CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 9 PERCENT

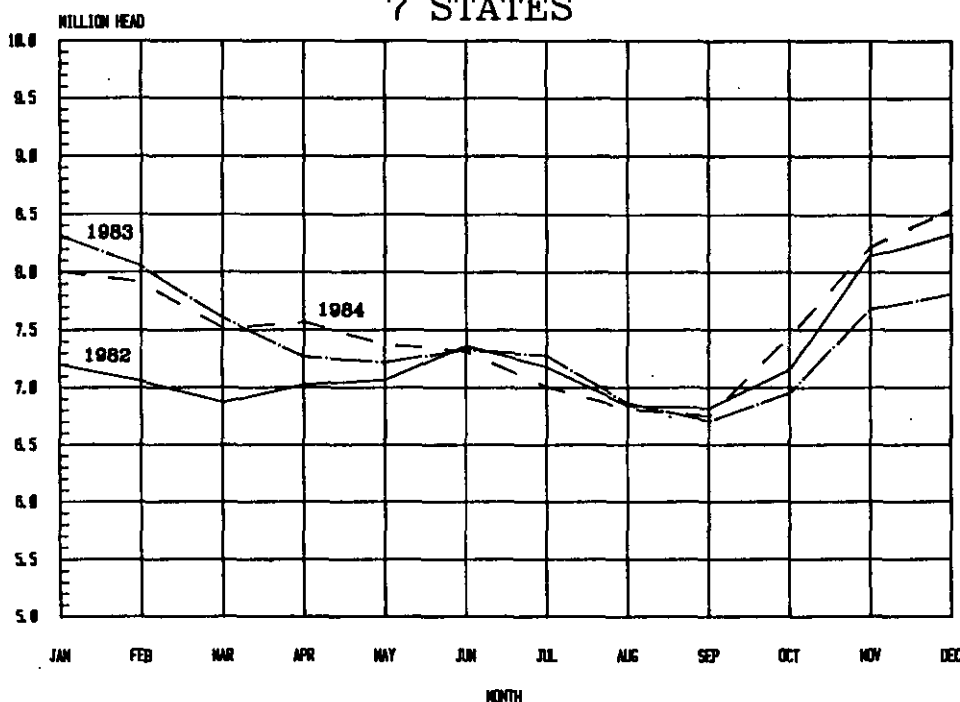
Cattle and calves on feed December 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.55 million head, a 9 percent increase from a year ago and up 3 percent from December 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during November totaled 1.49 million, an increase of 2 percent from last year and 1 percent more than November 1982.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States were 1.94 million, up 13 percent from November 1983 and up 9 percent from two years ago. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.82 million were up 15 percent from 1983 and 10 percent above 1982.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 120 thousand compared with 121 thousand during November 1983 and 119 thousand two years ago.
