CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES UP 17 PERCENT FROM YEAR AGO:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on July 1, 1976, in the 23 major feeding States surveyed totaled 10,036,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 17 percent more than the low number a year ago, but slightly less than July 1, 1974. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the April-June 1976 quarter totaled 5,599,000, up 1 percent from 1975 and 18 percent above 1974. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the quarter totaled 5,937,000, up 18 percent from the same quarter in 1975 but 5 percent below 1974. Other disappearance totaled 518,000, compared with 453,000 in 1975 and 738,000 in 1974.

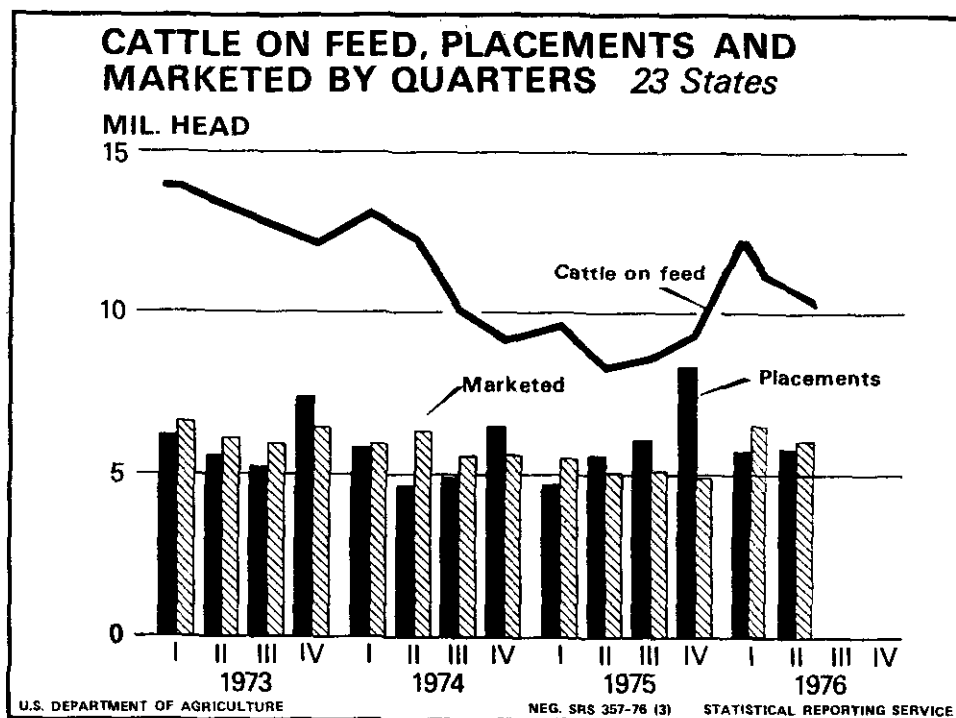
There were 6,594,000 steers and steer calves on feed, 16 percent above a year earlier but 10 percent below 1974. Steers and steer calves accounted for 66 percent of the total. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3,385,000 head, up 22 percent from July 1, 1975 and 26 percent above 1974.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS:

During July-September 1976, cattle feeders intend to market 5,983,000 head, 19 percent more than the third quarter marketings in 1975 and 8 percent more than the same quarter of 1974.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals) were estimated at 7,074,000, up 18 percent from a year earlier, but down 2 percent from June 1, 1976. Placements during June were 1,387,000, up 1 percent from a year ago. Marketings were 1,457,000, 27 percent more than in June 1975.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report, 65 percent was actually reported in the survey.
