CATTLE ON FEED IN 23 STATES DOWN 5 PERCENT:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market totaled 11.1 million head in the 23 States on January 1, 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number on feed was 5 percent below a year ago and 12 percent below January 1, 1979. Placements during the October-December 1980 quarter totaled 7.34 million, a decrease of 9 percent from the same quarter a year earlier and 15 percent less than the fourth quarter of 1978. Other disappearance of 523 thousand head leaves net placements of 6.82 million. Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the October-December 1980 quarter totaled 5.68 million, down 1 percent from the comparable quarter in 1979 and 16 percent less than 1978.

The January 1, 1981 number of cattle on feed included 7.49 million steers and steer calves, a decline of 5 percent from a year earlier and 12 percent fewer than January 1, 1979. Steers and steer calves accounted for 67 percent of the total. Heifers and heifer calves on feed totaled 3.54 million, down 5 percent from January 1, 1980 and 14 percent below January 1, 1979.

JANUARY-MARCH EXPECTED MARKETINGS UP 2 PERCENT:

Cattle feeders intend to market 6.29 million head during the January-March quarter of 1981. If this total is realized, the first quarter marketings would be 2 percent more than 1980 but 7 percent less than the same quarter in 1979.

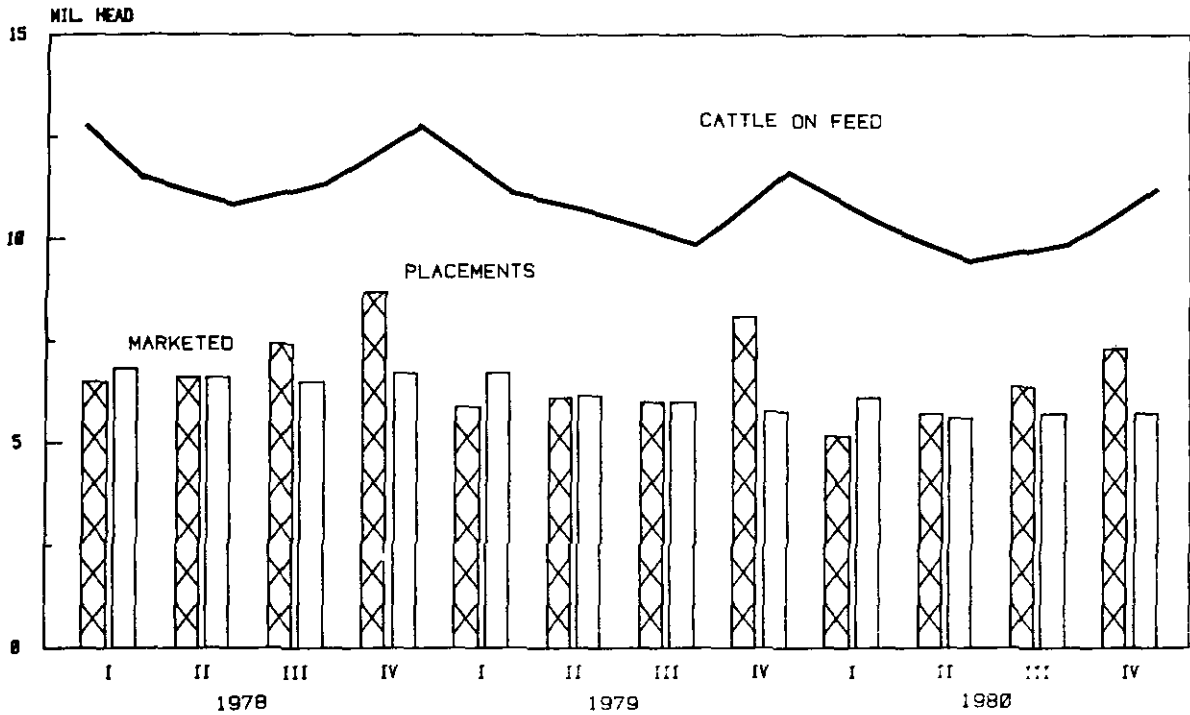
7 MONTHLY CATTLE ON FEED STATES DOWN 7 PERCENT:

Cattle and calves on feed in the seven monthly States totaled 7.86 million head, off 7 percent from a year earlier and 15 percent lower than January 1, 1979. The 7 States accounted for 71 percent of the 23-State total on feed. Placements in feedlots during December amounted to 1.39 million head, 17 percent lower than December 1979 and off 20 percent from December 1978. December marketings totaled 1.36 million in the 7 States, 1 percent more than 1979 but 18 percent lower than 1978. Seven-State marketings during the October-December quarter accounted for 76 percent of the 23-State total compared with 77 percent for the same period in 1979. Other disappearance in December amounted to 130 thousand, compared with 133 and 176 thousand in 1979 and 1978, respectively. Expected marketings for the 7 States during the January-March quarter are estimated at 4.73 million, virtually unchanged from the corresponding period last year.

This report provides data for the 23 Quarterly States only. The number of cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1981, by States for the the United States will be published in the Cattle Report to be issued January 30, 1981. Final estimates of cattle for 1976-79 are now available in Statistical Bulletin No. 655.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED ESTIMATED IN THIS REPORT 69 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
