## CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 4 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1984, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 8.70 million head, 4 percent below last year and 3 percent less than two years ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.64 million steers and steer calves, down fractionally from a year ago but virtually unchanged from 1982. This group represented 65 percent of the total July 1 number on feed compared with 62 percent in 1983. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.03 million, down 10 percent from last year and 8 percent below 1982.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the April-June quarter totaled 5.57 million, 5 percent below the same quarter one year ago, and 4 percent below the comparable period in 1982. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 582 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 4.99 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during April-June totaled 5.63 million, up 2 percent from the same quarter last year, and 8 percent above the same quarter in 1982.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JULY-SEPTEMBER UP 2 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 6.00 million head during the July-September quarter of 1984. This would be 2 percent greater than the third quarter marketings in 1983, and 4 percent above 1982.

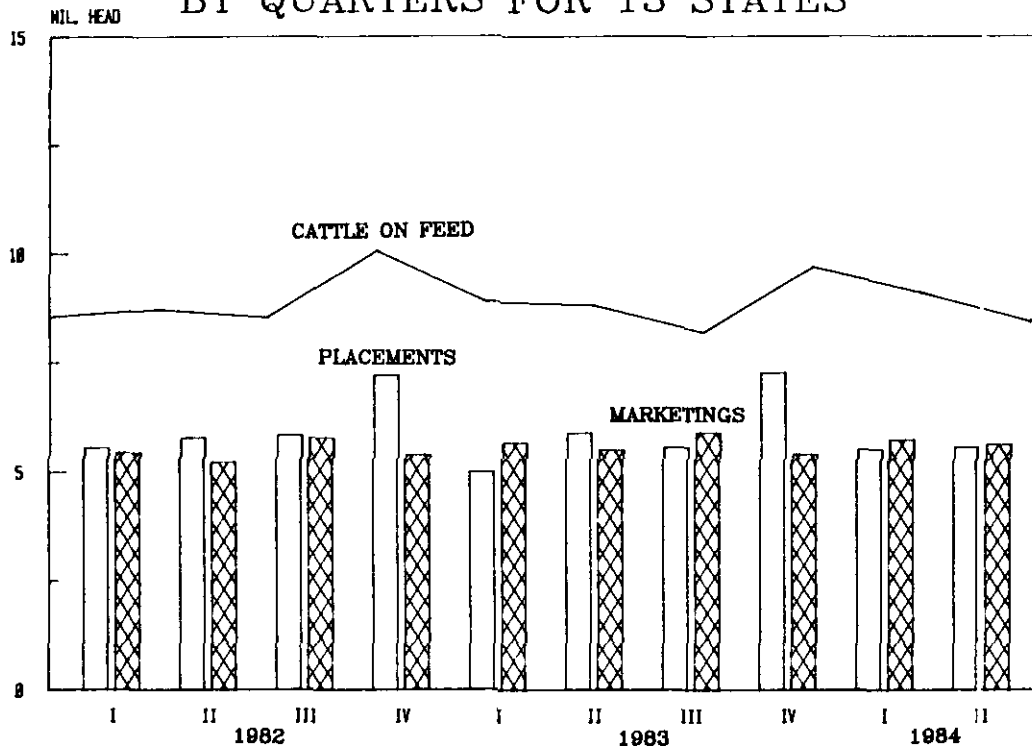
## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 2 PERCENT

Cattle on feed July 1, 1984 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.13 million, 2 percent below the previous year and 1 percent less than 1982. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during June, of 1.46 million, were 9 percent below last year's level, but 2 percent above June 1982. MARKETINGS during June totaled 1.55 million, 1 percent below 1983 but 3 percent above 1982. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during June was 94 thousand head, 21 percent above last year, and 2 percent above 1982.

The April-June quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.71 million, were up 2 percent from last year and 9 percent above the same quarter in 1982. Marketings for the 7 States during the April-June quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the July-September 1984 quarter are estimated at 4.98 million, up 3 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1983 and up 5 percent from 1982.
