CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 4 PERCENT IN 23 STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1 for slaughter market in 23 States totaled 9.76 million head, down 4 percent from a year ago and 12 percent less than 2 years ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the lowest April 1 number on feed since 1975.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the January-March quarter were 5.15 million, 1 percent fewer than in the corresponding quarter in 1980 and 12 percent less than the first quarter of 1979. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 502 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS of 4.65 million. MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during January-March totaled 6.00 million, down 2 percent from the same period in 1980, and down 11 percent from January-March 1979. Both marketings and placements for the 23 States during the January-March quarter were the smallest since 1975.

The April 1, 1981 Cattle on Feed inventory included 6.58 million steers and steer calves, down 3 percent from a year ago, and 10 percent from 2 years ago. Steers and steer calves represented 67 percent of the April 1 total in both 1981 and 1980. Heifers and heifer calves totaled 3.13 million, 6 percent below April 1, 1980 and off 15 percent from April 1, 1979.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS NEXT QUARTER DOWN 2 PERCENT

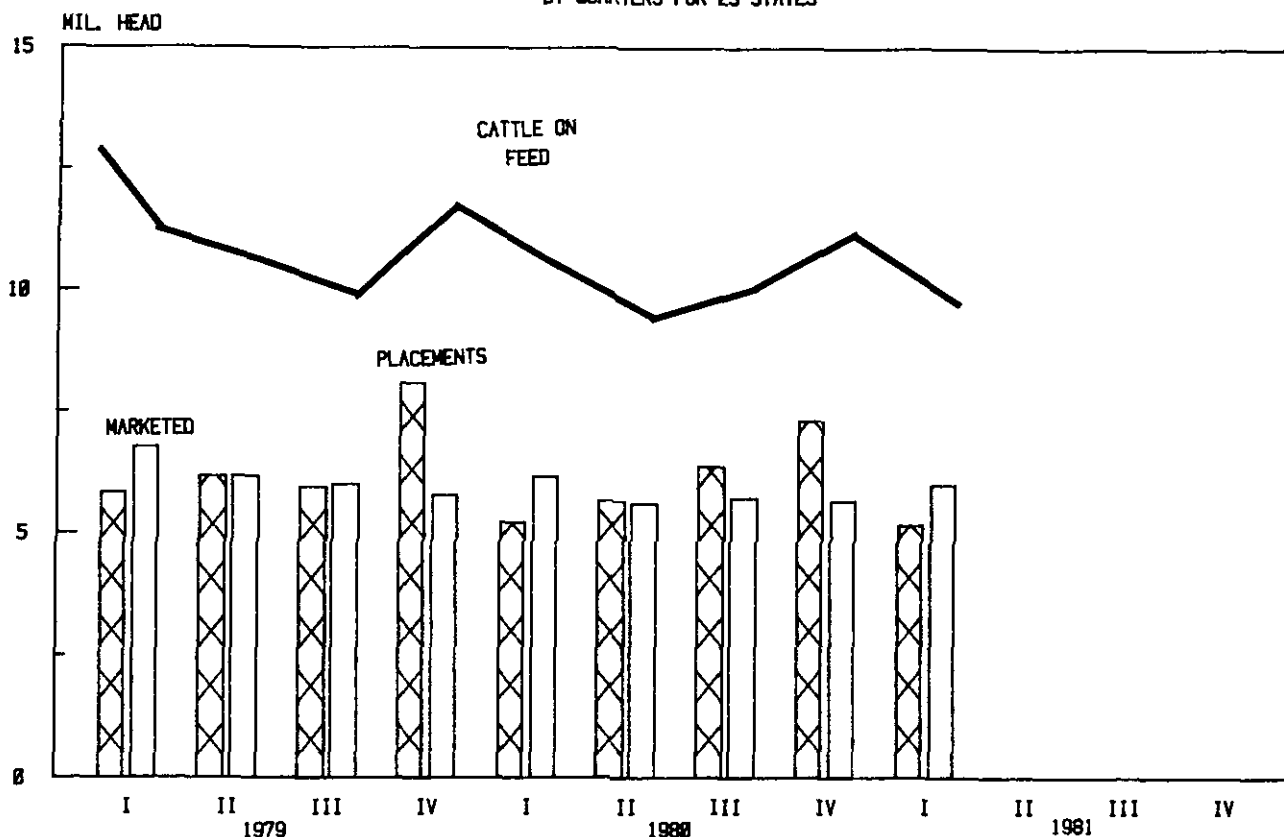
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.54 million head during the April-June quarter of 1981. This would be 2 percent less than second quarter marketings in 1980 and 10 percent below the same period in 1979.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 4 PERCENT

