

# CATTLE ON FEED

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## CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DOWN 7 PERCENT:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in 23 States on January 1, 1980 totaled 11.7 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This number was down 7 percent from January 1, 1979 and 8 percent below January 1, 1978. Placements during the October-December 1979 quarter were 8.10 million, 7 percent below 1978 and 15 percent lower than the 1977 fourth quarter. Other disappearance of 571 thousand leaves a net placement of 7.53 million. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the October-December 1979 quarter were 5.73 million, 15 percent and 6 percent below 1978 and 1977, respectively.

The January 1, 1980 number of cattle on feed included 7.91 million steers and steer calves, 7 percent below January 1, 1979 and 5 percent below January 1, 1978. Steers and steer calves accounted for 67 percent of total cattle on feed. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3.72 million, 9 percent below 1979 and 16 percent below 1978. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 32 percent of all cattle on feed.

## JANUARY-MARCH EXPECTED MARKETINGS BELOW LAST TWO YEARS:

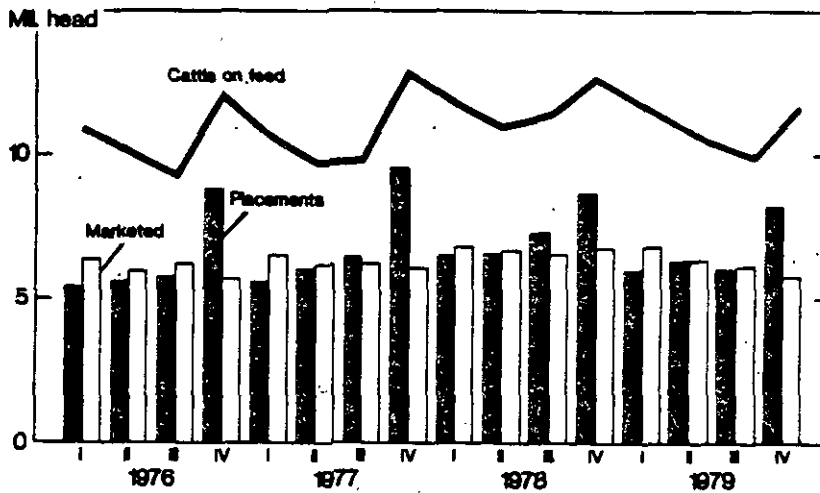
Cattle feeders intend to market 6.38 million during the January-March quarter of 1980. If this total is realized, the first quarter marketings would be 5 percent below 1979 and 6 percent below the same period of 1978.

## 7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 8 PERCENT:

Cattle on feed in the 7 monthly States totaled 8.45 million, 8 percent below January 1, 1979 and 5 percent below two years ago. The 7 States accounted for 72 percent of the 23 State total. Feedlot placements during December at 1.65 million were 5 percent below last year and 20 percent below December 1977. Marketings during December 1979 totaled 1.33 million, 20 percent below December 1978 and 17 percent below 1977. The October-December 1979 quarterly marketings for the 7 States at 4.41 million were 16 percent below a year earlier. January-March 1980 expected marketings in the 7 States are 4.82 million, 7 percent below 1979.

This report provides only cattle on feed data for the 23 quarterly States. The number of cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1980 by States and for the United States will be published in the Cattle Report to be issued January 30, 1980.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 71 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
