## CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS, MARKETINGS DECLINE

Feedlots in the 23 major feeding States totaled 9.93 million cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on October 1, 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 13 percent less than last year's October 1 estimate but 1 percent above the 1977 comparable estimate. This October 1 total is 4 percent below the July 1, 1979 estimate. Placements during the July-September quarter, at 5.95 million head, were down 19 percent from last year and the lowest since 1976. Other disappearance for the third quarter in 1979 was below 1978, totaling 352 thousand head; Net placements totaled 5.60 million head. Marketings during July-September dropped 8 percent compared with the same quarter in 1978. The 5.98 million head marketed for slaughter is the lowest since 1975.

The October 1 total number on feed included 6.69 million steers and steer calves, 11 percent below 1978 but 6 percent above 1977. They accounted for 67 percent of the total on feed. Heifers and heifer calves were estimated at 3.20 million, 16 percent below last year's record high and 7 percent less than 1977.

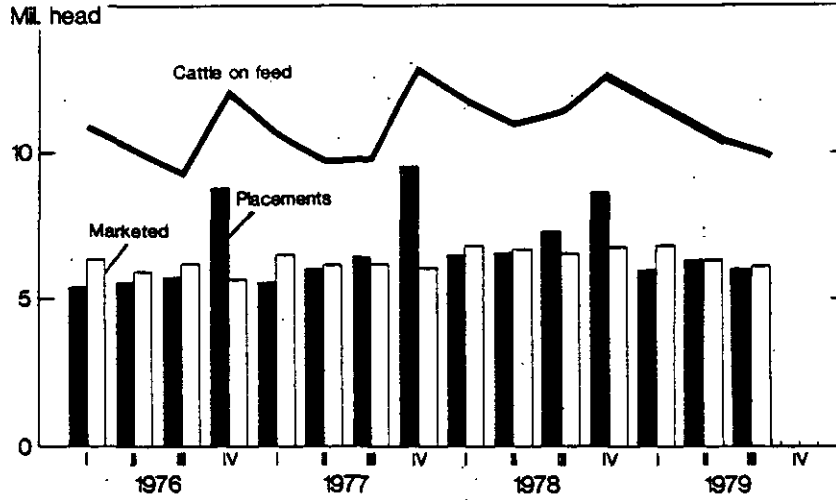
## EXPECTED MARKETINGS DECREASE 11 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.98 million head during October-December 1979. If this total is realized, 4th quarter fed marketings would be 11 percent less than last year and 2 percent less than the 1977 marketings for the same period.

## 7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 13 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in the 7 monthly States (included in the 23 State totals), were estimated at 7.42 million head, down 13 percent from last year, but 7 percent more than 1977. Placements during September were 2.05 million, down 17 percent from last year, but up 12 percent from 1977. Net placements totaled 1.96 million. September marketings at 1.38 million were 16 percent less than last year and down 10 percent from September 1977. Marketings during the July-September quarter totaled 4.49 million and accounted for 75 percent of the 23 State total, the same percentage as a year ago. Expected 7-State marketings during October-December 1979 are 4.59 million, down 13 percent from the same period in 1978.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 73 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
