CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 1 PERCENT

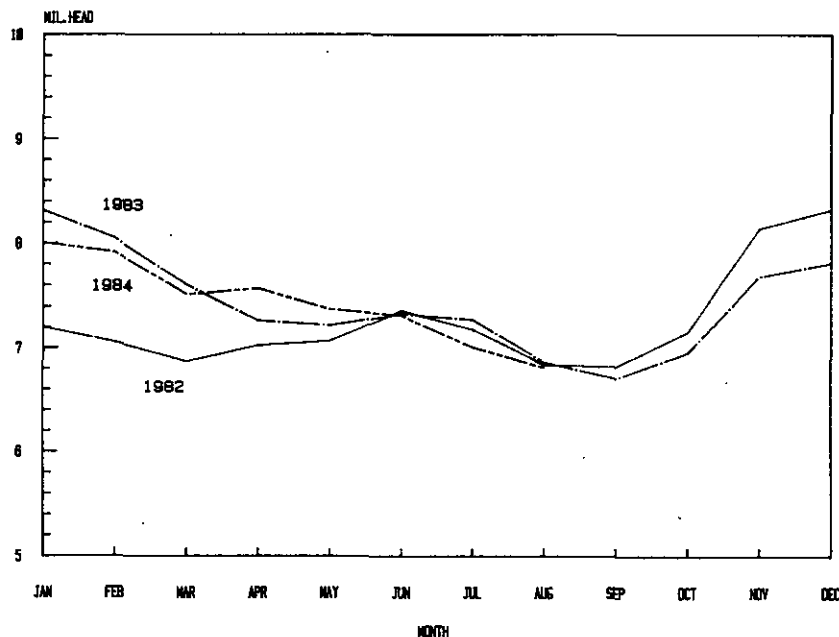
Cattle and calves on feed August 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.81 million head, down 1 percent from a year ago and fractionally below August 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during July totaled 1.55 million, 4 percent above last year and 5 percent more than July two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during July totaled 1.32 million, up 13 percent from last year and 10 percent above July 1982. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.24 million for July are 15 percent above last year and up 9 percent from two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 84 thousand head, compared with 94 thousand during July 1983 and 68 thousand during July 1982.
