## CATTLE ON FEED—13 STATES

### CATTLE ON FEED IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES DOWN 4 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1984, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States, totaled 9.91 million head, 4 percent less than last year but 10 percent above 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 6.75 million steers and steer calves, up 1 percent from last year and 9 percent from two years ago. This group represented 68 percent of the total January 1 number on feed compared with 65 percent in 1983. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.12 million, down 12 percent from last year but 13 percent above 1982.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed during the October-December quarter totaled 7.25 million, fractionally above the same quarter a year earlier and 16 percent more than the same quarter for 1981. Other Disappearance of 393 thousand leaves Net Placements for the fourth quarter of 1983 at 6.86 million.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during October-December totaled 5.42 million, up 1 percent from fourth quarter marketings in 1982 and 6 percent more than marketings in the same quarter of 1981.

### EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JANUARY-MARCH UP 1 PERCENT

During the first quarter of 1984, 5.75 million head of fed cattle are expected to come to market. This would be a 1 percent increase from first quarter marketings in 1983 and 6 percent above 1982.

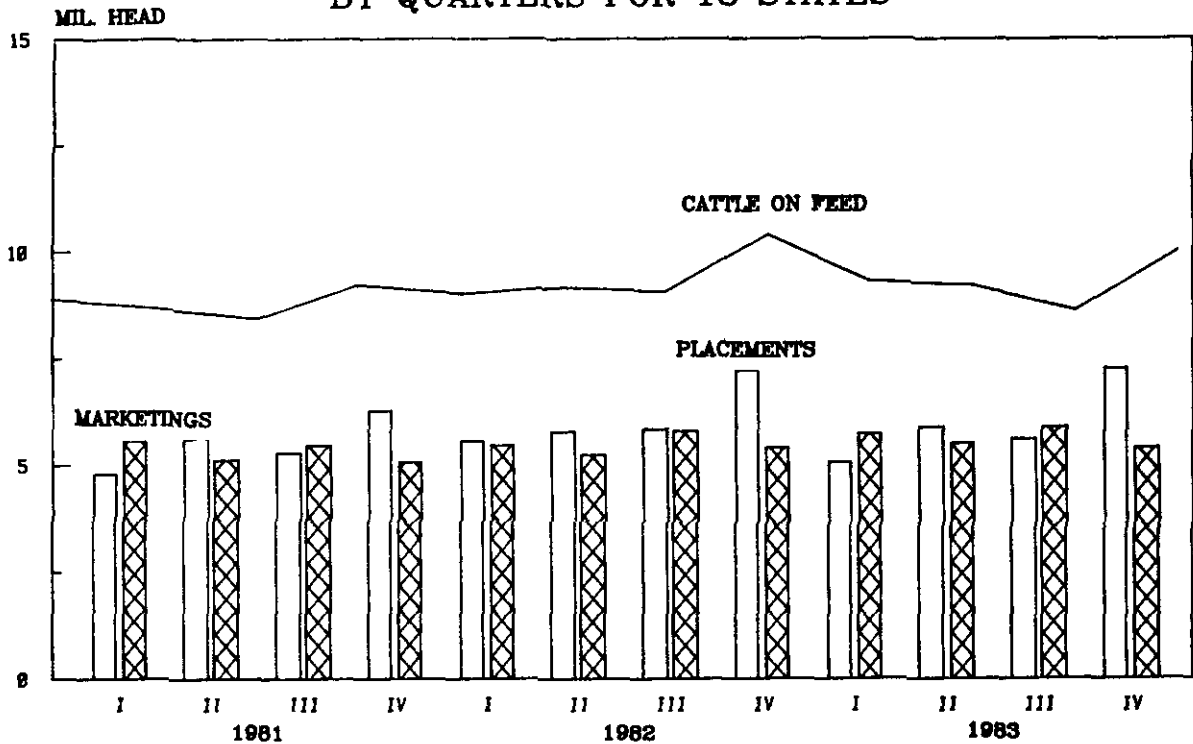
### CATTLE ON FEED IN SEVEN MONTHLY STATES DOWN 4 PERCENT

The number of cattle on feed January 1, 1984, for the seven monthly States was 8.01 million head, 4 percent below last year but 11 percent higher than 1982. Placements in feedlots during December of 1.74 million was 13 percent more than December 1982 and 33 percent above 1981. Marketings in December totaled 1.43 million, down fractionally from 1982 and 6 percent above 1981. Other Disappearance during December was 119 thousand compared with 111 thousand in December 1982 and 88 thousand two years ago.

The October-December Quarterly Marketings for the seven States at 4.51 million was 2 percent above 1982 and 9 percent above the same quarter in 1981. Marketings for the 7 States during the October-December quarter accounted for 83 percent of the 13 State total. Expected 7-State Marketings for the January-March 1984 quarter are 4.77 million, a 1 percent increase from the same quarter in 1983 and 6 percent above 1982.
