CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS, MARKETINGS RISE

Feedlots in 23 major feeding States held 10.9 million cattle and calves for slaughter on July 1, 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board, 12 percent more than a year earlier but 7 percent below April 1, 1978. During April through June, 6.53 million head were placed on feed, a record high, and 9 percent above the same quarter in 1977. Other disappearance was estimated at 734 thousand head, leaving net placements of 5.80 million. Other disappearance totaled 714 thousand and 519 thousand during this quarter in 1977 and 1976. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter in the April-June quarter amounted to 6.59 million head, up 7 percent and 11 percent from those months in 1977 and 1976.

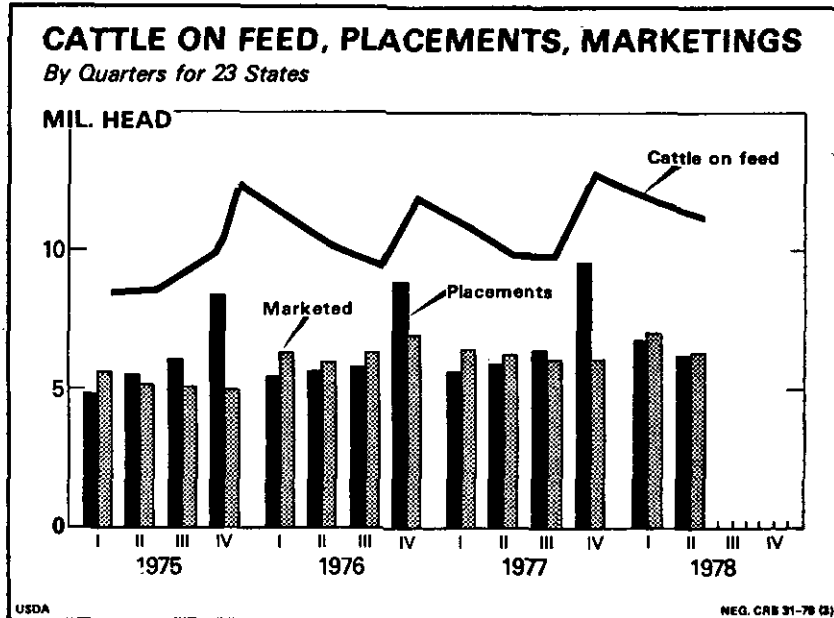
The total on July 1 included 6.86 million steers and steer calves, 7 percent above 1977 and 4 percent above 1976, and accounted for 63 percent of the total on feed. Heifers and heifer calves reached a record high, 4.01 million head, 20 percent more than last year and 18 percent greater than 1976.

MARKETINGS EXPECTED TO RISE 7 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 6.60 million head during July-September 1978, an increase of 7 percent over last year and 6 percent above 1976.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED UP 16 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States estimated monthly (included in 23 State totals), were estimated at 7.98 million head, up 16 percent from last year and 13 percent above 1976. Placements during June totaled a record 1.77 million head, up 21 percent from a year ago and 27 percent over 1976. June marketings at 1.65 million were 7 percent above last year, but 2 percent below the previous month. Expected marketings for these 7 States during July-September are 4.94 million, up 8 percent from the same quarter last year.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The State Statistical Offices maintain an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the first day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report 71 percent were actually reported in the survey.
