CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES UP FRACTIONALLY

Cattle and Calves on feed for slaughter market totaled 9.99 million head in the 23 States on October 1, 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number on feed was virtually unchanged from 1979 but 12 percent less than on October 1, 1978. PLACEMENTS during the July-September quarter totaled 6.41 million, an increase of 8 percent over the same quarter last year but 13 percent less than the third quarter of 1978. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 299 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS of 6.11 million. MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during the July-September quarter totaled 5.75 million, down 4 percent from the comparable quarter in 1979 and 12 percent less than 1978.

The October 1, 1980 number of cattle on feed included 6.88 million steers and steer calves, up 3 percent from last year but down 8 percent from 1978. Steers and steer calves accounted for 69 percent of the total on feed October 1, 1980. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3.06 million, down 4 percent from 1979 and 20 percent below 1978.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS UP 3 PERCENT

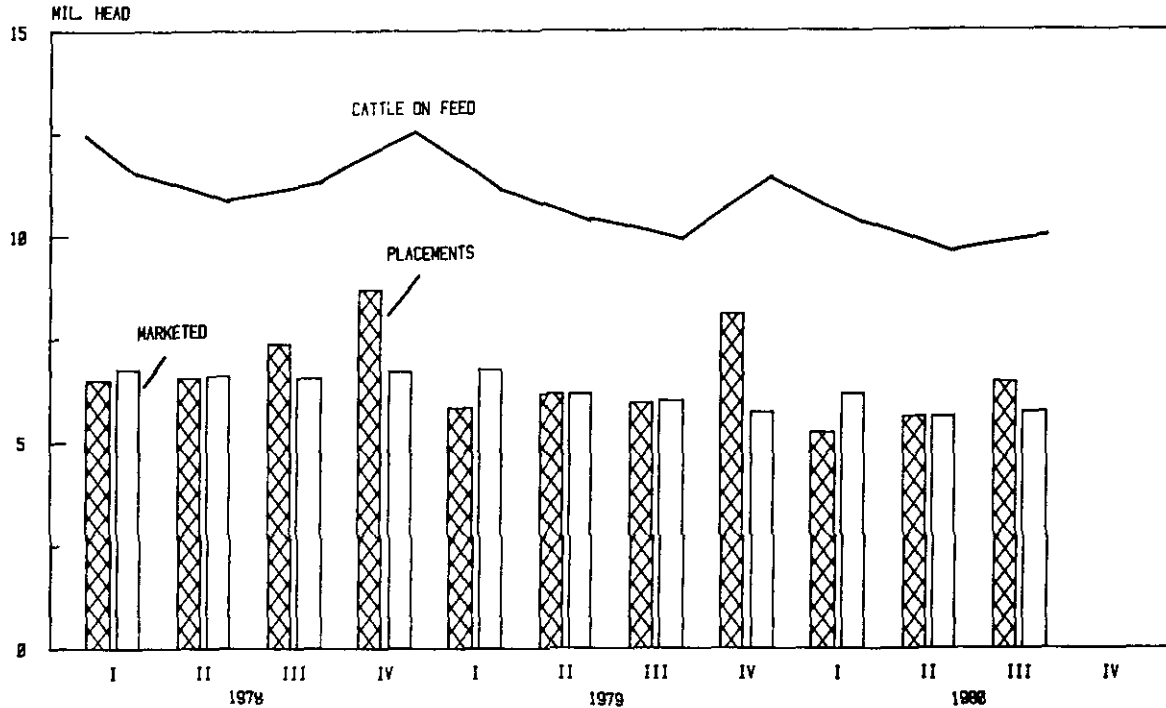
During the October-December quarter, cattle feeders intend to market 5.88 million head. This would be 3 percent above the fourth quarter marketings of 1979 but 13 percent less than the last quarter of 1978.

7 MONTHLY CATTLE ON FEED STATES DOWN 2 PERCENT

In the seven monthly States, the number of cattle and calves on feed totaled 7.25 million, down 2 percent from last year and 15 percent below October 1, 1978. The seven States accounted for 73 percent of the 23-States total on feed. Feedlot PLACEMENTS during September at 1.74 million declined 15 percent from a year earlier and were off 30 percent from September 1978. September MARKETINGS totaled 1.46 million in the 7 States, 5 percent higher than in 1979 but an 11 percent decline compared with September 1978. MARKETINGS for the 7 States during the July-September quarter accounted for 73 percent of the 23-States total compared with 75 percent last year. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during September dropped to 73 thousand head compared with 86 and 126 thousand in 1979 and 1978, respectively. The expected marketings for the 7 States during the October-December quarter is 4.43 million, compared with 4.41 million during the comparable quarter last year.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED ESTIMATED IN THIS REPORT 69 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
