CATTLE ON FEED UP 2 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1 for slaughter market in 13 States totaled 8.82 million head, up 2 percent from last year but 2 percent below two years ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the first year-to-year increase on April 1 since 1978.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.67 million steers and steer calves, down 2 percent from last year and 6 percent below 1980. Steer and steer calves represented 64 percent of the total April 1, 1982 number on feed compared with 67 percent a year ago. Heifers and heifer calves, accounting for 3.11 million of the April 1 inventory, were 10 percent greater than last year and 4 percent more than two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the January-March 1982 quarter were 5.57 million, 16 percent more than the corresponding year earlier quarter and 15 percent more than the comparable quarter of 1980. This is the highest number of placements during January-March since 1978.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 339 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS of 5.23 million. MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during January-March totaled 5.44 million, 2 percent below the same quarter last year, and 4 percent below the corresponding 1980 quarter. This is the lowest number marketed in the 13 States during the January-March quarter since 1975.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE UP 2 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.21 million head during the April-June quarter of 1982. This would be 2 percent greater than the second quarter of both 1981 and 1980.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED UP 3 PERCENT

Cattle on feed in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.02 million, 3 percent more than April 1, 1981, but 2 percent less than two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March, at 1.79 million, increased 30 percent from last year's low level and 37 percent more than March 1980. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.54 million, 1 percent less than 1981 but 4 percent greater than 1980. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 96 thousand compared with 119 thousand last year.

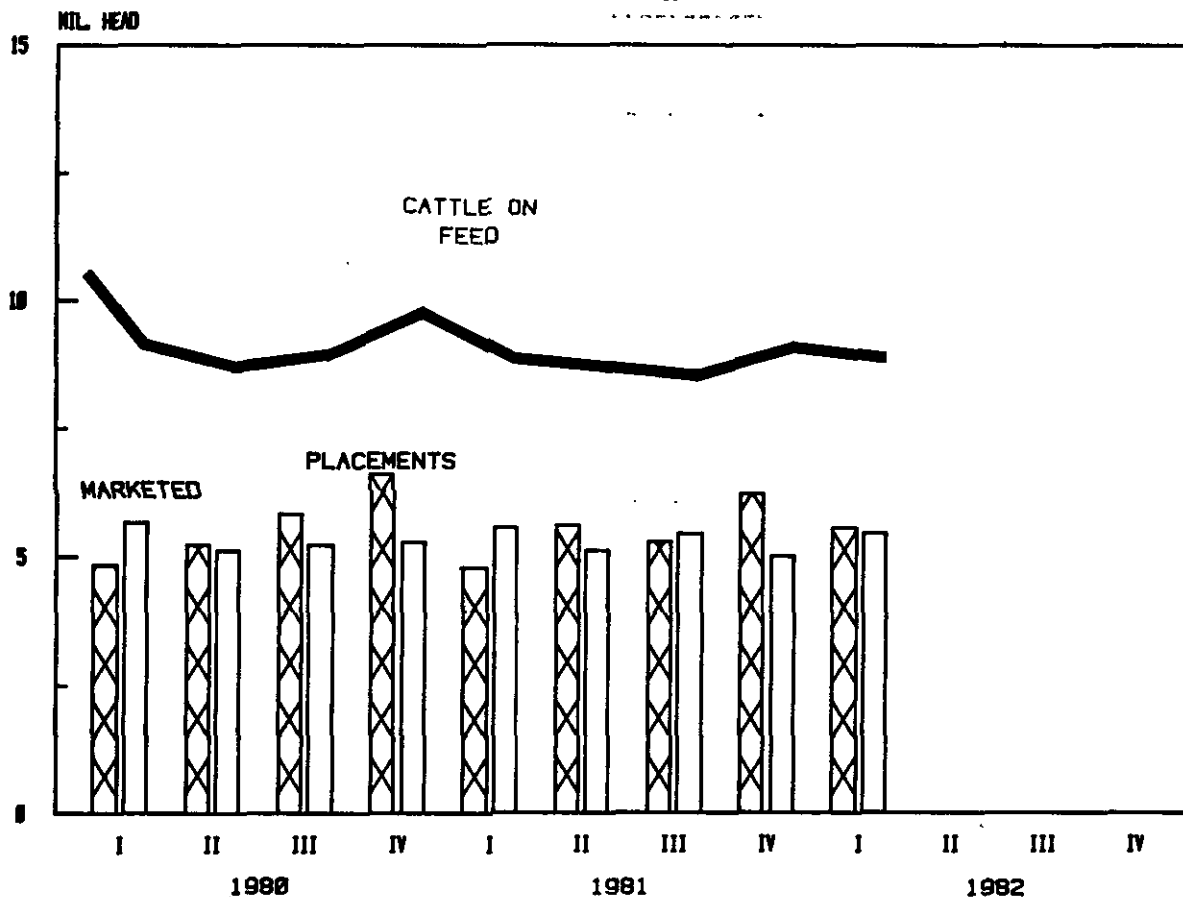
The January-March quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.48 million, were down 1 percent from last year and off 5 percent from the same quarter in 1980. The January-March marketings in the 7 States accounted for 82 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the April-June 1982 quarter are estimated at 4.31 million, up 2 percent from the same quarter in 1981.

Coverage of the quarterly Cattle on Feed report is reduced from 23 to 13 States. The monthly report will continue to cover 7 major cattle feeding States.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 66 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
