## CATTLE ON FEED UP 6 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

CATTLE AND CALVES ON FEED October 1, 1984, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States, totaled 9.00 million head, 6 percent more than last year and 2 percent above 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.61 million steers and steer calves, up 3 percent from last year but virtually the same as 1982. This group represented 62 percent of the total October 1 number on feed, 2 percentage points less than in 1983. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.36 million, up 12 percent from last year and 6 percent above 1982.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the July-September quarter totaled 6.24 million, 12 percent more than the same quarter a year ago and 7 percent above the comparable period in 1982.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 268 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 5.97 million head. MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during July-September totaled 5.67 million, down 4 percent from the same quarter last year and 2 percent below the same quarter in 1982.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR OCTOBER-DECEMBER UP 5 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.70 million head during the October-December quarter of 1984. This would be 5 percent more than the fourth quarter marketings in 1983 and 6 percent above 1982.

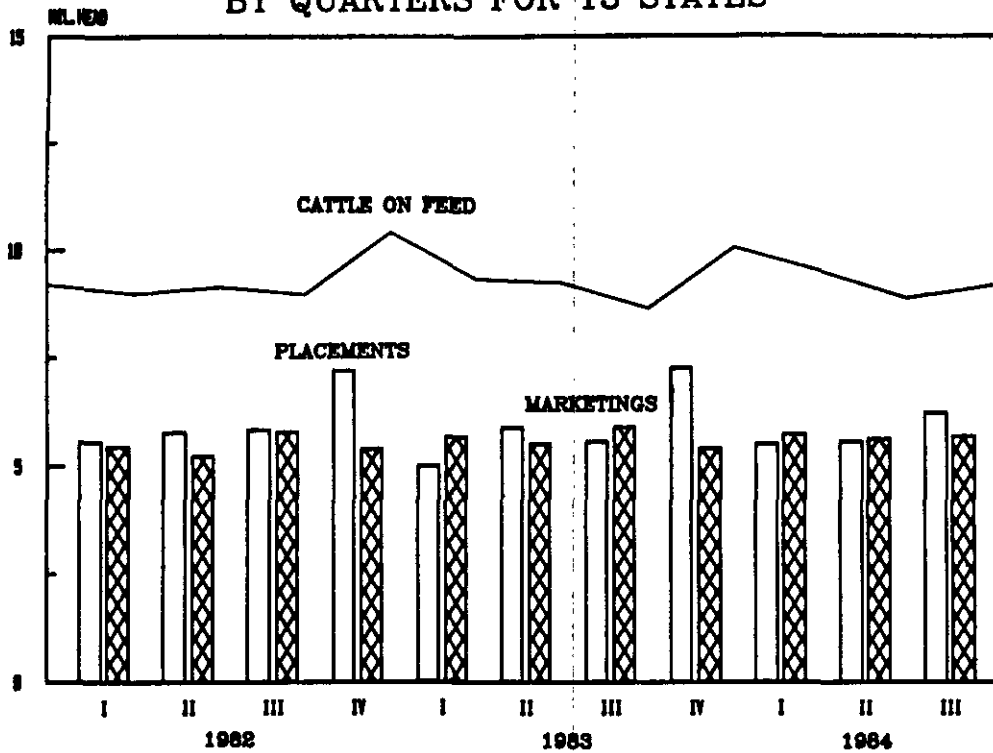
## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 7 PERCENT

CATTLE ON FEED October 1, 1984, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.44 million, a 7 percent increase from the previous year and a 4 percent increase from 1982. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during September, of 2.27 million, were up 13 percent from last year and 14 percent above 1982. MARKETINGS during September totaled 1.49 million, 11 percent below 1983 and 5 percent below 1982. There were 2 less slaughter days in September 1984 than in September 1983. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during September was 81 thousand head, 14 percent above last year but 2 percent below 1982.

The JULY-SEPTEMBER QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.71 million, were down 2 percent from last year and 1 percent below the same quarter in 1982. Marketings for the 7 States during the July-September quarter accounted for 83 percent of the 13-State total marketings. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the October-December 1984 quarter are 4.79 million, up 6 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1983 and 8 percent above 1982.
