## CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES UP 5 PERCENT FROM A YEAR AGO:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on October 1, 1977 in 23 major feeding States totaled 9,777,000 head. This is 5 percent above a year ago, but 19 percent less than the record 1973 number for this date. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during the July-September quarter totaled 6,472,000 head, up 14 percent from last year and up 7 percent from 1975. This is the largest July-September placements of record. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the quarter totaled 6,164,000, down 1 percent from last year but 23 percent above two years ago. Other disappearance totaled 292,000 compared with 274,000 last year and 252,000 during July-September 1975.

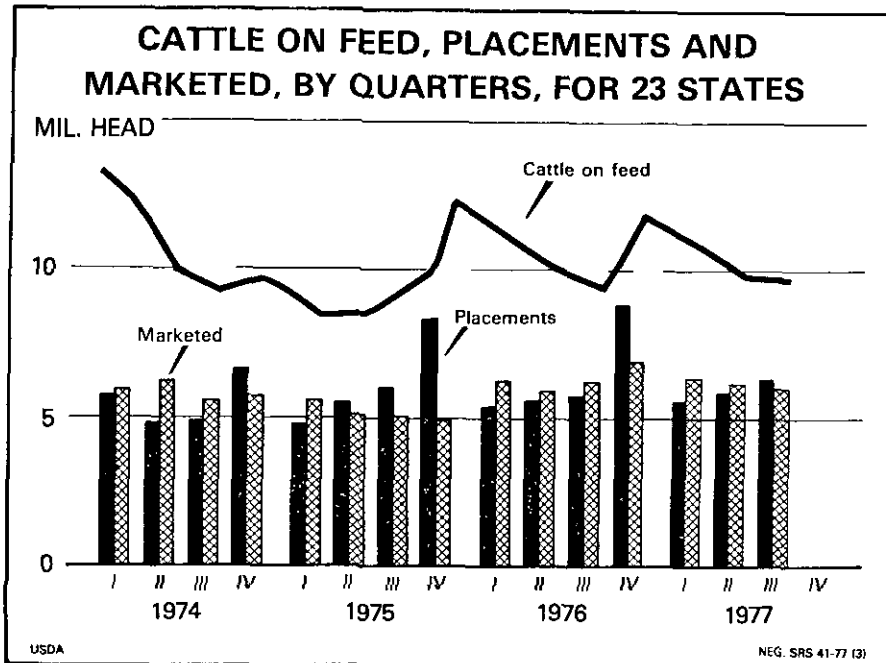
There were 6,305,000 steers and steer calves on feed, 7 percent above a year earlier, but 10,000 head below 1975. Steers and steer calves accounted for 65 percent of the total, 1 percent above 1976. Heifer and heifer calves totaled 3,436,000, 3 percent above last year and 17 percent above 1975. This is the largest number of heifers on feed for October in records dating back to 1960.

## MARKETINGS EXPECTED TO RISE SLIGHTLY:

During October-December 1977, cattle feeders intend to market 5,842,000 head, 3 percent more than the fourth quarter marketings in 1976, but 14 percent below the record marketings for the quarter in 1972.

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals) were estimated at 6,948,000, up 6 percent from a year earlier and 3 percent above September 1, 1977. Placements were 1,837,000, 10 percent more than September 1976. Net placements during September totaled 1,770,000, up 9 percent from a year earlier. Marketings during September were 1,540,000, up 4 percent from a year ago.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report 63 percent was actually reported in the survey.
