## CATTLE ON FEED—13 STATES

### CATTLE ON FEED UP 7 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

CATTLE AND CALVES ON FEED October 1, 1982, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States, totaled 8.80 million head, 7 percent more than last year but 2 percent below 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.60 million steers and steer calves, up fractionally from last year but down 9 percent from 1980. This group represented 64 percent of the total October 1 number on feed compared with 68 percent in 1981. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.18 million, up 22 percent from last year and 13 percent above 1980.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during July-September quarter totaled 5.86 million, 11 percent greater than the same quarter a year ago and fractionally above the comparable period in 1980.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 254 thousand leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 5.60 million head. MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during July-September totaled 5.78 million, up 6 percent from the same quarter last year and 11 percent above the same quarter in 1980. This was the largest third quarter marketings since 1978.

### EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR OCTOBER-DECEMBER UP 8 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.46 million head during the October-December quarter of 1982. This would be 8 percent greater than fourth quarter marketings in 1981 and 4 percent below 1980.

### CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 8 PERCENT

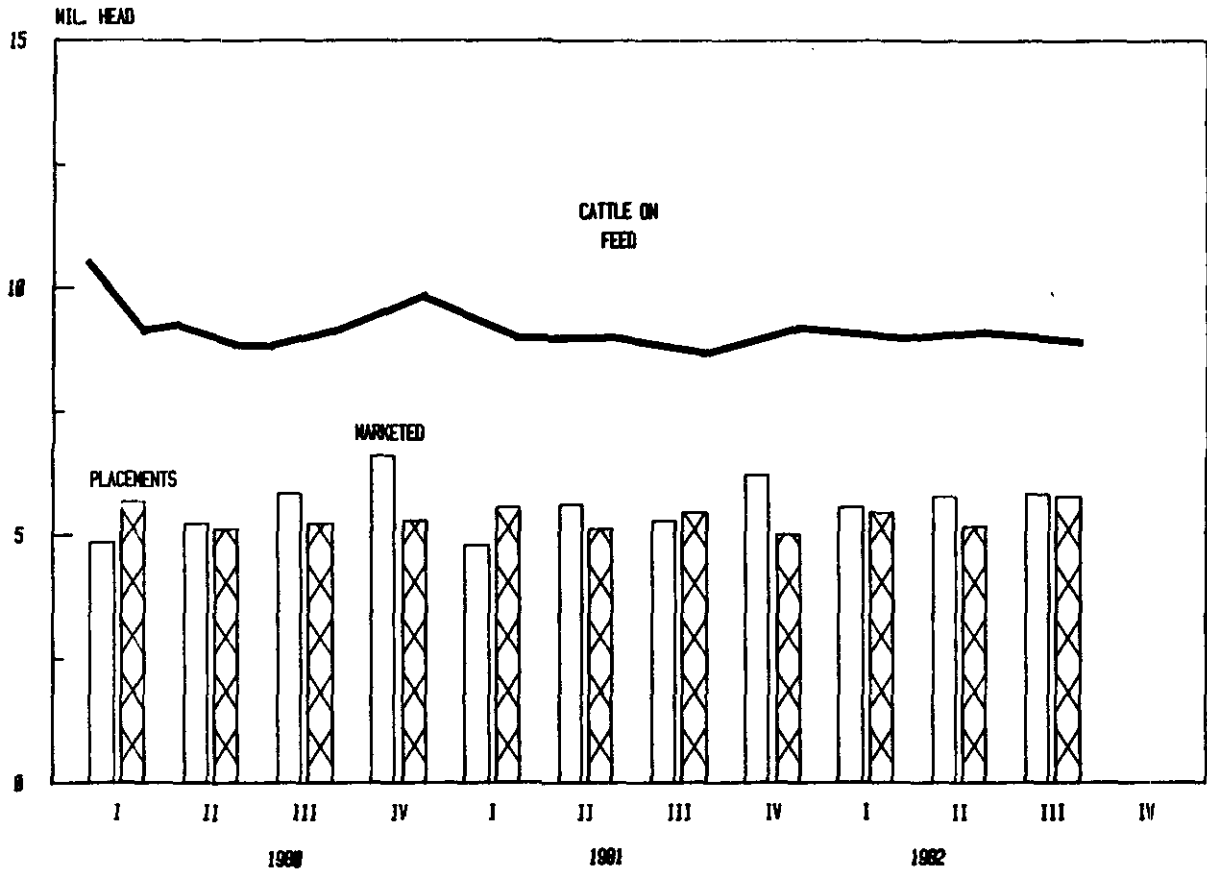
Cattle on feed October 1, 1982, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.15 million, an 8 percent increase from the previous year but a 1 percent decrease from 1980. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during September, of 2.00 million, were 9 percent above last year and 15 percent above 1980. MARKETINGS during September totaled 1.59 million, 9 percent above both 1981 and 1980. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during September was 83 thousand head, 3 percent below last year, but 14 percent above 1980.

The JULY-SEPTEMBER QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.76 million, were up 8 percent from last year and 14 percent above the same quarter in 1980. Marketings for the 7 States during the July-September quarter accounted for 82 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the October-December 1982 quarter are 4.51 million, up 11 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1981 and 4 percent above 1980.
