8.96, respectively, from a year earlier.
