## CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DOWN SLIGHTLY FROM A YEAR AGO:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on October 1, 1976 in the 23 major feeding States surveyed totaled 9,264,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is less than one percent below the number on feed a year ago, but 1 percent more than October 1, 1974. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the July - September 1976 quarter totaled 5,673,000, down 6 percent from 1975 but 15 percent above 1974. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the quarter totaled 6,170,000, up 23 percent from the same quarter in 1975 and 12 percent above 1974. Other disappearance totaled 275,000, compared with 252,000 in 1975 and 325,000 in 1974.

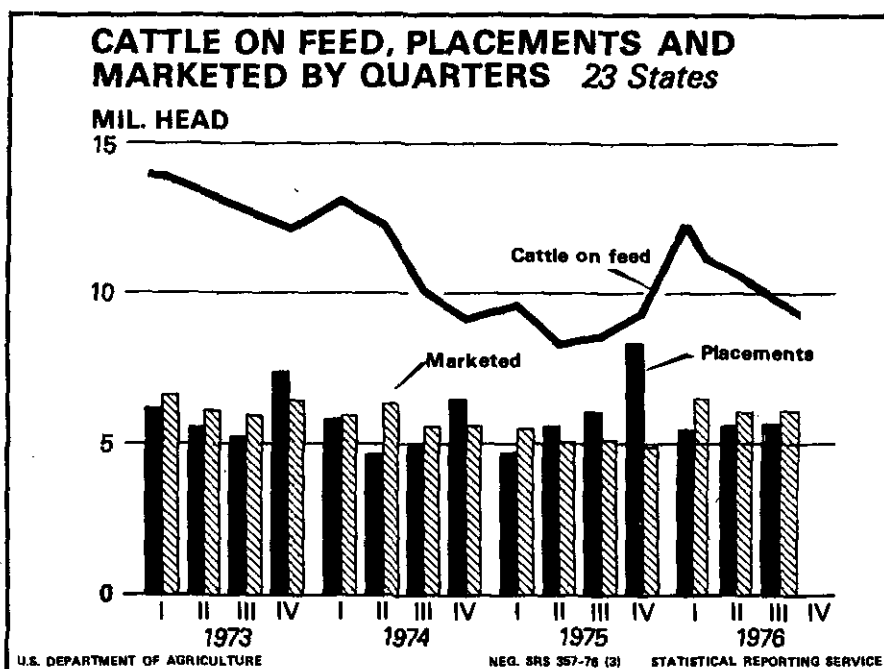
There were 5,900,000 steers and steer calves on feed, 7 percent below a year earlier and 12 percent below 1974. Steers and steer calves accounted for only 64 percent of the total, the lowest October 1 percentage for these States in 7 years. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3,324,000, up 13 percent from October 1, 1975 and 39 percent above 1974.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS:

During October - December 1976, cattle feeders intend to market 5,490,000 head, 11 percent more than the fourth quarter marketings in 1975 but 1 percent less than the same quarter of 1974.

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals) were estimated at 6,572,000, down 1 percent from a year earlier, but up 2 percent from September 1, 1976. Placements during September were 1,663,000, down 19 percent from a year ago. Marketings were 1,467,000, 13 percent more than in September 1975.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report, 65 percent was actually reported in the survey.
