## CATTLE ON FEED UP 4 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1, 1985 for the slaughter market in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 9.68 million head, up 4 percent from a year earlier and up 6 percent from April 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The cattle on feed inventory included 5.95 million steers and steer calves, about the same as last year's level, but up 2 percent from April 1, 1983. Steers and steer calves made up 61 percent of the inventory total for April 1, 1985 compared with 64 percent the two previous years. Heifers and heifer calves numbered 3.68 million head on April 1, showing an increase of 10 percent from a year ago and 12 percent from two years earlier.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves into feedlots during the January-March 1985 quarter totaled 5.32 million head, down 3 percent from the same quarter last year, but 6 percent above the first quarter of 1983. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 373 thousand head leaving NET PLACEMENTS of 4.95 million head.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during the January-March 1985 quarter totaled 5.91 million head, up 3 percent from the corresponding quarter last year and 4 percent above the comparable 1983 quarter.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE UP 5 PERCENT

Cattle feeders intend to market 5.91 million head during the April-June quarter of 1985. This would be an increase in marketings of 5 and 7 percent over the corresponding quarters of 1984 and 1983, respectively.

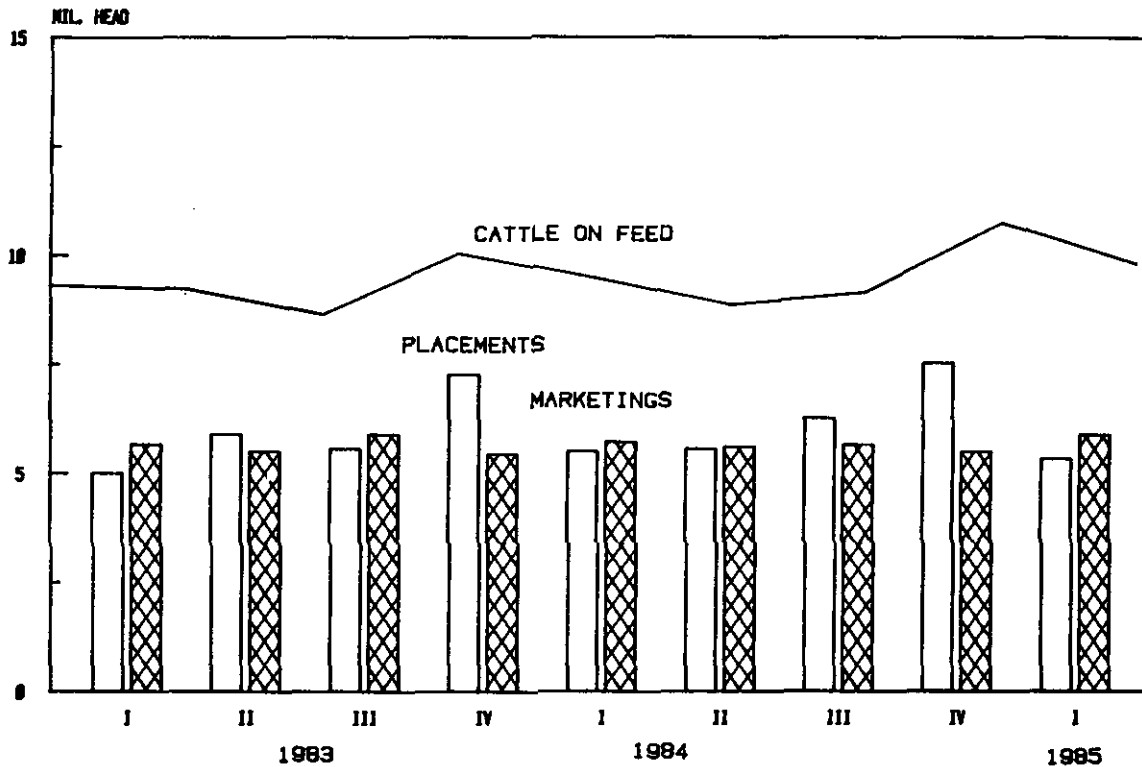
## 7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED UP 3 PERCENT

Cattle on feed April 1, 1985, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.81 million head, 3 percent above April 1, 1984, and 8 percent above April 1 two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March, at 1.59 million head, decreased 10 percent from last year but were 14 percent above March 1983. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.56 million, 2 percent below the same month in 1984 and 3 percent below March 1983. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 98 thousand head compared with 117 thousand last year and 137 thousand in 1983.

The January-March quarterly marketings, at 4.88 million head, were up 2 percent from the comparable quarter last year and 3 percent above the same quarter in 1983. The January-March marketings in the 7 States accounted for 83 percent of the 13-State total. Expected marketings for the April-June 1985 quarter are estimated at 4.93 million, up 5 percent from the same quarter in 1984.
