## CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 6 PERCENT FROM YEAR AGO

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in 50 States are estimated at 13,637,000 head on January 1, 1974, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 6 percent less than a year earlier.

Cattle and calves on feed January 1 for slaughter market totaled 13,062,000 head in the 23 major feeding States, a decrease of 6 percent from January 1 a year earlier.

Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during October-December 1973 totaled 7,513,000 head, down 15 percent from placements during the comparable period of 1972.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the last quarter of 1973, at 6,505,000 head, were 4 percent below the comparable period a year earlier.

## KINDS ON FEED

There were 9,479,000 steers and steer calves on feed January 1, 1974 in the 23 major feeding States, 4 percent below a year earlier. Heifers and heifer calves at 3,497,000 were down 11 percent from January 1, 1973. Cows and other cattle on feed, totaled 86,000 up 20,000 head from a year earlier.

## WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed in the 23 major States in each weight group and the change from January 1, 1973 are as follows: under 500 pounds - 819,000 head, down 246,000; 500-699 pounds - 1,952,000 head, down 536,000; 700-899 pounds - 2,945,000 head, down 199,000; 900-1,099 pounds - 2,775,000 head, up 226,000; 1,100 pounds and over - 988,000 head, up 356,000. The number of heifers and heifer calves by weight groups with changes from a year ago are as follows: under 500 pounds - 694,000 head, down 187,000; 500-699 pounds - 1,019,000 head, down 335,000; 700-899 pounds - 1,198,000 head, up 14,000; 900-1,099 pounds - 586,000 head, up 88,000.

### EXPECTED MARKETINGS

During January-March, cattle feeders in the 23 major States intend to market 6,535,000 head. If these expectations are realized, first quarter marketings this year would be 1 percent below a year earlier. Monthly marketing intentions are for 34 percent of the 3-month total to be marketed in January, 34 percent in February and 32 percent in March.

### DECEMBER MARKETINGS FOR SEVEN LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter in December totaled 192,617 head and included 113,091 steers and 79,526 heifers. Average live-weight of December marketings of steers was 1,169 pounds compared with 1,155 pounds a year earlier. Heifers averaged 1,003 pounds compared with 982 pounds a year ago. Average price per 100 pounds live weight during December was \$38.31 for steers, up \$2.05 from December 1972 and \$37.55 for heifers, up \$2.43.

### CATTLE FEEDLOTS AND FED MARKETINGS BY SIZE GROUPS

The trend toward fewer but larger feedlots continued in 1973 in the 23 major feeding States. Feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head and over totaled 2,040, virtually unchanged from a year earlier. Feedlots with a capacity below 1,000 head decreased 5 percent to 144,380. Feedlots with a capacity of over 32,000 head showed the largest percentage gain during 1973 in number of lots and fed cattle marketings.

During 1973, fed cattle marketings in the 23 major feeding States totaled 25,331,000 head, down 6 percent from 1972.

Lots with over 1,000 head capacity accounted for 65 percent of the 1973 fed cattle marketings compared with 62 percent of the total during 1972.