Cattle on feed in the 7 monthly States totaled 6.84 million, 4 percent fewer than April 1, 1980 and 14 percent below two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March at 1.37 million increased 4 percent from last year's level but were 14 percent below March 1979. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.54 million, 4 percent above 1980 but 9 percent less than March 1979. The January-March 1981 quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.50 million, were 5 percent less than a year earlier and accounted for 75 percent of the 23 State total. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March 1981 was 119 thousand, up 2000 from a year earlier. Expected 7 State marketings during the April-June 1981 quarter are estimated at 4.12 million, down 2 percent from the corresponding quarter last year.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 62 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.

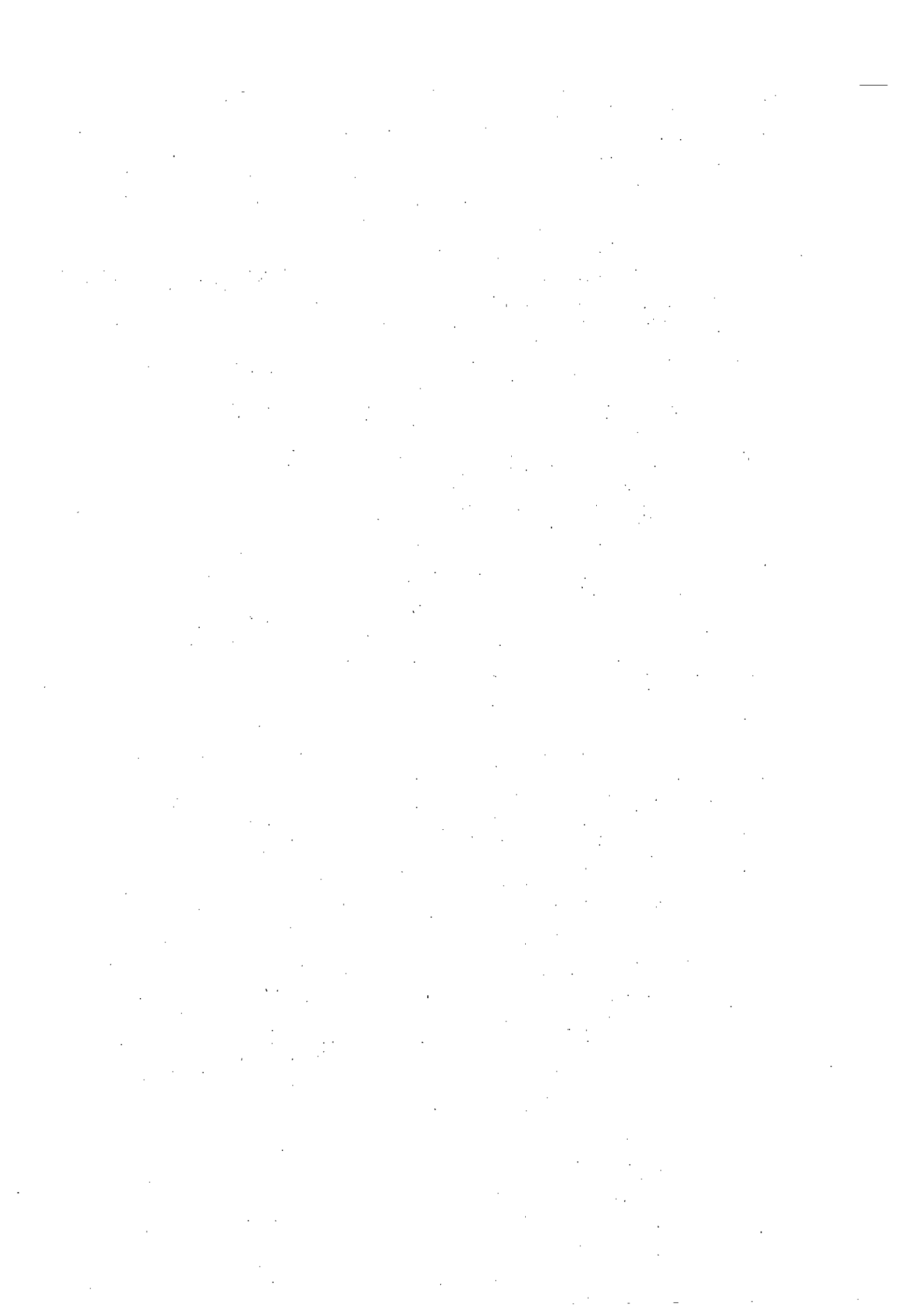

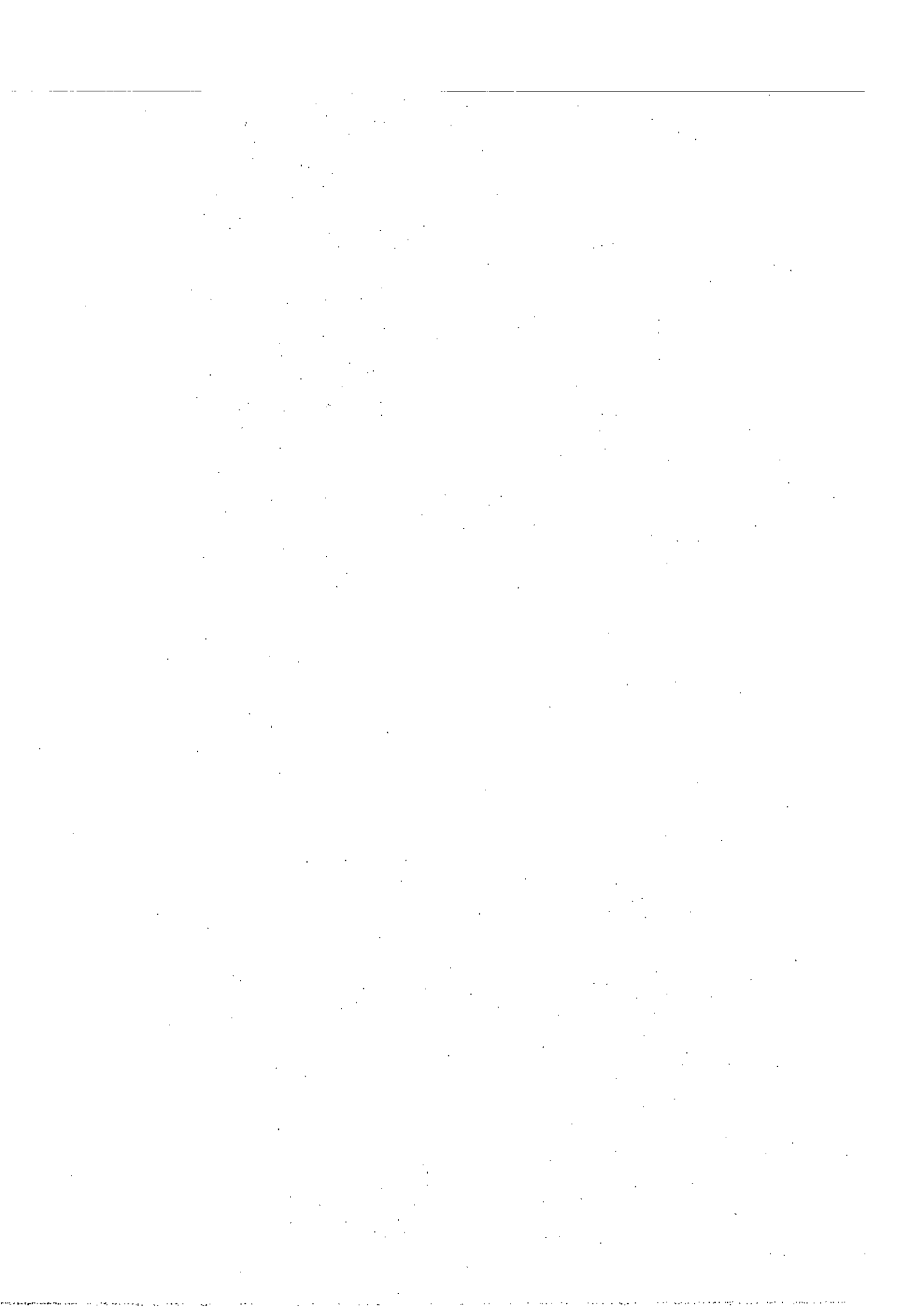
