## CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DOWN 3 PERCENT FROM A YEAR AGO:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 23 major cattle feeding States surveyed on April 1, 1977 totaled 10,618,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 3 percent fewer than the number on feed a year ago, but 25 percent above the April 1, 1975 total. Cattle in feedlots on April 1 were down 11 percent from the number on feed January 1, 1977. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the January-March 1977 quarter totaled 5,597,000 head, up 3 percent from the January-March quarter last year and 18 percent higher than the corresponding period in 1975. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during last quarter totaled 6,442,000 head, up 2 percent from the same quarter a year ago and 17 percent above 1975. Other disappearance totaled 482,000 head, compared with 513,000 in 1976 and 392,000 in 1975.

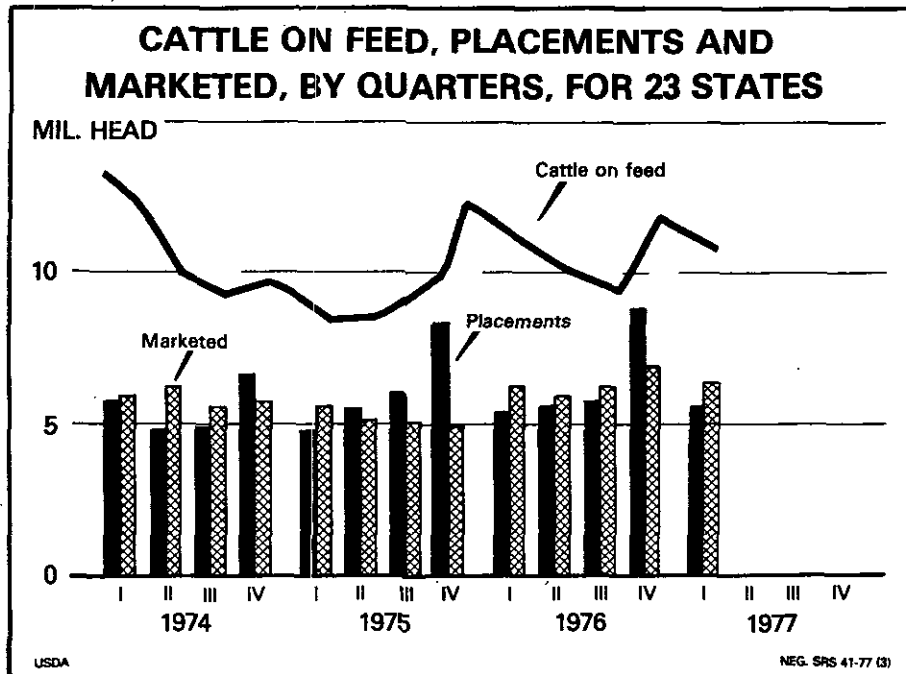
There were 7,047,000 steers and steer calves on feed April 1, 4 percent below a year earlier but 18 percent above 1975. Steers and steer calves accounted for only 66 percent of the total, the lowest April 1 percentage for these States during the last 9 years. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3,523,000, slightly higher than last year and 46 percent above 1975. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 34 percent of the total, the highest April 1 percentage during the last 9 years.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS:

During April-June 1977, cattle feeders intend to market 6,001,000 head, 1 percent more than the second quarter marketings in 1976, but 19 percent more than the same quarter in 1975.

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals) were estimated at 7,280,000, down 3 percent from a year earlier and down 4 percent from March 1, 1977. Placements during March were 1,526,000, up 11 percent from a year ago. Marketings were 1,690,000, 8 percent less than March 1976.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report 59 percent was actually reported in the survey.
