CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS, MARKETINGS CLIMB

Feedlots in 23 major feeding States totaled 11.3 million cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on October 1, 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board, 16 percent more than on October 1, 1977. This is the highest October 1 on-feed inventory since 1973 but only 4 percent above July 1, 1978. Placements on feed during the July-September quarter totaled 7.36 million, a record high, 14 percent above the previous record of 6.48 million during this period in 1977. Other disappearance totaled 406 thousand leaving net placements of 6.96 million. During the July-September quarter in 1977, other disappearance was estimated at 292 thousand. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the July-September quarter was 6.54 million, up 6 percent from this period in 1977.

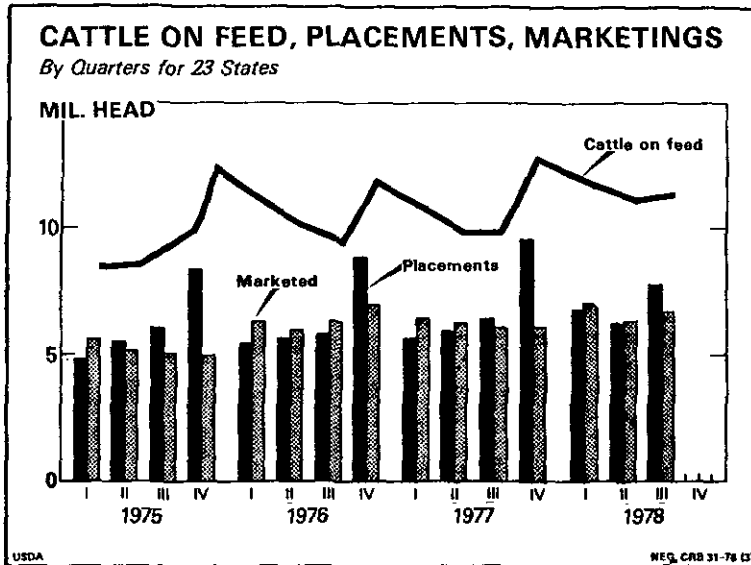
The October 1 total included 7.49 million steers and steer calves, 18 percent above 1977 and 27 percent above 1976. Steers accounted for 66 percent of the total on feed. Heifers and heifer calves reached a new October 1 record high of 3.82 million head, 11 percent above 1977 and 15 percent higher than 1976.

MARKETINGS EXPECTED TO INCREASE 9 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 6.61 million head during October-December 1978. If this total is realized, 4th quarter fed marketings would be 9 percent above last year and 16 percent greater than 1976.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED UP 23 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in the 7 monthly States (included in 23 State totals), were estimated at 8.54 million head, up 23 percent from last year and 30 percent more than 1976. Placements during September were a record 2.49 million, 36 percent greater than last year and 49 percent above 1976. September marketings at 1.66 million were 8 percent above last year and virtually the same as August 1978. Expected 7-State marketings during October-December 1978 are 5.11 million, up 9 percent from the same period in 1977.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE FIRST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 71 PERCENT WERE ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
