FEEDLOT NUMBERS OFF 7 PERCENT IN 23 STATES

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market totaled 9.62 million head on July 1, 1980 in the 23 States, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number on feed was 7 percent less than July 1, 1979, 12 percent below the July 1, 1978 level, and the smallest number on feed for this date since 1975. The only weight group totals that exceeded previous year numbers were heifers 700-899 pounds, up 1 percent, and heifers 900 pounds and over, up 7 percent. Placements during the April-June quarter totaled 5.63 million, down 9 percent from the same quarter last year and 14 percent less than the second quarter of 1978. Other disappearance of 589 thousand head leaves net placements of 5.04 million. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the April-June period totaled 5.62 million, down 9 percent from the comparable quarter in 1979 and 15 percent below the 1978 level.

The July 1, 1980 number of cattle on feed included 6.29 million steers and steer calves, 8 percent less than the two previous years. Steers and steer calves accounted for 65 percent of the total on feed. Heifers and heifer calves on feed totaled 3.27 million, down 5 percent from 1979 and 18 percent below 1978.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS DOWN 4 PERCENT

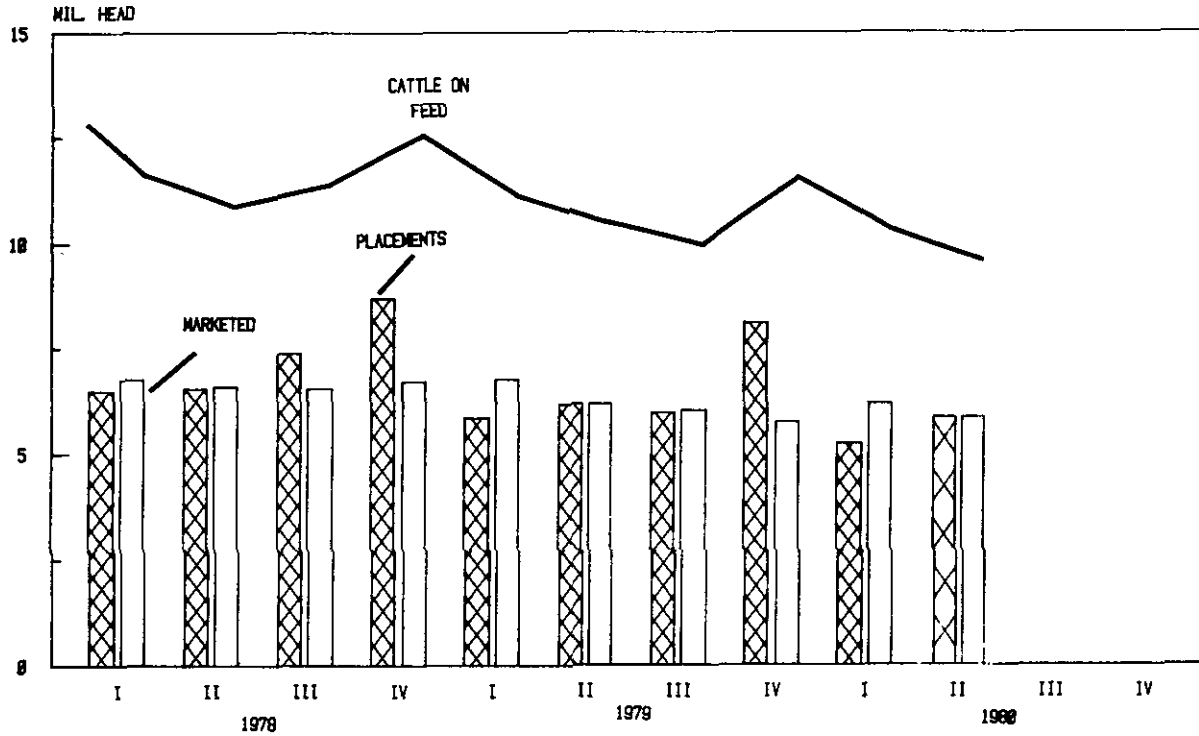
During the July-September quarter, cattle feeders intend to market 5.75 million head. This would be 4 percent below the third quarter marketings of 1979 and 12 percent below 1978.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 10 PERCENT

In the 7 monthly States, the total number on feed at 6.79 million is down 10 percent from a year earlier and 15 percent below July 1, 1978. This is the lowest July 1 figure since 1975. The 7 States accounted for 71 percent of the 23-State total on feed. Placements in feedlots during June at 1.45 million declined 8 percent from last year's level and was 18 percent below June 1978. Marketings during June at 1.40 million were 10 percent below last year and 16 percent less than June 1978. Marketings for the 7 States during the April-June quarter accounted for 75 percent of the 23-State total compared with 76 percent last year. Other disappearance during June dropped to 113 thousand compared with 158 thousand a year ago. Expected 7-State marketings during the July-September quarter are estimated at 4.18 million, 7 percent fewer than the corresponding period of 1979 and 15 percent less than 1978.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 69 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
