CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN FRACTIONALLY

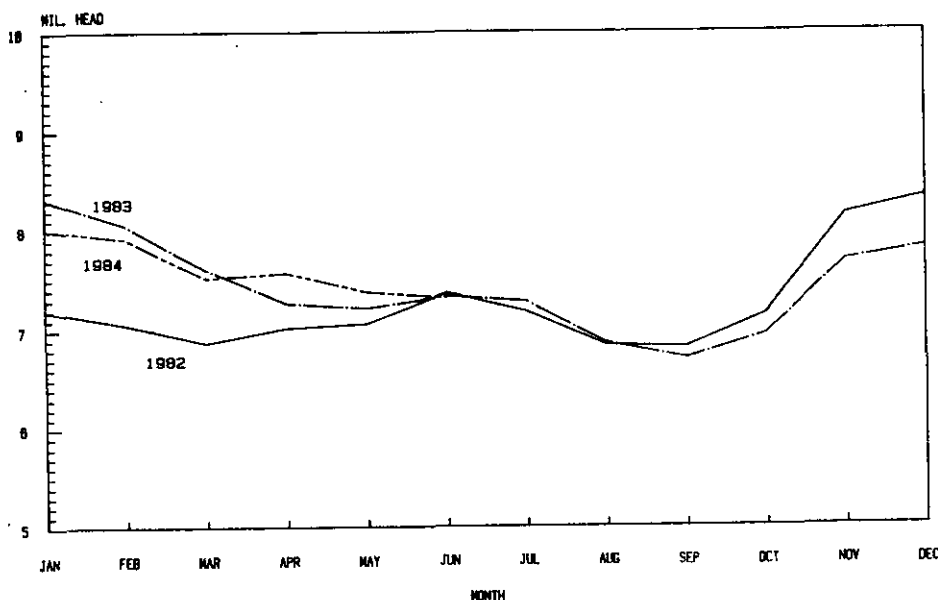
Cattle and Calves on feed June 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.32 million head, down fractionally from the 7.33 million head on hand a year ago, and 1 percent below June 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during May totaled 1.64 million, a 4 percent increase from last year and up 16 percent from May two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during May totaled 1.80 million, a 2 percent decrease from last May and 3 percent less than May 1982. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.58 million for May were 6 percent below May 1983 and 8 percent below two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 219 thousand compared with 150 thousand in May 1983 and 143 thousand during May 1982.
