CATTLE ON FEED—13 STATES

CATTLE ON FEED UP 4 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1982, for slaughter market in the 13 States, totaled 8.98 million head, 4 percent more than both last year and two years ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.64 million steers and steer calves, up 2 percent from last year and up 1 percent from 1980. This group represented 63 percent of the total July 1 number on feed compared with 64 percent in 1981 and is the first year-to-year increase for steers on feed on July 1 since 1978. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.31 million, up 8 percent from last year and up 11 percent from 1980.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the April-June quarter totaled 5.77 million, 3 percent greater than the same quarter one year ago, and 10 percent above the comparable period in 1980.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 409 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 5.36 million. MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during April-June totaled 5.19 million, up 2 percent from the same quarter last year, and 1 percent above the same quarter in 1980. This increase ended 3 consecutive years of decline in marketings during the second quarter.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JULY-SEPTEMBER UP 5 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.71 million head during the July-September quarter of 1982. This would be 5 percent greater than the third quarter marketings in 1981, and 9 percent above 1980.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 5 PERCENT

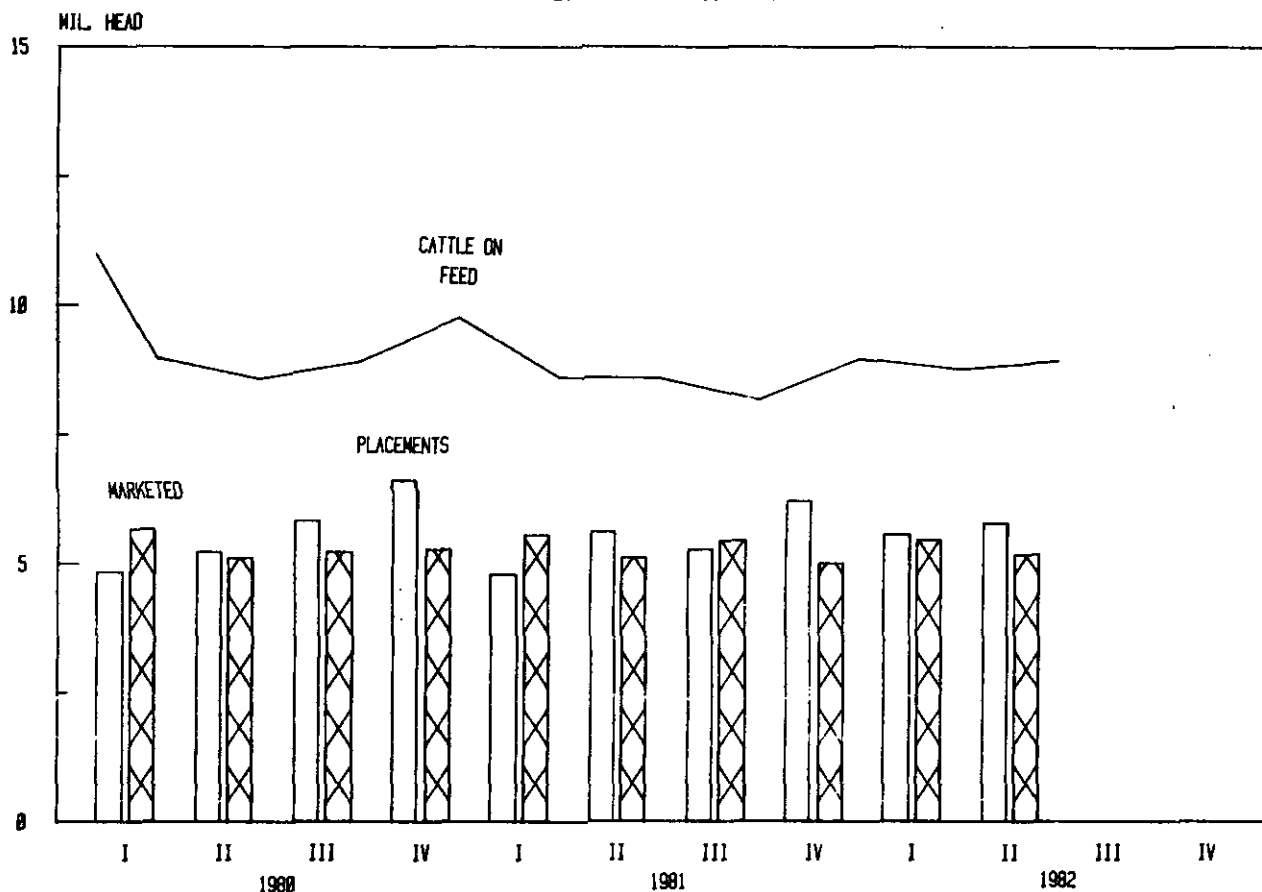
Cattle on feed July 1, 1982 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.18 million, a 5 percent increase from the previous year and 6 percent greater than 1980. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during June, of 1.41 million, were 6 percent above last year's low level, but 3 percent less than June 1980. MARKETINGS during June totaled 1.50 million, 3 percent and 7 percent above 1981 and 1980, respectively. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during June was 92 thousand head, 12 percent above last year, but 19 percent below 1980.

The April-June quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.32 million, were up 2 percent from last year and up 3 percent from the same quarter in 1980. Marketings for the 7 States during the April-June quarter accounted for 83 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the July-September 1982 quarter are estimated at 4.66 million, up 6 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1981 and up 11 percent from 1980.
