CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 9 PERCENT IN 23 STATES

CATTLE AND CALVES ON FEED October 1, 1981, for slaughter market in the 23 States totaled 9.03 million head, 9 percent below both a year earlier and 2 years ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the lowest October 1 number on feed since 1967. All weight groups for heifers and steers are below a year earlier except the heaviest weight group of steers which is 1 percent above last year.

The October 1, 1981, Cattle on Feed inventory included 6.17 million steers and steer calves, down 10 percent from a year ago and 8 percent from 2 years ago. Steer and steer calves represented 68 percent of the total October 1, 1981, number on feed compared with 69 percent a year ago. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 2.84 million, 7 percent below a year earlier and 11 percent below October 1, 1979.

PLACEMENTS during the July-September quarter totaled 5.67 million, 11 percent below the same quarter last year and 5 percent below the comparable period in 1979. Placements for the July-September 1981 quarter were the lowest since 1974.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 281 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS of 5.39 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during July-September totaled 5.93 million, up 4 percent from the same quarter last year but 1 percent below July-September of 1979.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS DOWN 3 PERCENT

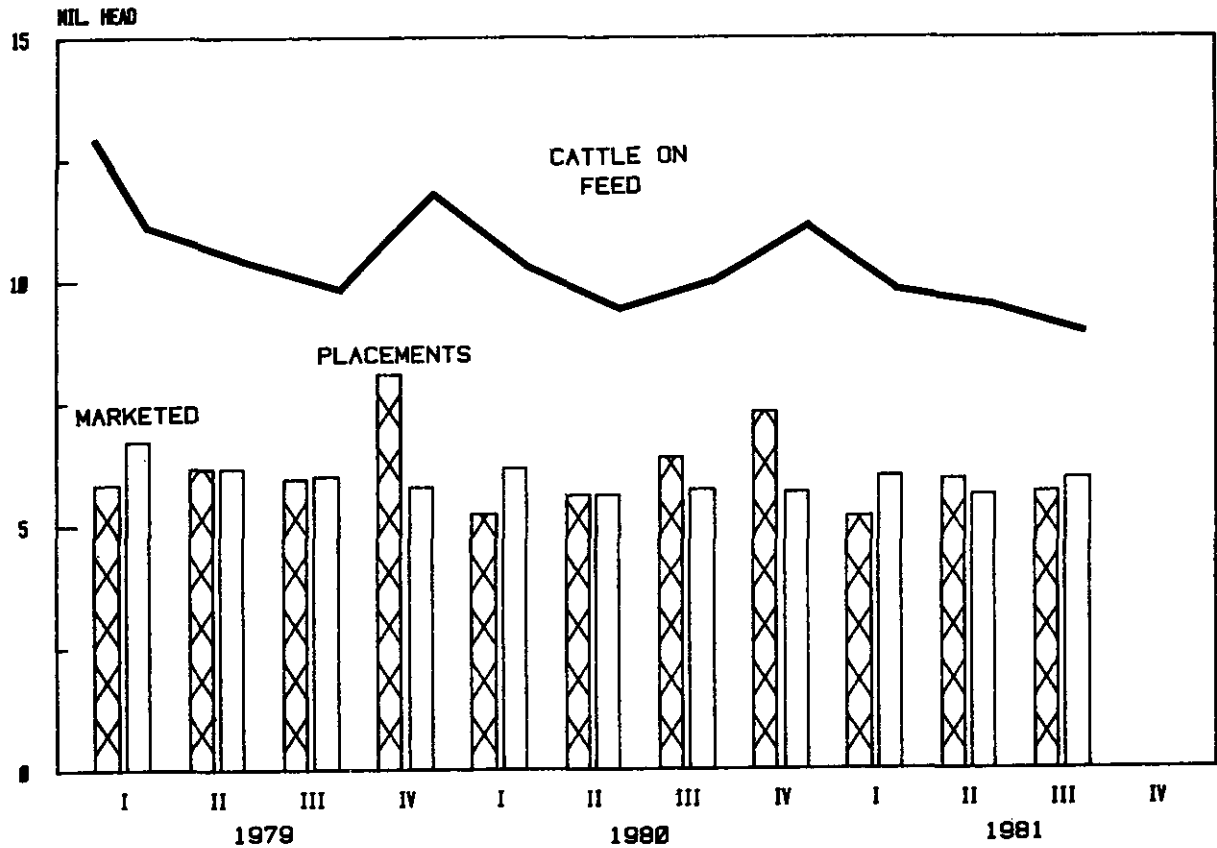
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.49 million head during the October-December quarter of 1981. This would be 3 percent less than fourth quarter marketings in 1980 and 5 percent below 1979.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 9 PERCENT

Cattle on feed in the 7 monthly States totaled 6.60 million, 9 percent below a year earlier and 11 percent below 1979. PLACEMENTS into feedlots during September, at 1.83 million, were 5 percent above 1980 but 11 percent below 1979. MARKETINGS during September totaled 1.43 million, 2 percent below 1980 but 3 percent more than September 1979. The July-September 1981 quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.37 million, were 4 percent above last year but 2 percent below 1979. Marketings for the 7 States during July-September accounted for 74 percent of the 23-State total. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during September totaled 86 thousand, compared with 73 thousand last year. EXPECTED MARKETINGS from the 7 States during the October-December quarter are estimated at 4.11 million, 4 percent less than the corresponding period of 1980 and 7 percent below 1979.
