## CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES UP 28 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 23 major cattle feeding States totaled 12,296,000 head on January 1, 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is up 28 percent from the January 1, 1975 figure, which was the lowest total since January 1, 1965. The January 1, 1976 figure is up 32 percent from October 1, 1975, but 6 percent below January 1, 1974.

Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the October - December quarter of 1975 totaled 8.3 million head, up 27 percent from this period in 1974 and up 11 percent from the 1973 period.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the October - December quarter of 1975 totaled 4.9 million head, down 11 percent from the same quarter a year ago and down 24 percent from the 1973 period.

Other disappearance during the October - December quarter totaled 382,000 compared with 535,000 in the same period last year.

## KINDS ON FEED

There were 20 percent more steers and steer calves on feed January 1, 1976 than a year earlier in the 23 major feeding States, but 13 percent less than January 1, 1974. Heifer and heifer calves on feed were up sharply, 50 percent more than January 1, 1975 and 13 percent more than January 1, 1974. Cows and other cattle on feed increased 6,000 from a year ago, but decreased 9,000 head from two years earlier.

This report provides data for the 23 quarterly States only. The number of cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1976 by States and for the United States will be published in the Cattle Report to be issued February 2, 1976.

## WEIGHTS OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed January 1, 1976 in the 23 major States by weight groups and the changes from a year earlier are:

Under 500 pounds	- 632,000 up 139,000;
500 - 699 pounds	- 1,813,000 up 448,000;
700 - 899 pounds	- 2,902,000 up 770,000;
900 - 1,099 pounds	- 2,502,000 up 250,000;
1,100 lbs. & over	- 407,000 down 258,000.

The number of heifers and heifer calves on feed by weight groups and the change from January 1, 1975 are:

Under 500 pounds	-- 621,000 up 172,000;
500 - 699 pounds	-- 1,270,000 up 488,000;
700 - 899 pounds	-- 1,493,000 up 524,000;
900 lbs. & over	-- 579,000 up 138,000.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS

During January-March 1976, cattle feeders in the 23 major States expect to market 6.2 million head and if realized would be 12 percent above the first quarter of 1975 and 3 percent above 1974.

## CATTLE FEEDLOTS AND FED CATTLE MARKETINGS BY SIZE GROUPS

In 1975, feedlots with a capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 1,764, down 8 percent from 1974 in the 23 major cattle feeding States. Feedlots with a capacity below 1,000 head increased slightly to 136,262.

During 1975, fed cattle marketings in the 23 major feeding States totaled 20.5 million head, down 12 percent from 1974 and down 19 percent from 1973.

Feedlots with over 1,000 head capacity accounted for 65 percent of the 1975 fed cattle marketings, unchanged from 1973 and 1974.

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on January 1, 1976 in the 7 monthly States (which are included in the 23 major States) totaled 8.5 million head. This is 34 percent above last year's unusually low number, but 9 percent below 1974. Placements during December at 1.6 million head were 30 percent more than a year ago and marketings were down 11 percent from last year.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report, 65 percent was actually reported in the survey.
