## CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DECREASE 6 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on April 1, 1979 totaled 11.1 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This count dropped 6 percent from April 1, 1978 but was 4 percent above the number on feed April 1, 1977. With the exception of 1978 it is the highest April 1 number on feed since 1974. Placements during the January-March quarter totaled 5.88 million, down 9 percent from the comparable quarter last year but 5 percent above the same quarter in 1977. Other disappearance totaled 713 thousand leaving net placements of 5.16 million. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during January-March totaled 6.77 million, just slightly below the record 1978 quarter marketings.

The April 1, 1979 number of cattle on feed included 7.33 million steers and steer calves, 1 percent less than a year ago but 4 percent above 1977. Steers accounted for 66 percent of the total on feed. Heifers and heifer calves on feed totaled 3.70 million, down 14 percent from 1978 but up 5 percent from 1977.

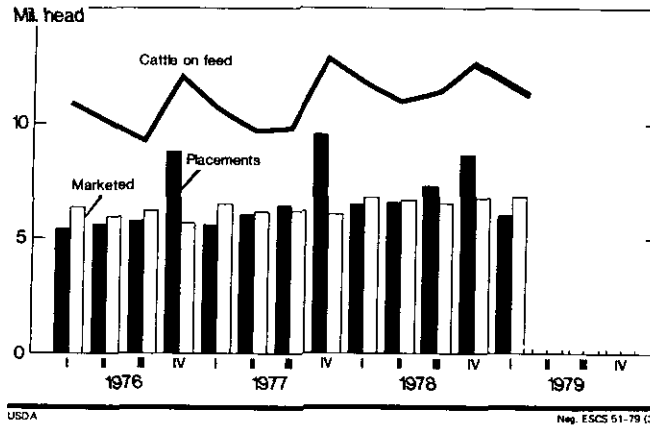
## NEXT QUARTER EXPECTED MARKETINGS DOWN 4 PERCENT

During the April-June 1979 quarter, cattle feeders intend to market 6.35 million head. This would be 4 percent below the second quarter marketings in 1978 but 3 percent more than 1977.

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 4 PERCENT

In the 7 monthly States, the total number on feed at 7.95 million is down 4 percent from a year earlier but 9 percent more than April 1, 1977. The 7-State total accounted for 72 percent of the 23-State number on feed. Placements in feedlots during March at 1.61 million declined 14 percent from last year's level, but were 4 percent above March 1977. Marketings during March at 1.70 million were 1 percent greater than last year although 1 percent smaller than 2 years ago. Marketings for the 7 States during the quarter accounted for 77 percent of the 23-State total compared with 75 percent a year ago. Other disappearance dropped to 181,000 head compared with 203,000 a year ago. Expected 7-State marketings during the April-June 1979 quarter are estimated at 4.84 million, 4 percent fewer than 1978 yet 6 percent more than 1977.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The State Statistical Offices maintain an up-to-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report 68 percent was actually reported in the survey.
