CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DOWN 15 PERCENT FROM A YEAR AGO

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 23 major cattle feeding States totaled 8,542,000 head on July 1, 1975, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 15 percent less than a year ago and the smallest July 1 number on feed since 1967.

Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the April-June quarter of 1975 totaled 5,535,000, a 17 percent increase from 1974.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the April-June quarter totaled 5,013,000, down 20 percent from the same quarter in both 1974 and 1973.

Other disappearance during the April-June quarter totaled 453,000 compared with 738,000 during the same quarter in 1974.

KINDS ON FEED

There were 5,695,000 steers and steer calves on feed July 1, 1975 in the 23 major feeding States, 22 percent below a year earlier and 37 percent below 1973. Heifer and heifer calves, at 2,782,000, were up 3 percent from July 1, 1974 but 25 percent below July 1, 1973. Cows and other cattle on feed totaled 65,000, an increase of 16,000 over a year ago.

WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed July 1, 1975 in the 23 major States by weight groups and the changes from a year earlier are as follows:

Under 500 pounds - 184,000 down 23,000;
500-699 pounds - 1,084,000 down 250,000;
700-899 pounds - 2,242,000 down 379,000;
900-1,099 pounds - 1,852,000 down 603,000;
1,100 pounds and over - 333,000 down 355,000.

The number of heifers and heifer calves on feed by weight groups and the changes from July 1, 1974, are as follows:

Under 500 pounds - 202,000 down 7,000;
500-699 pounds - 998,000 up 191,000;
700-899 pounds - 1,256,000 down 43,000;
900 pounds and over - 326,000 down 52,000.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS

Cattle feeders in the 23 major States expect to market 5,231,000 during July-September 1975. If these intentions are realized, third quarter marketings this year would be 5 percent less than they were a year earlier and 12 percent below 1973. This would be the lowest July-September marketings since 1967. Expected monthly marketings are that 32 percent of the 3-month total will be marketed during July, 35 percent during August, and 33 percent during September.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on July 1, 1975, in the 7 monthly States (which are included in the 23 States) are estimated at 6,006,000. This is 16 percent less than a year earlier, but 3 percent more than were on feed June 1, 1975.
