CATTLE ON FEED UP 2 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1 for the slaughter market in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 9.34 million head, up 2 percent from a year earlier and up 6 percent from 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The cattle on feed inventory included 6.20 million steers and steer calves, an increase of 7 percent over last year's level and up 9 percent from 1982. Steers and steer calves made up 66 percent of the inventory total for April 1, compared with 64 percent the two previous years. Heifers and heifer calves numbered 3.11 million head on April 1, showing a decrease of 6 percent from a year ago but virtually the same as two years earlier.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves into feedlots during the January-March 1984 quarter totaled 5.51 million head, up 10 percent from the same quarter last year, but 1 percent below the first quarter of 1982. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 365 thousand leaving NET PLACEMENTS of 5.15 million head.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during the January-March quarter totaled 5.71 million head, up less than one-half of 1 percent from last year and 5 percent more than the comparable 1982 quarter.

An unusually cold January and a cloudy, cool, and wet March complicated cattle feeding in Corn Belt and Plains States and limited weight gains. Muddy feedlots have reduced placements and resulted in dockage for excessively muddy cattle in some areas.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE UP 3 PERCENT

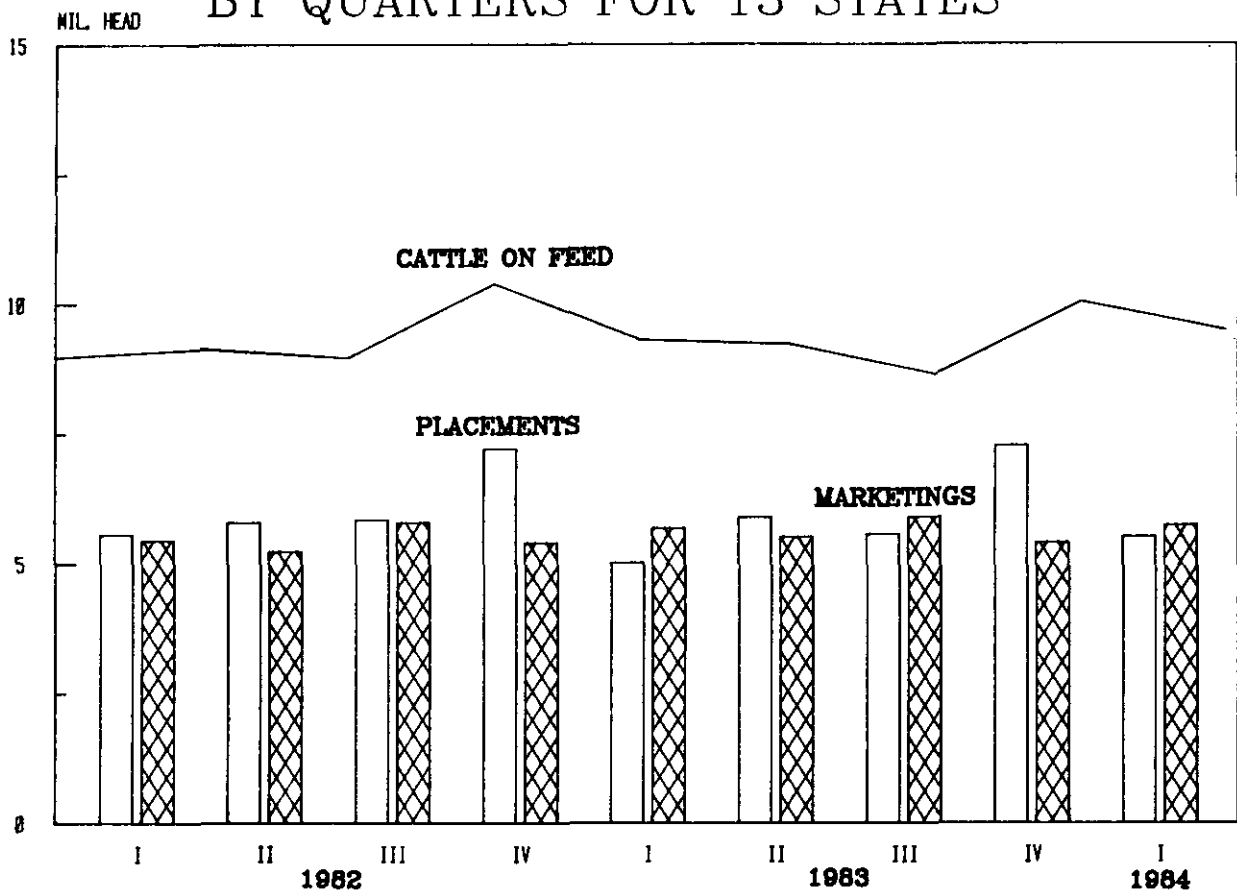
Cattle feeders intend to market 5.69 million head during the April-June quarter of 1984. This would be an increase in marketings of 3 and 9 percent over 1983 and 1982, respectively.

7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED UP 4 PERCENT

Cattle on feed April 1, 1984, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.57 million head, 4 percent above April 1, 1983, and 8 percent above two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March, at 1.76 million increased 26 percent from last year but were 2 percent below March 1982. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.59 million, 1 percent below the same month in 1983 but 3 percent above March 1982. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 117 thousand head compared with 137 thousand last year and 96 thousand in 1982.

The January-March quarterly marketings, at 4.78 million head, were up 1 percent from last year and 7 percent above the same quarter in 1982. The January-March marketings in the 7 States accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. Expected marketings for the April-June 1984 quarter are estimated at 4.75 million, up 3 percent from the same quarter in 1983.
