CATTLE ON FEED — 7 STATES

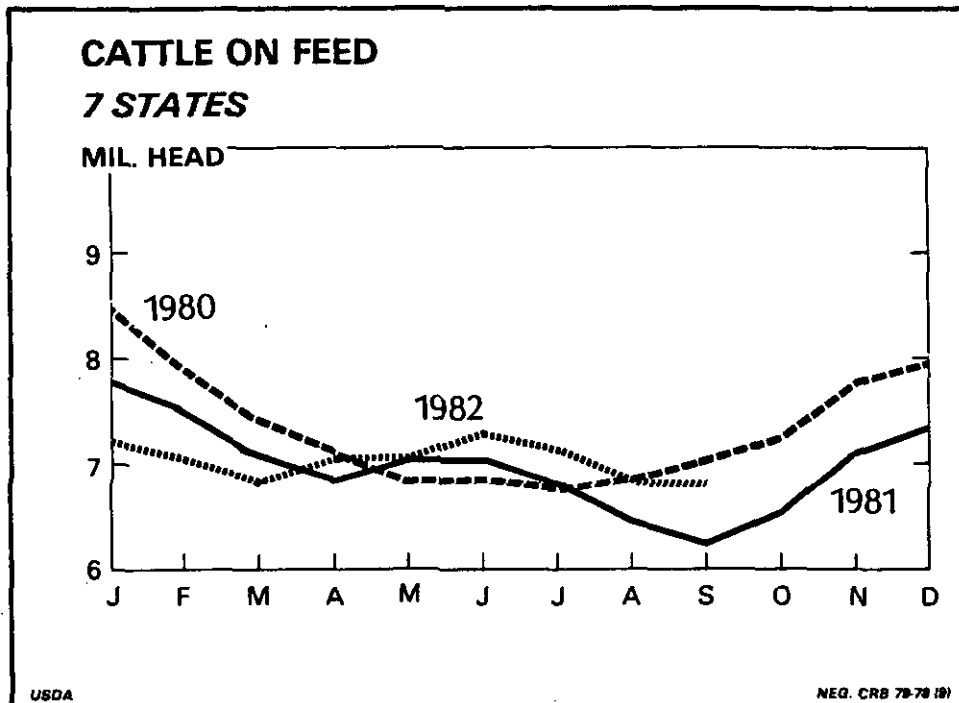
CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 8 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed September 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.82 million head, up 8 percent from a year ago but 3 percent less than September 1, 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during August totaled 1.69 million, 11 percent above last year and 21 percent more than August two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during August totaled 1.73 million, up 22 percent from last year and 7 percent more than the same month in 1980. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.67 million head during August were 22 percent greater than last year and 7 percent more than two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 61 thousand head compared with 55 thousand during August 1981 and 61 thousand during August 1980.
