CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 8 PERCENT IN 23 STATES

Cattle and Calves on feed for slaughter market in the 23 States on April 1, 1980 totaled 10.2 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This number was down 8 percent from the same date in 1979 and is 13 percent less than 2 years ago. All classes and weight groups were below last year, except steers weighing 1100 pounds or more up 7 percent, and heifers 900 pounds and over up 27 percent. Together these represent 13 percent of the number on feed.

PLACEMENTS during January - March were 5.22 million, 11 percent fewer than in the corresponding quarter in 1979 and 20 percent less than the first quarter of 1978. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 572 Thousand leaves net placements of 4.65 million. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter January-March totaled 6.16 million, down 9 percent from the same period in both 1979 & 1978.

The April 1, 1980 Cattle on feed inventory included 6.82 million steers and steer calves, down 7 percent from a year ago and 8 percent from 2 years ago. Steers and steer calves represented 67 percent of the total this April 1 compared with 66 percent in 1979 & 63 percent in 1978. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3.34 million, 10 percent below April 1, 1979 and 22 percent below April 1, 1978.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS NEXT QUARTER DOWN 4 PERCENT

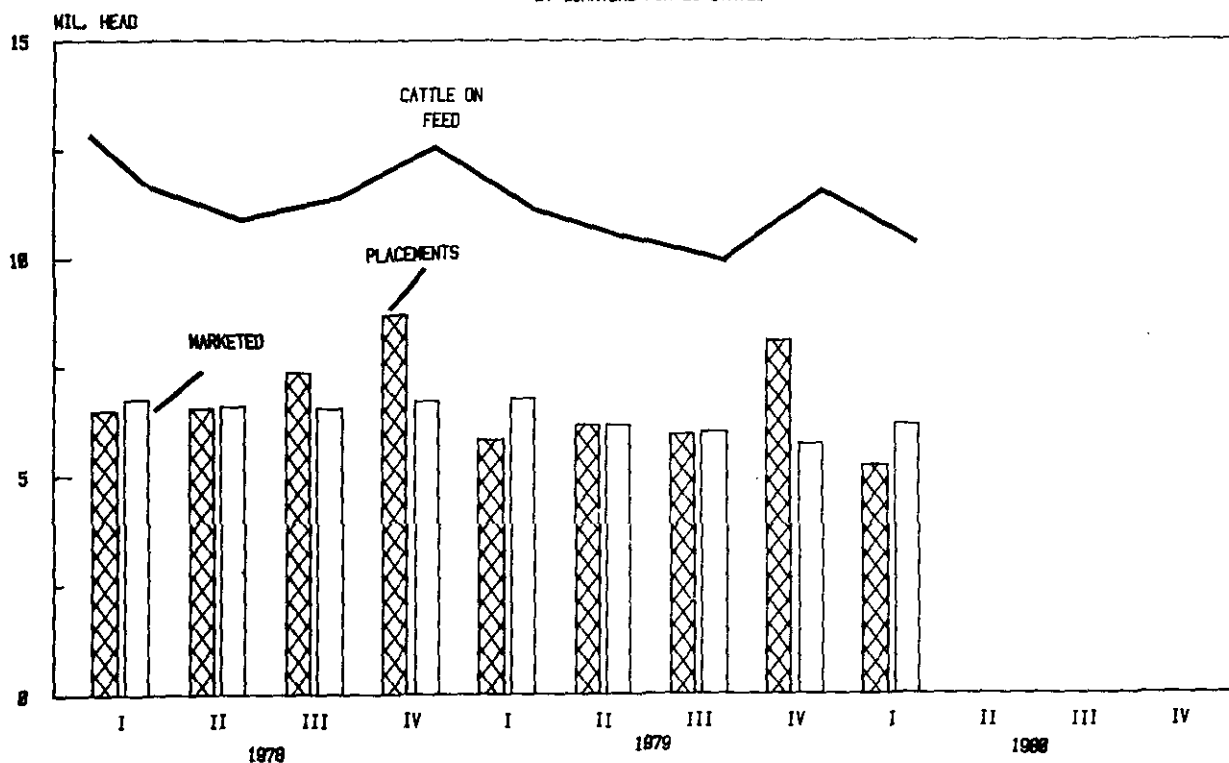
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.91 million head during the April - June quarter of 1980. This would be 4 percent less than second quarter marketings in 1979 and 11 percent below the same period in 1978.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 9 PERCENT

Cattle on feed in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.16 million, 10 percent fewer than April 1, 1979 and 13 percent below two years ago. Placements in feedlots during March at 1.31 million declined 18 percent from last year's level and 30 percent below March 1978. Marketings during March totaled 1.48 million, 12 percent below 1979 and 1978 levels. The January - March 1980 quarterly marketings for the 7 States at 4.74 million were 9 percent less than a year earlier and accounted for 77 percent of the 23 State total. Other disappearance during March 1980 dropped to 117 Thousand compared with 181 Thousand a year ago. Expected 7 - State marketings during the April - June 1980 quarter are estimated at 4.43 million, down 6 percent from the corresponding quarter last year.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 67 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
