
## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 5 PERCENT FROM A YEAR EARLIER

Cattle and calves on feed March 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.88 million head, up 5 percent from a year ago and 4 percent above March 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during February totaled 1.54 million, down 5 percent from last year but 3 percent above February 1983.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during February were 1.34 million, 3 percent above last year and 15 percent above February 1983. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.25 million were up 2 percent from last year and 20 percent above February 1983.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 94 thousand head compared with 82 thousand during February 1984 and 121 thousand two years ago.
