CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS & MARKETINGS UP:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on April 1, 1978 in the 23 States totaled 11,716,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 10 percent more than in feedlots a year ago, but 8 percent less than on January 1, 1978 and 12 percent below the record for April 1 set in 1973. Placements of cattle and calves in the 23 States during January-March at 6,479,000 were up 15 percent from the same quarter in 1977 and 19 percent above 1976. Record highs for the quarter were recorded for both total placements and fed marketings. Net placements, at 5,690,000 were 11 percent above 1977 and 16 percent above 1976. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter the past quarter totaled 6,773,000, up 5 percent from the same period last year and 7 percent above 1976. Other disappearance totaled 789,000, well above 1977 and 1976. Good to excellent pasture conditions in most plains and western States allowed more cattle to move from feedlots back to pastures.

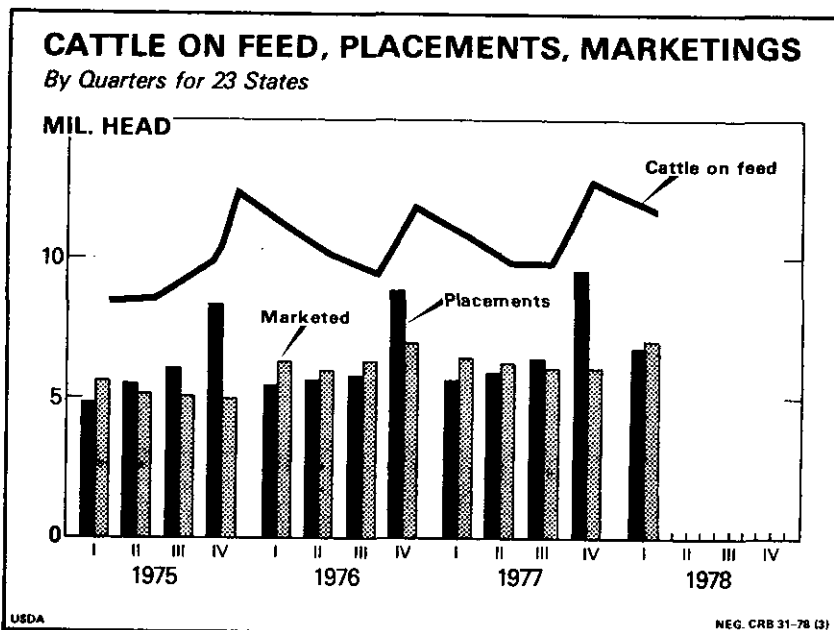
Steers and steer calves on feed April 1 amounted to 7,395,000 head, 5 percent above 1977 and 1 percent above 1976. Steers and steer calves accounted for only 63 percent of the total on feed, the lowest percent of total on record. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 4,277,000, 21 percent more than last year and 22 percent greater than 1976.

MARKETINGS EXPECTED TO RISE 7 PERCENT:

Cattle feeders expect to market 6,566,000 head during April-June 1978, an increase of 7 percent from last year and 11 percent above 1976.

7 MONTHLY STATES UP 13 PERCENT:

Cattle and calves on feed in the 7 monthly States, (included in 23 State totals), were estimated at 8,262,000 head, up 13 percent from last year and the highest April 1 total in 4 years. Placements jumped to a record 1,887,000 during March, up 22 percent from a year ago. March marketings totaled 1,698,000 fed cattle, off 1 percent from last year, but 2 percent above the previous month. Other disappearance rose to 203,000 head, compared with 111,000 last year.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The State Statistical Offices maintain an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report 66 percent was actually reported in the survey.
