CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DOWN 3 PERCENT FROM YEAR AGO

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 23 major cattle feeding States surveyed on January 1, 1977 totaled 11,928,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 3 percent fewer than in feedlots a year ago, but 24 percent above the January 1, 1975 total. Cattle in feedlots on January 1 were up 29 percent from the number on feed October 1, 1976. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the October-December 1976 quarter totaled 8,755,000 head, up 5 percent from the corresponding period a year ago and 34 percent above the similar period in 1974. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the quarter totaled 5,694,000 head, up 15 percent from the same quarter in 1975 and 3 percent above 1974. Other disappearance totaled 413,000 head, compared with 382,000 in 1975 and 535,000 in 1974.

There were 7,799,000 steers and steer calves on feed, 6 percent below a year earlier but 13 percent above 1975. Steers and steer calves accounted for only 66 percent of the total, the lowest January 1 percentage for these States during the last 9 years. Heifers and heifer calves totaled a record 4,066,000, up 2 percent from January 1, 1976 and 54 percent above 1975. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 34 percent of the total, the highest January 1 percentage during the last 9 years.

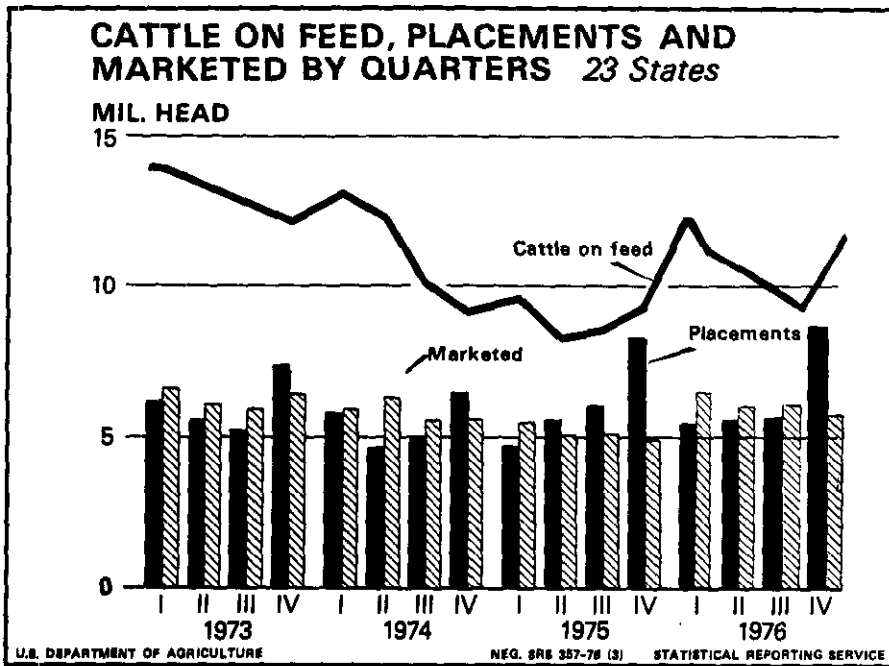
Expected Marketings:

During January-March 1977, cattle feeders intend to market 6,111,000 head, 4 percent below the first quarter marketings in 1976 but 11 percent more than the same quarter in 1975.

Cattle on Feed in 7 Monthly States:

Cattle and Calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals) were estimated at 8,202,000 head, down 4 percent from a year earlier but up 3 percent from December 1, 1976. Placements during December were 1,769,000, up 11 percent from a year ago. Marketings were 1,473,000, 23 percent more than in December 1975.

This report provides data for the 23 quarterly States only. The number of cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1977 by States and for the United States will be published in the Cattle Report to be issued February 2, 1977.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report, 63 percent was actually reported in the survey.
