CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES UP 28 PERCENT FROM YEAR AGO:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on April 1, 1976, in the 23 major feeding States surveyed totaled 10,872,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 28 percent more than the low number a year ago, but 12 percent less than April 1, 1974. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the January-March 1976 quarter totaled 5,439,000 head, up 14 percent from 1975. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the quarter totaled 6,350,000 head, up 15 percent from the same quarter in 1975 and 6 percent more than 1974. Other disappearance totaled 513,000 head, compared with 392,000 during the same quarter in 1975.

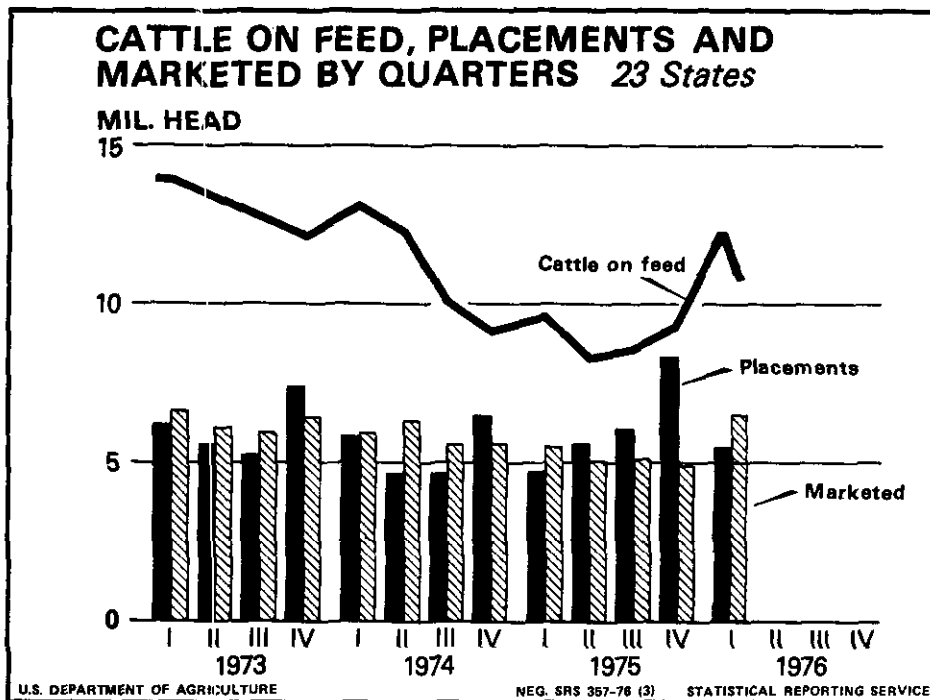
There were 7,306,000 steers and steer calves on feed, 22 percent above a year earlier but 19 percent below 1974. Steers and steer calves accounted for 67 percent of the total. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3,501,000, up 45 percent from April 1, 1975 and 9 percent above 1974.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS:

During April-June 1976, cattle feeders intend to market 5,957,000 head, an increase of 18 percent over the second quarter marketings of 1975, but 5 percent below 1974.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals) were estimated at 7,525,000 head, up 34 percent from a year earlier, but down 7 percent from March 1, 1976. Placements during March 1976 were 1,397,000 down 9 percent from a year ago and the first decrease since July 1975.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report, 63 percent was actually reported in the survey.
